Friday night at Heritage Financial Park...George Lombard drove in three runs while Brenny Escanio hit a two run home run in the win...Braydon Tucker took the loss, allowing four runs in six innings...Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz gave up one run in 5.2 innings to earn the win...Devin Saltiban had three hits for Jersey Shore.

Back in the Hudson Valley...The BlueClaws are back at Heritage Financial Park this week (2-2) less than a month after they opened the season there, dropping two of three to the Renegades from April 4-6...This is the BlueClaws second and final visit to Hudson Valley this year, though the teams will play 15 times at ShoreTown Ballpark later this season (next beginning June 17th).

State of the Teams...The BlueClaws have dropped all four series they've played this year, including going 2-3 aginast Brooklyn last week (Saturday's game was rained out)...They have lost eight of their last 12 games entering today...Hudson Valley is 12-4 since beginning the season 5-4...They lost the first two and won the last four last week at Asheville.

On Rehab... C Paul McIntosh (2-run double on Tuesday, 2-5 on Thursday) is with the BlueClaws this week on a rehab assignment from Reading (4-12 in five games with the Fightin Phils)...He was acquired with Jesus Luzardo for Starlyn Caba and Emaarion Boyd in December...C Payton Henry (0-2 on Friday) started a rehab assignment last night from Lehigh Valley 8-23 with the IronPigs)...He played for AAA Buffalo (Blue Jays) last year and signed with

Salti-GONE...2B Devin Saltiban has back to back three-hit games, including a Thursday home run and two doubles on Friday...He has two home runs so far this year, one on Sunday and one on Thursday...He also had three hits on 4/24 (10 for last 27 with four doubles and two home runs after a 2-30 stretch with 13 strikeouts)...Saltiban hit 17 home runs last year with Clearwater

(plus one on rehab with the FCL Phillies)... A 3<sup>rd</sup> round pick in 2023 (Hilo HS in Hilo, Hawaii), he is the #9 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline.

Transactions...RHP Tommy McCollum, who led the BlueClaws with three saves, was promoted to Reading while OF Eduardo Lopez was placed on the 7-day IL.

Ray Ray On a Roll... Raylin Heredia is 16-48 to start the season and has 13 RBIs in 16 appearances... He homered on both Sunday and Thursday, his first two with the BlueClaws after hitting eight with Clearwater last year, giving him 17 career home runs...He has five multi-hit games on the season, one behind Carson DeMartini for the team lead.

Going, Going Gone...Raylin Heredia and Devin Saltiban hit their second home runs of the season on Thursday after they both hit their first home runs of the season on Sunday...Among the four home runs hit by the BlueClaws on Sunday, three were the first of the year for that resective player (Devin Saltiban, Bryson Ware, Raylin Heredia), and for Eduardo Lopez, it was his second...The BlueClaws hit four homers in a game for the first time since July 6th of last year (Emaarion Boyd, Hendry Mendez, Justin Crawford, Leandro Pineda)

DeMartini Heating Up...Since starting the year 2-17, Carson DeMartini is 19-62 though he had an eight-game hitting streak snapped on Tuesday...DeMartini had a three run double in the win on Wednesday at Hudson Valley...He has six multi-hit games in the last two series...He has already drawn 15 walks this year while adding eight stolen bases...DeMartini hit a three run home run to cap a six run seventh inning in the home opener on 4/8 vs Aberdeen.

Lock It Down...Jaydenn Estanista got his first save of the season, and fifth professional save, in the win on Wednesday at Hudson Valley...Tommy McCollum (promoted to Reading on Thursday), who got two strikeouts to end the eighth inning on Wednesday, leads the team with three saves, and has 27 in his career...Paxton Thompson also has one save this year for Jersey

Hip Hip, Hettiger...Kehden Hettiger had two hits including a home run on Friday night and is 10-35 with the BlueClaws, (he hit safely in his first eight BlueClaws appearances, going 10-31, a streak snapped on 5/2 at Hudson Valley)...He joined on 4/16 from Clearwater, where he was 2-25...He homered in his first BlueClaws at bat on 4/17 at Greensboro...His homer on 4/25 was his 7th professional home run after he hit five with Clearwater last year...He is the first BlueClaw to homer in his first game with the team since Logan O'Hoppe homered on 5/4/21 in the first game of his first season with the BlueClaws (second at bat)...Luke Miller (5/24/19 at Delmarva) also homered in his first game with the BlueClaws (second at bat) as did Nick Maton (4/5/18 at Kannapolis, Opening Day, second at bat).

