The game took 3:13 to play on Friday the 13th.

Padawans: The Lugnuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Athletics prospects: No. 8 prospect (Tommy White), No. 11 (Joshua Kuroda-Grauer), No. 13 (Steven Echavarria), No. 17 (Ryan Lasko), No. 18 (Rodney Green, Jr.) and No. 28 (Nate Nankil). The A's new No. 2 prospect was Lansing's Opening Day starter, southpaw phenom Gage Jump.

This is the Way: The Nuts have walked off with a win on four different occasions this year, including this past Wednesday:

- Jared Dickey's two-run single in the 12th inning to beat Great Lakes, 12-11, April 13th
- Sahid Valenzuela's RBI single in the 10th inning to beat Lake County, 1-0, May 4th
- Rodney Green, Jr.'s RBI single in the 10th inning to beat South Bend, 7-6, May 13th
- Jared Dickey's RBI fielder's choice in the bottom of the 9th to beat West Michigan, 4-3, June 11th

I am One With the Force, and the Force is With Me: Lansing first baseman T.J. Schofield-Sam went 1-for-3 with a double and a walk yesterday, putting his batting average at .357. That ranks 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball, trailing only Single-A San Jose's Carlos Gutierrez, who is hitting .360. Schofield-Sam leads the Midwest League in total bases (112), base hits (74) and HBPs (17), ranks 2nd in OPS (.971), tied for 2nd in triples (4), 3rd in slugging (.541), tied for 3rd in runs scored (41), 4th in on-base percentage (.430), tied for 4th in doubles (15) and tied for 5th in extra-base hits (24).

Let the Past Die: The Whitecaps' 26 hits yesterday tied the Lugnuts' record for most hits ever allowed in a game, set back on April 28, 1996, vs. the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers. The Whitecaps' 20 runs, however, fell short... because the Nuts gave up 24 runs to the Cedar Rapids Kernels on June 1, 2023. The franchise's single-inning record for runs allowed is unknown, though the Major League record is 18.

Don't Get Cocky: West Michigan's Kevin McGonigle became the second player to collect five hits in a game against Lansing this year, joining Fort Wayne's Leo De Vries (who hit for the cycle with two home runs on April 22). Johnny Peck became the first player to collect seven RBIs against the Lugnuts in one game since Clinton's Blake Ochoa on July 24, 2010.

I Have the High Ground: Tonight's Lansing starting pitcher, Nathan Dettmer, has induced 12 double plays this year (in 12 outings/9 starts between Stockton and Lansing), leading all of Minor League Baseball. As a team, the Nuts have turned 64 double plays, 1st in the MWL.

Never Tell Me the Odds: The Nuts are the most difficult team to strike out in Minor League Baseball, whiffing 6.98 times per game (426 strikeouts in 61 games). The Erie SeaWolves, one stop above West Michigan on the Tigers' organizational ladder, are in second at 7.30 strikeouts per game (445 in 61 games).

Hello There: 6-foot-8 left-hander Jack Mahoney made his Athletics organizational debut and affiliated MiLB debut on Wednesday, entering in relief in the eighth inning and striking out the first five Whitecaps he faced. Mahoney is the 967th player in the history of the Lansing Lugnuts and the 37th used this year (including the 20th different pitcher). The native of Appleton, Wisc., had his contract purchased from the independent Atlantic League's Staten Island FerryHawks on Monday.

### **JUNE 14TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY**

2012: RF Chris Hawkins threw out two Fort Wayne TinCaps at home plate and 1B Kevin Patterson hit a go-ahead two-out three-run homer in the top of the 8th for a 5-4 Lugnuts win. (Patterson then homered twice more the next day at Great Lakes.)

2014: 30-year-old knuckleballer Frank Viola III tossed 6 2/3 scoreless innings: eight hits, two walks, one strikeout in a 3-0 win at Great Lakes.

2019: In the bottom of the eighth inning, the Lugnuts rallied for two runs on a DJ Neal RBI double and a Gabriel Moreno sacrifice fly to beat Bowling Green, 3-2. The Lugnuts' win, as it turned out, denied the third-place Hot Rods from making the playoffs in the first half. Bowling Green then clinched a second-half playoff berth, denying the Lugnuts from making the post-season. The winning pitcher was 19-year-old lefty Naswell Paulino, who pitched a scoreless eighth in his only appearance of the year with the Lugnuts.
