### INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Highlighted by a grand slam from Billy Cook, the Indianapolis Indians defeated the Toledo Mud Hens 9-4 on Saturday night at Fifth Third Field. The Indians took control early against Toledo starter Troy Watson. After Nick Yorke drew a one-out walk in the first inning, Malcom Nuñez singled him home for the game's first run. In the second frame, Joshua Palacios led off with a single, Matt Gorski walked and Seth Beer was hit by a pitch to load the bases for Cook, who capitalized with a grand slam, extending the lead to 5-0. The Mud Hens responded in the home half of the second with three runs. Former Indian Bligh Madris singled and advanced to second on a wild pitch by Indians starter Jake Woodford. A walk issued to Justice Bigbie and a double from Anthony Bemboom put Toledo on the board. Another wild pitch scored Bigbie and a single off the bat of Riley Unroe cut the deficit to 5-3. Both teams went scoreless in the third and fourth innings before Gorski roped an RBI double in the fifth. The Indians then sent three runs across in the sixth. Dylan Shockley drew a lead-off walk, Cook singled and a wild pitch advanced Shockley to third. Yorke then drove him home with an RBI single. Jake Lamb followed with a sacrifice fly, and Liover Peguero capped the Indians' scoring with an RBI single to left. Eddy Leonard launched a two-out home run in the bottom of the ninth, but the threat ended there for Toledo.

**SEEKING MOMENTUM:** The Indians regained the advantage in the series last night with a 9-4 win against the Mud Hens. They remain tied with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and Worcester for second place in the International League second-half standings, 5.0 games behind first-place Columbus. They are now 68-66, and the Indians have not finished with a full-season record above .500 since going 73-67 in 2018.

**COOKED UP A GRAND SLAM:** Billy Cook has a knack for hitting big home runs for the Indians this season, launching a three-run homer to kick off Indianapolis' eight-run ninth-inning comeback attempt on Friday night before launching a grand slam last night. It was his third home run in six September games and his second grand slam with Indianapolis, making him the first Indians batter to hit multiple grand slams in the same season since Josh Bell in 2016. All five of his home runs for the Indians have come with runners on base. In total, he went 2-for-5 with two runs scored last night and is now hitting .276 (29-for-105) with 19 runs, 12 extra-base hits, 21 RBI, nine stolen bases and a .875 OPS since making his organization debut on Aug. 3.

**START SPREADING THE NEWS:** Nick Yorke has now reached base safely in each of his five September games, going 1-for-3 with two runs, an RBI and two walks last night. The stretch follows a torrid month of August when he was named Indianapolis' Player of the Month, and since joining the Indians on July 31 he has hit safely in 26 of 33 games while ranking among International League leaders in doubles (1st, 16), hits (T-1st, 44), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 17), batting average (3rd, .358), total bases (5th, 63) and on-base percentage (T-7th, .429).

**TURN UP THE TEMP:** Matt Gorski went 1-for-3 with a run, double, RBI and walk last night. He has now hit safely in 12 of 14 games since Aug. 18 with a .415 batting average (22-for-53), 11 runs, 10 extra-base hits, 12 RBI, five stolen bases and a 1.211 OPS. He currently ranks second among International League leaders with a .538 slugging percentage and tied for the fifth most extra-base hits with 50. His 21 home runs are also the most by an Indians batter since Will Craig had 23 in 2019.

**MALCOM DOES THE MOST:** Malcom Nuñez has hit safely in all five games at Toledo this week following an RBI single last night. For the series, he is 10-for-23 with three doubles and five RBI, highlighted by a four-hit performance in Monday's opener. He has now hit safely in eight of his last eight nine since Aug. 29 with a .361 batting average (13-for-36), eight runs, four doubles and eight RBI.

**LIOVER LACED TWO:** Liover Peguero smacked two singles last night and now has two hits in three of five games at Toledo this week. He has not gone hitless in back-to-back games since Aug. 21, hitting safely in 13 of his last 15 during that time with a .356 batting average (21-for-59), nine runs, five doubles, four home runs and 12 RBI. In 119 games with the Indians this season, he is hitting .260 (118-for-453) with 64 runs, 27 doubles, three triples, 13 home runs and 75 RBI, which is tied for the eighth most in the IL.

**SHORTY WINS:** Aaron Shortridge entered in relief of starter Jake Woodford last night and earned his second win of the season with 3.0 one-hit innings with just one walk allowed and five strikeouts of his 10 total batters faced. He has made only six relief appearances compared to 87 starts during his minor league career, all coming within the last two seasons. In four outings out of the bullpen with Indianapolis, he is 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2er/11.0ip) and 15 strikeouts, compared to going 0-3 with a 7.00 ERA (21er/27.0ip) and 20 strikeouts in six starts.

**TONIGHT:** The Indianapolis Indians will look to return to Victory Field with a road trip series victory as they conclude their six-game series at Fifth Third Field, home of the Detroit Tiger-affiliated Toledo Mud Hens, today at 2:05 PM ET. The Indians and Mud Hens were evenly matched in a pair of series at Victory Field, 6-6. At Fifth Third Field, the Indians dropped five of six games during their first road trip in April. Closing out the series for the Indians today is RHP Mike Burrows (0-1, 3.12), who tossed 4.0 one-run innings with four walks and four strikeouts in Monday's series opener. Countering for the Mud Hens is RHP Jack Anderson (2-0, 0.00), who has faced Indianapolis three times this season and allowed three unearned runs with six strikeouts in 6.1 innings.

**THIS DATE IN 2017:** In Game 3 of its Governors' Cup semifinal against Durham, Nick Kingham hurled 7.0 shutout frames in a 5-0 win, Indy's lone victory in the best-of-five series. Kingham struck out four and allowed just seven baserunners (four hits, three walks). A two-run double by Joey Terdoslavich in the third put Indy in front for good, and the offense tacked on two more insurance runs in the eighth. The win was the first playoff shutout for the Indians at Victory Field and Indy's second since 1996, the other coming in Game 3 of the 2012 Governors' Cup semifinals at Charlotte.

## TONIGHT'S PITCHER

**Mike Burrows:** Right-hander Mike Burrows is set to make his second start of the series against Toledo, this afternoon at 2:05 PM ET at Fifth Third Field. The Pirates' No. 10 prospect according to *Baseball America* made his first appearance since April 8, 2023, with the FCL Pirates on June 17 while recovering from Tommy John surgery.

**Last Outing:** Burrows pitched 4.0 innings with four punchouts and gave up one run on two hits in his last start on September 2 against Toledo.

**Against the Mud Hens:** Burrows has made two starts against Toledo this season and fanned a combined 11 hitters in 7.1 innings.

**Miscellaneous:** Selected by Pittsburgh in the 11th round (324th overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Waterford (Conn.) High School.
