FRES-NOTES

ANOTHA' WALK-OFF WIN: The Fresno Grizzlies (26-18) outlasted the Visalia Rawhide (17-27) 10-9 Sunday afternoon from Chukchansi Park. Fresno enjoyed their fourth walk-off win of the 2024 season thanks to a Jason Hinchman two-run homer in the bottom of the ninth. Four of the last five home victories for the Grizzlies have ended in walk-off triumphs (Sunday, May 12, 1-0, Wednesday, May 22, 6-5, 10 innings and Thursday, May 23, 3-2). The last two home Sundays have also concluded in Fresno walk-off wins (May 12). The comeback claws victory gave the Grizzlies their first series win at Chukchansi Park since August 22-27, 2023 versus Stockton. The Grizzlies improved to 26-4 at home and 47-13 all-time against the Rawhide. Fresno has won 25 of their last 31 contests against their Highway 99 rivals. The clubs combined to score 19 runs on 27 hits, five walks and five errors. Both teams plated alled be least one run in five different innings, while relishing comeback efforts with Fresno uttimately holding on. Fresno went to the ninth tred all least one run in five different innings, while relishing a filled an on-doubter to left-center field, sending the Growifornia crowd home happy. Aidan Longwell, Andy Perez and GJ Hill all supplied three hits with Hill launching a solo shot against his former team as well. Reliever Welinton Herrera picked up his team-best fifth win.

GIANT AMOUNT OF MATCHUPS: The Fresno Grizzlies and San Jose Giants (San Francisco Giants Single-A affiliate) start a six-game series tonight at Excite Ballpark. This is the third of six series between the clubs in 2024 and the second of three sets in San Jose. In the first series of 2024, the Grizzlies enjoyed their first series sweep of the Giants since the California League Playoffs in 2022. Fresno also swept their first series at Excite Ballpark since joining the league in 2021. The Grizzlies are now 52-44 overall in the regular season (2-3 in playoffs) against the Giants since joining the California League.

FROM FRIEND TO FOE: The San Jose Giants have a few names on their coaching staff that the Central Valley may recognize. Giants pitching coach Dan Runzler was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 9th round of the 2007 MLB Draft. He played for the Grizzlies from 2009-14, appearing in 144 games. Runzler pitched in the majors for parts of five seasons (Giants 2009-12, Pirates 2017) before playing overseas and independent ball. Over 97 big league games, he logged a 4-2 record with a 3.89 ERA over 76.1 innings. Another staff member fans may remember is Giants hitting coach Travis Ishikawa. The Giants selected Ishikawa in the 21st round of the 2002 MLB Draft out of Federal Way HS in Washington. Ishikawa played eight MLB seasons starting in 2006 and ending in 2015 with time spent in San Francisco (2006, 2008-10, 2014-15). Ishikawa wore a Grizzlies uniform in 2008, 2011 and 2014, playing in 175 games. The final coach fans may remember is Giants Manager Ydwin Villegas. The always smilling infielder played for the Grizzlies from 2011-14, appearing in 95 games. Villegas batted .208 and had a .962 fielding percentage.

PACHECO PITCHES: Tonight, the Grizzlies give the rock to LHP Albert Pacheco. Last year, Pacheco was assigned to Fresno from the ACL Rockies on June 7 and spent his entire season with the Grizzlies. Pacheco made 14 starts, going 7-4 with a 5.45 ERA. Over 72.2 innings, he struck out 69 batters. The 21-year-old signed as an international free agent by the Rockies in 2019.

HERRERA IS NOT HORSING AROUND: Grizzlies' LHP Welinton Herrera has been unbelievable out of the bullpen this season. Over 15 games, Herrera is 5-1 with a 2.08 ERA and 0.78 WHIP, while opponents are botting .171 against him (069 against lefties; 2-for-29, 15 strike-outs). In 21.2 frames, Herrera has permitted five runs (earned), on 13 hits, four walks and three hit-by-pitches while fanning 39 batters. The southpaw has 13 consecutive scoreless outings from April 12-May 26. Herrera has tossed 19 innings, allowing seven hits, four walks and one hit-by-pitch while punching out 34 in that stretch. The 20-year-old is in his second season stateside and grew up on a ranch with horses in the Dominican Republic.

RISP IS A RISK: In the month of May, the Grizzlies hold a 13-11 record with 87 total runs scored (3.63 runs a game). A big reason for the lack of offense is the Grizzlies' inability to score with runners in scoring position (RISP). Over the 24 games in the month, Fresno is 49-for-212 (.231) with five different instances where the team went 0-fer with runners in scoring position. They have also left 187 runners on base in May.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has had an outstanding season (42 games), going 49-for-169 (.290 AVG/.337 OBP/.444 SLG/.781 OPS) with four homers (one grand slam), three triples, eight doubles, 26 RBI, 19 runs, 12 walks and two stolen bases. Perez had hit safely in his first 18 games and 23 of first 24 games to start the season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockles affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.383 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Perez's triple on April 24th against San Jose was his 10th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him three triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

HITMAN HINCHMAN AND HILL: Grizzlies' OF/1B Jason Hinchman has reached base safely in 19 straight games and 27 of 28 contests this season (April 26-May 26 for the streak). In those 19 games, Hinchman is 16-for-59 (271) with 15 walks. Grizzlies' OF/2B GJ Hill has reached base safely in 13 straight games and 15 of 16 contests since joining Fresno (April 30-May 26 for the streak). In those 13 games, Hill is 10-for-44 (227) with 11 walks.