Big Innings...The BlueClaws have allowed four-plus runs in an inning 14 times this season (most of any team in the league), in 12 different games over which they are 1-11 (they have done it three times in this series, twice on Tuesday and once on Friday)...Their lone win in a game in which they allowed four runs in an inning was game two of the 4/12 double-header against Aberdeen, an 8-7 come-from-behind win (Eduardo Lopez go-ahead home run in the 5" of the seven inning game)...They have allowed at least four runs in an inning in five of their last seven games, and lost all five...Eight of the 14 innings have included multiple walks...By comparison, Hudson Valley has four such innings this season (two this week, last on Thursday) and Asheville has 13 (second most in the league) in which they've allowed four or more runs.

Not Grand... After Coby Morales hit one on Tuesday, the BlueClaws have now allowed four grand slams this season, the most of any team in Minor League Baseball (tied with Biloxi, AA Brewers)...This already tied for the second most allowed in a season by the BlueClaws in team history (they gave up six last year).

Luke on the Board...Luke Davis hit his first professional home run, a three-run shot that just missed entering the Chick-fil-A Fan Zone, on April 24th against Brooklyn...The switch-hitting catcher from Garden Grove, California (Orange County) signed with the Phillies last year out of Long Beach City College, where he was the South Coast League MVP...He did not appear in a game last year, and made his pro debut with Jersey Shore on Opening Day, 4/4 at Hudson Valley,

A Walk in the Park... The BlueClaws have four players with double-digit walks so far this year: Bryan Rincon (15 in 90), Carson DeMartini (15 in 98), Luke Davis (14 in 56 plate appearances), and Bryson Ware (11 in 77)...Luke Davis drew four walks on 4/18 at Greensboro, tying a club record and becoming the seventh BlueClaw to draw four walks in a game (most recently McCarthy Tatum on 8/8/21 vs Aberdeen)...Ware had six walks in 106 plate appearances with the BlueClaws in 2024, Rincon had 23 in 140 plate appearances with the BlueClaws last year, while DeMartini had nine in 104 with Clearwater last year.

After this series, the BlueClaws return home on Tuesday to start a six game series with Aberdeen...The IronBirds took four of six from Jersey Shore in their first meeting (4/8 - 4/13).

Comebacks...The BlueClaws win on 4/17 at Greensboro was their first of the season in which they trailed after the 8th inning — they had five such wins last year (last one was 7/21/24 at Brooklyn when they tied the game in the 9th inning on an RBI double from Felix Reyes and scored three times in the 10th)...Meanwhile, the BlueClaws lost a 7-0 lead on 4/18 at Greensboro, their largest blown lead since also losing a 7-0 at Greensboro, on 5/31/15, and the fourth time since 2011 (4/19/12 at Hagerstown and 4/22/11 at Asheville) they have lost

From the Draft... Carson DeMartini is the lone member of the Phillies 2024 draft class to open the season with the BlueClaws (4th round pick, Virginia Tech)...This is the third straight year only one member of the previous year's draft class opened the season with the BlueClaws (2024 – 3B Zach Arnold, 11th round, 2023; 2023 – OF Troy Schreffler, 15th round, 2022)... DeMartini hit the game winning home run in the Spring Breakout game against the Pirates on March 14th...He had 46 home runs at Virginia Tech including 24 as a junior last

New to the Phillies...The BlueClaws roster includes four players that were acquired by the Phillies in the offseason: RHP Augusto Calderon (Minor League Rule-5 from the Cardinals), RHP Aaron Combs (from the White Sox for LHP Tyler Gilbert), OF Dylan Campbell (from the Dodgers for international bonus pool money), and OF Eduardo Lopez (Minor League Rule-5 from the Red Sox)...C Luis Caicuto was a Minor League Rule-5 pick from the Diamondbacks in December of 2023...The Phillies were the only team to use six picks in the 2024 Minor League Rule-5 Draft.

