## DIRECTIONS TO DELTA DENTAL STADIUM

**FROM NORTH:** Take I-93 South to I-293 South. Follow I-293 South and take exit 5 (Granite St.) Take a left onto Granite St. and immediately move into the right lane. At light take a right on South Commercial St. Please follow the RIVERFRONT/BALLPARK signs. The ballpark is directly ahead.

**FROM SOUTH via I-93:** Take I-93 North to I-293 North, then follow directions from the East below. Pick up the directions from where I-293 North passes the Mall of New Hampshire and Brown Ave.

**FROM EAST:** Follow Route 101 heading west to I-93 South. Go about a half a mile and stay right, exiting onto I-293 North (right hand exit off I-93S - this exit is not numbered). Once on I-293 North, go past the Mall of New Hampshire and Brown Avenue exits. After crossing the river, stay to the right as I-293N bears right. Turn right onto Granite St. Then take a right onto South Commercial St. Please follow the RIVERFRONT/FISHER CATS BALLPARK signs. The ballpark is directly ahead.

**FROM WEST:** Take Route 101 West to Route 293 North. Follow I-293N and take exit 5 (Granite St.) Turn right at the bottom of the ramp onto Granite St. Take a right onto South Commercial St. Please follow the FISHER CATS BALLPARK signs. The ballpark is directly ahead.

**FROM Rte 3/Everett Tpke:** Follow Route 3 to the Everett Turnpike heading north. Just south of Manchester, this road becomes I-293 North. Follow I-293N and take exit #5 (Granite St.) Turn right at the bottom of the ramp onto Granite St. Take a right onto South Commercial St. Please follow the FISHER CATS BALLPARK signs. The stadium is directly ahead.



## 2023 FISHER CATS BROADCAST NETWORK

---



Steve Goldberg, Gareth Kwok, and Bob Lipman will bring Fisher Cats baseball to the airwaves, with all games airing on the team's flagship station, AM 610 WGIR.

Every home game will also be available in high definition on MiLB.TV.

**Steve Goldberg** returns to the organization as broadcasting and media relations manager. The Boston native and University of Missouri graduate has made stops with the Charleston RiverDogs, Melbourne Aces, Frisco RoughRiders, and Mobile BayBears, where he was named the 2019 Southern League Broadcaster of the Year. Previously, Goldberg worked for Learfield as a broadcast producer and Mississippi State studio host. He also spent two years as the women's basketball radio voice at the University of South Alabama. Goldberg also is a veteran of the Cape Cod Baseball League, calling Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox games in 2014.

**Gareth Kwok** enters his first season as the broadcasting and media relations assistant for the Fisher Cats. Most recently, Kwok was the broadcasting, community and public relations assistant for the Frederick Keys, former High-A affiliate of the Orioles, in Frederick, MD. In the fall and winter, Kwok fills in on play-by-play for Arizona State men's and women's basketball on the Sun Devil Radio Network on Arizona Sports 98.7 FM and KDUS 1060 AM. He is a proud Cape Cod Baseball League alum, serving a summer as a play-by-play broadcaster for the Orleans Firebirds. Kwok is a graduate of the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism at Arizona State University.

**Bob Lipman**, a six-time NSMA New Hampshire Sportscaster of the Year award winner, will also return to the booth. He has been broadcasting games for the Fisher Cats since the team's inaugural season in 2004. He is also the radio voice of UNH Football, the primary basketball broadcaster for Dartmouth College, and an athletic communications assistant at Southern New Hampshire University.

**Pat Cullen** and **Zach Herman** return as the lead producers of Fisher Cats baseball. All 138 games, home and away, will air on iHeartRadio's WGIR 610 AM (Manchester) and Fox Sports 930 WPKX (Rochester). This marks the 16th season of the partnership between the team and radio station.

### **Credential Requests:**

Media sources are recommended to contact Steve at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled game time to ensure that your request will be processed on time for that day's game.

Media that request a daily pass are required to pick up their credentials with the rear parking lot attendant.

Under no circumstances shall the Fisher Cats discriminate, in any fashion, against any accredited member of the media based on race, color, creed, or national origin. If a member of the media violates team policies, the New Hampshire Fisher Cats reserve the right to revoke the media credential.

### **Media Parking:**

Due to limited availability of parking resources, members of the media are instructed to notify Steve Goldberg of their need for parking no later than 4 hours before the start of that day's game.

If a member of the media arrives at the game unexpectedly, the Fisher Cats can not assure a free parking space.

### **Entering Delta Dental Stadium:**

All members of the media are to enter the ballpark at the Suite/Media entrance at the back of the stadium. Media may not pass through clubhouse or dugout area.

