Scouting Report: The Patriots begin a six-game series at home against the Reading Fightin Phils tonight. Reading owns the league's worst record (4-20) and ERA (6.76). As a team the Fightin Phils are hitting just .199, third worst in all of Double-A.

Caught the Cats: The Somerset Patriots took three of five games against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats at TD Bank Ballpark last week. Somerset won the first game of the series then split a pair of doubleheaders. Two weeks ago, the Fisher Cats took four of six against Somerset.

On Assignment: New York Yankees left-handed relief pitcher Zack Britton tossed a scoreless inning of relief in game one of Saturday's doubleheader. The two-time All-Star relief pitcher became the first player in Somerset Patriots history to make a rehab assignment. It is expected Britton will pitch two to three more times against the Reading Fightin Phils.

A Start to Remember: Somerset plated seven runs in the bottom of the first inning in game two of Saturday's doubleheader. The seven runs were the most the Patriots have scored in an inning this season, while the six hits in the inning marked a season-best and the four walks drawn tied a season high. Overall, the Patriots brought 13 batters to the plate -- the most for a single inning this season. Somerset has scored three or more runs in the first inning five times, including a five-run first inning in the first game of the season.

Hits and Misses: The Patriots pitching staff owns lowest ERA in the second-most strikeouts in all of Double-A with 280. The pitchers have struck out double digit batters in 18 of 23 contests this season, including in nine of their last 11 games. Additionally, the Patriots pitching staff has lowest ERA (2.83) and the second-lowest collective BAA (.191) in all of Double-A baseball.

On the Beltway: Michael Beltre is currently on an 11-game on-base streak, despite his season-best eight-game hit streak ending in game two of Thursday's doubleheader. He has hit .391 (18-for-46) with three home runs, nine RBI and 16 runs scored over the current on-base streak. Beltre currently leads the Double-A Northeast League in triples (3) and runs scored (20), is tied for fifth in the league in total bases (42) and ranks sixth in steals (5).

The Spiel on Gil: RHP Luis Gil earned his first win as a Patriot in game two of Thursday's doubleheader. The No. 4 prospect in the Yankees organization allowed one run and struck out eight batters over six innings -- his longest outing of the season. Gil has allowed four earned runs over 21.1 innings of work this season (1.69 ERA). He currently leads the Double-A Northeast League in strikeouts (36) and fifth in ERA (1.69). Current Patriots starting pitcher Glenn Otto ranks second in the league in strikeouts (35).
