FROM THE CROW'S NEST

SUNDAY SPLURGE: The Marauders racked up season-highs in runs (18) and hits (16) in Sunday's 18-9 win over Fort Myers. The nine-run outburst in the first inning was the team's first nine-run inning since June 20, 2018, when Bradenton plated nine runs in the second inning against Clearwater. Additionally, the 18 runs were the Marauders' first game of 15 or more runs scored since 2017, when they pulled out a 20-2 win over Palm Beach on May 20.

SUPER SAMMY: Sammy Siani hit his first career home run on Sunday against Fort Myers and collected a career-high five RBI. The Pirates first-round pick from 2019 went 3-for-4 in the game, including two doubles in the Marauders' nine-run first inning. Siani's five RBI made him the first Marauder since Dylan Busby (8/27/19 vs Palm Beach) to record five RBI in a game, and he finished a triple shy of becoming the first player in franchise history to hit for the cycle.

SATURDAY NIGHT STEALS: The Marauders stole a franchise-record eight bases on Saturday against Fort Myers, including a three-steal performance by **Jasiah Dixon**, who became the first Marauder to swipe three bases in a game since Alfredo Reyes on June 29, 2017. Dixon leads the team with five steals, and as a team, the Marauders are 12-for-13 in base stealing attempts this season.

WELCOME ABOARD: Alexander Mojica currently owns the longest on-base streak among Marauders hitters, reaching safely in each of his first five games. The 18-year-old Dominican Republic native is batting .333 (4-for-13) with two home runs, five RBI.

TURN THIS THING AROUND: Entering Sunday's game, the Marauders owned the Low-A Southeast's fourth-lowest team batting average (.205) and were batting .145 (8-for-55) with runners in scoring position. The club turned the tide with Sunday's hit parade, going 9-for-21 with men in scoring position.

TOP PROSPECTS: The Marauders roster currently boasts six prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the organization: **Hudson Head** (#6), **Eddy Yean** (#13), **Sammy Siani** (#19), **Nick Garcia** (#21), **Endy Rodriguez** (#27), and **Alexander Mojica** (#30). Three of the six (Head, Rodriguez, and Yean) came to the organization via blockbuster trades: Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the three-team Joe Musgrove deal, while Yean came from Washington in the Josh Bell trade.

UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT: New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** takes the helm in Bradenton for his first season in the Pirates organization. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020 (he was originally slated to manage the short-season West Virginia Black Bears), he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

THE OPPONENT: The Dunedin Blue Jays pitching staff was ravaged in the opening series, surrendering 78 runs on 73 hits to the Tampa Tarpons over the six-game set. Dunedin dropped each of the first five games of the series before salvaging Sunday's series finale, 4-1. The five-game skid was the D-Jays' longest losing streak to open a season since 2011, when Dunedin lost its first six games.

HEAD TO HEAD: The Marauders struggled against Dunedin in 2019, going 5-8 against the D-Jays despite outscoring them in their 13 matchups, 63-57.