### **Press Releases:**

The New Hampshire Fisher Cats are in the practice of emailing all press releases to all media sources. If the ball club does not have your email address, please contact Steve Goldberg at (603) 606-4130 or at [sgoldberg@nhfishercats.com](mailto:sgoldberg@nhfishercats.com).

### **Press Box:**

The Delta Dental Stadium Press Box is located behind homeplate on the suite level (top level) of the Stadium. The elevator to the Press Box is located in the entry corridor at the bottom of the stairwell near the Suite Holder Parking/Entrance.

### **Press Box Work Area:**

The working media have a room reserved for their use. This room is located all the way to the left of the back of the Press Box. If you would like to make other seating arrangements, please communicate this request to Steve Goldberg at (603) 606-4130 or [@nhfishercats.com](mailto:@nhfishercats.com).

### **Press Box Technology:**

The Press Box is wireless internet.

### **Photographer/Camera Work Locations:**

Media sources that require the use of still photography and video imagery are allowed to work in Delta Dental Stadium. The Fisher Cats ask that you respect the fans by making sure that your work area is chosen with the fans' sightlines in mind. The intimacy of the Ballpark makes it difficult to shoot without blocking a fan's sightline, so please be aware of this guideline.

### **Camera Crews are allowed to work in the following locations:**

- \*In the Press Box.
- \*Anywhere in the publicly accessed areas of the Stadium (as long as you do not affect the sightline of any fans).

### **Camera Crews are NOT allowed to work in the following locations:**

- \*Concession Stands
- \*Front Office
- \*Restricted Locations



## **Player Interviews/Accessibility:**

It is very important to the New Hampshire Fisher Cats and Toronto Blue Jays that all players are available to the media for reasonable periods of time, following our policies, before and after games. It is the player's responsibility to cooperate.

Special interview requests are to be submitted to Steve Goldberg at (603) 606-4130 or [sgoldberg@nhfishercats.com](mailto:sgoldberg@nhfishercats.com). Steve will need 24 hours advanced notification to handle special requests.

Media members are not allowed access to the players on the field or in the clubhouse 60 minutes prior to the regularly scheduled game time.

Nearing the completion of the game, members of the media are to notify Steve Goldberg or Gareth Kwok of their desire to interview specific players or team personnel.

There is a 10 minute cool down period following the completion of each game. Media members are not allowed into the clubhouses during this time. The Fisher Cats will have a staff member notify the media when they are allowed to enter the clubhouses. Some games might require more of a cool down period due to team meetings or team business. This will require the media to wait a few minutes longer. The Fisher Cats will do their best to keep these instances to a minimum.

Live interviews, and any requests pertaining to the use of live microphones in the dugouts or on the field, should go through Steve Goldberg and Manager Cesar Martin.

Access to the Visiting clubhouse falls under the same operating procedures except there is no need to notify Steve Goldberg of your request to interview specific players. A visiting broadcaster may be able to assist. There is no interview room in the Visiting clubhouse.

Visitors in the clubhouses are to conduct themselves in a professional manner. There is to be no photography, seeking of autographs, removal of property, or sample of player food spreads.

Clubhouses are work places and business should be conducted in a timely fashion with minimum disruption of team personnel procedures. The clubhouse is a player's sanctuary, and we ask that you please treat it as such.

## **Field Access:**

The working media is allowed field access during batting practice up to 60 minutes prior to the start of the regularly scheduled game time. The media are allowed in foul territory and around the batting cage if they are not impeding with on-field activities. The media is allowed in the dugout as long as they are not preventing the players and staff from doing their jobs. The media may be asked to move from their location at any time if the Fisher Cats organization needs to conduct business in those areas. There will be no media access on the field during the game.

## **Player Roster Moves:**

Steve Goldberg will notify the media of all roster moves. This will be done via email or in the press box, depending on the time of the move. Roster moves are decided and approved by the Toronto Blue Jays, not the New Hampshire Fisher Cats.

## **Player Status Health/Injury:**

All members of the media are required to direct all questions pertaining to the status of a player to the New Hampshire Fisher Cats Manager Cesar Martin. No other member of the organization is authorized to comment on these issues.

## **Food:**

Members of the media covering Fisher Cats games are given a complimentary meal and drink at each game. The Fisher Cats request that this food and drink is only for your consumption only. The media meal is on a first come/first served basis and we ask that you be considerate to the other members of the media when taking your portion. No member of the working media will be served alcoholic beverages.

## **Autographs:**

Requests will be handled on a case-by-case basis.

## **Not Allowed:**

Large Tripods that might be considered trip hazards for fans.  
Alcohol Consumption by working media is always prohibited.
