FROM THE CROW'S NEST

LAST TIME OUT: The Marauders fell twice to the Mighty Mussels Wednesday night, losing the completion of Tuesday's suspended game, 5-4, and dropping the seven-inning nightcap, 6-1... Bradenton built a 4-2 lead in the first game with a three-run fifth inning (game-tying **Sergio Campana** RBI-infield single, go-ahead two-run single by **Deivis Nadal**), but right Hander **Jack Hartman** loaded the bases on three walks in the seventh and saw the Mussels come within one run, 4-3, on a groundout... Jake Rucker hit a walk-off, two-run homer in the ninth to give Fort Myers the win... The second game saw **Joelvis del Rosario** and Jordan Carr battle with three scoreless innings each before the Mussels assembled a five-hit, four-run rally in the bottom of the fourth... Kala'i Rosario added a two-run homer in the sixth off **Brennan Malone**... Bradenton's lone run came in the fifth, when **Wyatt Hendrie** tripled and scored on a **Luke Brown** sacrifice fly.

THE OPPONENT: The Mighty Mussels clinched the first-half West Division title with their two wins Wednesday night... The team's roster currently features five players in *Baseball America's* latest top 30 prospect rankings for the Twins organization: INF Noah Miller (#10), LHP Steve Hajjar (#11), RHP Marco Raya (#18), OF Kala'i Rosario (#28), and INF Keoni Cavaco (#30).

GUESS WHO'S BACK: **Tsung-Che Cheng** returned to the Marauders lineup Tuesday after spending nearly four weeks on the IL... He held a 6-game hit streak prior to landing on the IL and promptly continued his streak with a leadoff single to begin Tuesday's game... Cheng is batting .400 (10-for-25) during the streak and leads the team with 11 multi-hit games.

J.B., JUST BRILLIANT: **Jase Bowen** has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games, batting .341 with 6 RBI and 8 SB during that stretch... He has also reached base in 16 of his last 17 games and had a 13-game on-base streak prior to going 0-for-4 last Saturday... The on-base streak was his second-longest of the season (16G) and the third-longest by a Marauder this year (Jacob Gonzalez, 24G).

WALK THIS WAY: **Brenden Dixon** leads the Marauders with 32 walks, tied for seventh-most in the FSL... The Texas native drew a season-high three walks in Tuesday's series opener and has drawn two or more walks in seven games this season... Since May 1, Dixon owns a .387 OBP, and his season OBP stands at .355.

TOP PIRATES PROSPECTS: The Marauders roster currently includes two prospects in *Baseball America's* Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: LHP **Anthony Solometo** (#11) and OF **Rodolfo Nolasco** (#28)... *Baseball America* lists the Pirates' farm system as the third-best in baseball.

FIELD STAFF: Manager **Jonathan Johnston**, 2021 Low-A Southeast Manager of the Year, is in his second season at the helm for the Marauders... Former major leaguer **Yorman Bazardo** is the club's new pitching coach after spending 2021 as a pitching coach for the FCL Pirates... Former Pirate **Mendy López** joins as hitting coach after serving as the Pirates' Latin American Field Coordinator in 2021... **Casey Harms** is the Marauders' Integrated Baseball Performance Coach after a collegiate coaching career in the Northwoods League (Waterloo Bucks, 2019-20) and at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018)... **Gustavo Omaña** is the Marauders' Development Coach after serving on staff at Triple-A Indianapolis in 2021.

HITTING TRIPLE DIGITS: The 2022 season marks the 100th year of operation for LECOM Park, known as City Park upon opening in 1923. It has served as a spring training home for six different MLB franchises, including the Pirates since 1969. Baseball hall-of-famers who once called the historic park their spring home include Hank Aaron, Roberto Clemente, Dizzy Dean, Rogers Hornsby, Reggie Jackson, and more.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS/INFO

SCOUTING REPORT (per *Baseball America*): “[L]ow-to-mid-90s [fastball], command and ability to throw it in any count. He pairs it with a slider that dives at the foot of righthanded batters and flashes plus. His changeup is more developmental but flashes solid-average potential.”

2022: Added to Marauders roster May 27... Professional debut that night vs Fort Myers: threw 32 pitches in first inning (two-out error led to two runs) before working scoreless second and third innings... June 2 at Lakeland: retired first six batters, lone run scored in 3rd (leadoff single-stolen base-passed ball-fielder’s choice), retired 4 of last 5... **Last Thursday vs Clearwater: pitched in piggyback role behind rehabbing Quinn Priester, went 4 IP in four-pitcher combined no-hitter (second 9-inning no-hitter in team history)...**

2021: As a senior at Bishop Eustace Prep High School (Pennsauken, N.J.), did not allow a hit or a run until 17.2 IP into his season... Finished the season with a 0.22 ERA and 65 K in 32.1 IP... Drafted by Pirates in 2nd round (37th overall) in July draft out of Bishop Eustace and was signed by Dan Radcliff... Chose to sign with the Pirates over a commitment to North Carolina and received a \$2.8 million signing bonus... Spent time at Pirates’ fall development camp later that year...

2020: Transferred from Gloucester Catholic H.S. (Gloucester City, N.J.) to Bishop Eustace for his junior season... Season was canceled due to Covid-19 pandemic...

2019: As a sophomore at Gloucester Catholic, went 5-2 with a 1.59 ERA and 64 K in 44 IP...

2018: Prior to his freshman season at Gloucester Catholic, committed to North Carolina on a baseball scholarship... Led Gloucester Catholic to a Non-Public B State Championship, striking out 11 in 5 scoreless IP in the championship game...

PERSONAL: *Last name is pronounced “sahl-uh-MEE-toh”*... Grew up a Phillies and Red Sox fan... Favorite NFL team is the Pittsburgh Steelers: “...[W]hen I was three or four years old, my dad said for some reason I had this weird obsession with the Seahawks, then the Seahawks played the Steelers [in Super Bowl XL] and the Steelers won, ... I switched.”... In high school, wore number 32 in honor of Steelers legend and fellow New Jerseyan, Franco Harris... Others in professional baseball who attended Bishop Eustace include RHP Zac Gallen (Diamondbacks), RHP Tyler Phillips (Phillies AAA), LHP Devin Smeltzer (Twins), Greg Brodzinski (Phillies catching coach), and RHP Justin Hagenman (Dodgers AAA)...