Power Index...Devin Saltiban led all current BlueClaws with 18 home runs in 2024 (17 with Clearwater)...Jordan Viars had 14 last year, 12 with Clearwater and two (both in the final series of the season) with Jersey Shore...Dylan Campbell hit 10 with Great Lakes in the Dodgers system.

Walk-Off This Way ... The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 - most recently July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

Going For Five...The BlueClaws enter 2025 with four straight winning halves, both halves in 2023 and 2024, all four halves managed by Greg Brodzinski...The BlueClaws had 10 straight winning halves from 2006 through 2010, all 10 halves in that five year stretch, a streak snapped when they went 33-35 in the first half

of the 2011 season.

New to ShoreTown...Of the 31 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 13 are making their BlueClaws debuts this season...Of the remaining 18, 14 were with the BlueClaws at the end of the 2024 season (the remaining four were with Reading: RHP Andrew Baker, RHP Tommy McCollum, C Jordan Dissin (since promoted), IF Zach Arnold).

Just Grand...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 - one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...125 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show including two last year (Ben Brown debuted with the Cubs and Sam Aldegheri debuted with the Angels)...Aldegheri, who was with the BlueClaws from Opening Day 2024 through July 6<sup>th</sup>, joins Orion Kerkering (2023) as the only players to ever play for the BlueClaws and in the big leagues in the same vear (non-rehab).

Just Win Baby...The BlueClaws are the only team in the South Atlantic League and High-A to win more than 70 games in both 2023 (73-58) and 2024 (74-58).

Bull Back for a Third...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2025 after leading the BlueClaws to a 73-58 mark in 2023 (and a postseason berth)

and a 74-58 mark in 2024...He is the first manager to lead the BlueClaws in three seasons (PJ Forbes in 2004-05, Steve Roadcap in 2007-08, Mickey Morandini in 2012-13, Shawn Williams in 2015-16 and Marty Malloy in 2017-18 are the five managers to

manage the BlueClaws for two seasons)...Brodzinski was a coach with Lehigh Valley in 2022 and on the Phillies staff in 2020 and 2021...He is a graduate of Bishop Eustace Prep in Pennsauken, New Jersev.

On the Staff... Ryan Buchter joins the BlueClaws as the pitching coach after spending the last two seasons with Lehigh Valley... Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey...Matt Snyder is the hitting coach in his first year in the organization – he was the Assistant Hitting Coordinator for the Marlins last year and in their organization as a coach since 2020...Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws as the Bench Coach...2021-22 BlueClaws C Herbert Iser makes his coaching debut as the Development Coach...Iser played in the Phillies system from 2019 through 2023 and played collegiately at Dallas Baptist.



**About:** 21 year old, 6-4, 190 pound RHP from Dearborn, Michigan **How Acquired:** 4<sup>th</sup> round pick, 2021 draft (Trenton High School, MI)

Season Notes: Gave up one run in three innings with four strikeouts on 4/27 vs BRK...Placed on 7-day IL on 4/16 (ankle sprain), and reinstated on 4/26...Fanned three over four scoreless innings on 4/15 at GBO...Entered season as #27 prospect in system per MLB Pipeline... On Opening Day roster. Career Notes: Spent 2024 with Clearwater, where he went 3-9 with a 4.88 ERA over 19 starts...He struck out 99 and walked 41 in 94 innings pitched...His longest outing was seven innings, on 5/21 at St. Lucie, allowing two runs, and he threw at least six innings five times...His season high-strikeout total was eight on 8/24 vs Dunedin...Threw a combined 14 innings between 2021 and 2023, having Tommy John Surgery in 2022...Committed to Michigan State before signing with the Phillies.

**Strikeout Marks** - Jean Cabrera struck out 14 Wilmington Blue Rocks on 6/12/24, the second-most in a game by a BlueClaws pitcher, behind Jose Taveras' 15 strikeout game on 6/25/16 at Greenville.
