SUNDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats split the doubleheader against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies on Sunday afternoon, losing the first game 9-8 before winning the second game 10-5 at Delta Dental Stadium to finish the series in a split. In the first game, Orelvis Martinez homered for the third time this series. Trailing 6-3 in the 7th, Will Robertson drove in two of his three RBIs in the first game with a two-run double to make it a one-run contest. With one out, Steward Berroa scampered home on a wild pitch to tie the game 6-6. After a three-run 8th by Binghamton, Zac Cook and Robertson both doubled in runs to make it a one-run game again 9-8. With the bases loaded and two outs, Trevor Schwecke struck out to end the first game of the day. In the second game, New Hampshire hit three home runs en route to a 10-5 victory. With Binghamton ahead 4-0 in the 4th, Schwecke hit an opposite field grand slam to right for his second career grand slam and the first Fisher Cats grand slam of the year. Dylan Rock's two-run home run to right in the fifth put the Fisher Cats ahead 6-4, his fourth home run of the season. PK Morris delivered a three-run home run in the sixth down the right field line for good measure. It was Morris's first Double-A home run.

CHUCKY CHEESE DALLAS: Chad Dallas was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week after a dominant seven shutout inning, nine strikeout performance on Friday against Binghamton. It's the first time a Fisher Cat pitcher has been named with the weekly award since Max Castillo the week of April 8-17, 2022. Dallas's seven-inning start in his Fisher Cats debut was the longest start of his career.

'OBP' - ON BASE PALMEGIANI: Damiano Palmegiani is in the top-5 of the Eastern League leaderboard in on-base percentage. The corner infielder is getting on-base at a .415 clip, tied for fifth-best in the league. On Sunday, he extended his hit streak to eight consecutive games while recording his team-leading ninth multi-hit game of the season in game one of the doubleheader. Palmegiani has reached base in an impressive 30 of 34 games played this season.

GET SCHWECKED: Trevor Schwecke drove in a career-high five RBIs in the second game of the Sunday doubleheader, including a grand slam in the fourth to tie up the score 4-4 in the fourth. It was Schwecke's second career grand slam and the first grand slam hit by the Fisher Cats this season. The utilityman has played every position on defense except for catcher, center field and pitcher.

PARTY LIKE A ROCK-STAR: Dylan Rock has a knack for knowing when to hit the ball out of the park for the Fisher Cats so far this year. Three of his four home runs this season have been game winning hits, including his most recent homer in the second game of the doubleheader on Sunday, a two-run shot to break the 4-4 tie in the fifth. His very first Double-A homer broke a 5-5 tie in the eighth on April 25 vs Hartford in the continuation of a suspended game.

SLUGGIN' SEBASTIAN: OF Sebastian Espino has been off to a solid start to the month of May after struggling for most of April. After hitting only .115 (3-for-26) in April, Espino is hitting .250 (10-for-40) so far in May with two doubles, a homer and eight RBIs. He has collected a hit in nine of 13 games played in the month of May and has recorded an RBI in four straight contests. Friday was his first multi-RBI performance in almost a month (4/20 @ SOM).

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (May 23, 2019) - The Fisher Cats completed a three-game home sweep of the Altoona Curve with a 7-2 win at Delta Dental Stadium. Patrick Murphy went six innings, allowing one run, striking out seven. Kevin Smith had a three-run triple in the third inning and Alberto Mineo homered for New Hampshire.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (25-23) lost its fifth in a row to Tampa Bay 6-4. Whit Merrifield went 4-for-4, including a home run and Daulton Varsho homered as well in the loss...Triple-A Buffalo (22-23) won four of six at home against Rochester. The Bisons will hit the road and face Lehigh Valley this week...High-A Vancouver (19-17) lost four of six against Tri-City this past week. The Canadians will go to Spokane for the week and will have to make up a pair of games from April for a total of eight games on the road trip....Class A Dunedin (21-18) split the series against Tampa. The D-Jays will host Fort Myers this week.

COMING UP: New Hampshire continues its six-game road trip at Portland this week, their first of two visits to the Sea Dogs this season. The next home game will be Tuesday, May 30 when the Fisher Cats host Reading.
