GAME RECAP:

The Reading Fightin Phils were topped in extras 5-4 as the Portland Sea Dogs walked it off in the 11th. Reading notched two home runs thanks to Aldrem Corredor and Jhailyn Ortiz. The team got ahead in the 10th but Portland was right there to come back.

HOMER HEAVEN:

Reading has now hit at least one home run in three straight games. In New Hampshire they had back-to-back games with three homers hit and started game one in Portland with another two long balls. Jhailyn Ortiz and Vito Friscia have a team-high five bombs a piece.

PERPETUALLY BEHIND:

The Fightins have had trouble this season getting out of the first inning. The pitching staff has allowed 24 runs to cross in the first, 19% of all runs allowed. Out of the 22 games played this summer, an opponent has scored first in 15 of them. Only four out of fifteen times has Reading gone on to win the game.

FORMER FOE:

The R-Phils have two players on their active roster that were formerly a part of the Boston Red Sox organization. Wendell Rijo was originally signed by Boston in 2013. In 2016, he played 51 games in Portland recording 33 hits and a .186 average before being traded to the Milwaukee Brewers. Josh Ockimey was initially a fifth round draft pick by the Sox in 2014. He spent part of two seasons in Portland laying down 26 doubles and 18 home runs. Ockimey elected free agency after the 2021 season.

SAC ATTACK:

The Reading Fightin Phils batters have sacrificed themselves a total of 13 times this season. Reading has hit a minor league leading eight sac bunts, the majority of which came in the last series at New Hampshire. They have also recorded five sacrifice flies to manufacture runs.

BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:

The Phillies fell to the Texas Rangers 6-3 on Monday night at Citizens Bank Park. JT Realmuto hit a home run while former Fightin Rhys Hoskins notched two RBIs. Ranger Suarez took the loss allowing six hits and five runs, three earned.

ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALLTOWN HISTORY:

May 4, 2001: At Reading, 9,792 fans pack First Energy Stadium as the largest crowd in the ballpark's 52-year history watches a game vs. the Altoona Curve. The R-Phils please the hometown fans with a 5-3 victory. The attendance mark would stand until August 23, 2003.

May 4, 2021: At Reading, Minor League Baseball returns to Baseballtown after a hiatus of 607 days. The R-Phils start the season with a bang as Arquimedes Gamboa leads off the bottom of the 1st with a home run. The rest of the game doesn't go so well for the home club, though, as Erie cruises to a 12-4 victory. The crowd is limited to 2,620 due to COVID-19 seating capacity restrictions.
