

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series with the Harrisburg Senators on Saturday night. It is the fourth-and-fifth-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and fourth-and-fifth-of-six in Reading. Reading won the season-series over Harrisburg last season 7-5, with a 3-3 record at home, and 4-2 on the road. The teams play next in the final week of the regular season in Harrisburg from Sept. 10-15. Reading leads the season-series 2-1.

Luchadores are Victorious

The Figtin Phils grabbed the 2-1 series lead with a 6-3 win over Harrisburg on Friday night. Matt Osterberg tossed 5.2 innings and allowed two-earned runs. The bullpen combined to not allow a run over the final 3.1 innings. Marcus Lee Sang, Carlos De La Cruz, Carson Taylor and Robert Moore all had two hits. Lee Sang had a double and two runs scored. De La Cruz scored two runs and drove in two on his third home run of the season. Carson Taylor knocked in his league-leading 41st RBI of the season. Robert Moore had two doubles to match a season-high for him,

Carlos De La Crushed

Carlos De La Cruz stayed hot with his third home run of the season on Friday night. The the game, De La Cruz had two hits, two runs scored and two RBI. Over his last two games, De La Cruz is 4-7, with four runs, two doubles, one home run and four RBI. After spending much of the 2023 in the two spot in the lineup, De La Cruz has found success in returning to the two hole. Over 10 games this season batting second, De La Cruz is hitting .156, with four extra-base hits and six RBI. De La Cruz has reached base in nine-straight games, dating back to May 26. Over that stretchm, he's hitting .300, with a .975 OPS.

Caleb Crushed It

Fightin Phils Catcher Caleb Ricketts had two home runs in Thursday night's win over Harrisburg. It marked the first multi-homer game of Ricketts career, since being drafted by the Phillies in 2022. It was also the fifth time this season a member of the Fightin Phils hit two home runs in a game. Ricketts is currently on a 12-game on-base streak, dating back to May 19. Over that stretch, Ricketts is slashing .304/.407/.543, with a .950 OPS. He's also added eight runs, two doubles, three home runs and 13 RBI. Ricketts .290 batting average would be second amongst Eastern League catchers, but he does not qualify.

Moore Please

Robert Moore's recent hot-streak continued on Friday night. Moore matched a season-high two doubles and also scored a run. Moore now leads Reading with 11 doubles on the season and ranks tied for 14th in the Eastern League in that mark. Across five gmaes in June, Moore is slashing .467/.579/1.067, with a 1.646 OPS. Moore has added four runs, two doubles, two home runs and seven RBI. Also included in June was a two home run night at Hartford on June 1, which also featured the first grand slam of Moore's professional career.

Packing the House

The Fightin Phils welcomed 8,805 fans last night to America's Classic Ballpark. That set a new season high, surpassing Opening Night, April 9, mark of 8,510. It is the largest crowd since May 27, 2023, against Harrisburg, when 8,959 fans came to FirstEnergy Stadium for Harry Potter Night. Currently, the Fightin Phils have the second-highest average attendance in the Eastern League at 5,969 fans per game, trailing on Richmond. Reading currently has the third-highest total attendance in the league at 149,233, which trails just Richmond and Portland. Reading is currently on pace to welcome 393,954 fans this season, which would surpass last seasons total of 385,478.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 8, 1967: At Reading, the R-Phils take on the big Phils in the first ever exhibition game between the two teams. A record crowd of 8,201 jam Municipal Stadium to watch the Double-A Phils top their Major League counterparts, 8-4.

Coming from the Capital

Harrisburg enters tonight in second place in the Eastern League's Southwest Divison with a 31-23 record. The Senators are on the back-half of a two-week road trip, after splitting a six-game series at Binghamton last week. Following this week, Harrisburg returns home and welcomes Bowie to FNB Field. Harrisburg's roster features 10 players ranked amongst the Washington Nationals' top-30 prospects: Dylan Crews (2), Brady House (3), Yohandy Morales (4), Robert Hassell III (8), Andrew Pinckney (17), Cole Henry (21), Israel Pineda (22), Dustin Saenz (25), Andry Lara (28) and Marquis Grissom (29).

Senators Pitcher

Righty Kyle Luckham makes the start in game one for Harrisburg. This season, Luckham is 2-3, with a 4.04 ERA over 10 starts (55.2 IP, 57 H, 13 BB, 35 SO). Luckham last pitched June 2 at Binghamton and was strong in a no-decision. He allowed one run on six hits and three strikeouts. Luckham split 2023 between High-A Wilmington and Harrisburg. He made one start for Harrisburg and 25 appearances for the Blue Rocks. Overall, he was 5-7, with a 4.87 ERA. He began his pro career in 2022 between the FCL-Nationals and Single-A Fredericksburg. The Nationals selected Luckham in the 15th round of the 2022 draft out of Arizona State. Righty Samuel Reyes is scheduled to open game two for Harrisburg in what will be a bullpen game for the Senators.

Picked up season-best to date seven punchouts Apr. 13 vs Portland, but suffered loss as he gave up five-earned runs over just three innings pitched. Was efficient, throwing 40-of-63 pitches for strikes in loss. Twirled best start of season to date Apr. 19 at BNG. Matched season-high with five innings and set new-season best with nine strikeouts in the win. Tossed best outing of season on Apr. 25 vs SOM, earning second-straight win. Threw season-high six innings and did not allow a run, with five hits scattered. Earned third-straight win May 4 at Portland. Season-high 11 strikeouts, which was the most in a game by a R-Phils since 2018 season. Picked up fourth-straight win May 8 vs Hartford. Streak of four-straight winning decisions snapped with loss May 18 at RIC. Allowed two runs on seven hits. Lasted just four innings as he fell victim to high pitch count. 2024 Notes: On Fightin Phils Opening Day Roster. Hit around in Apr. 6 loss at Bowie. Allowed eight-earned runs on seven hits in just 2.1 innings pitched. Eight runs allowed were a career high. Struggled in second-straight outing on Apr. 13 vs Portland. Allowed five-earned runs, including two more homers, while suffering second-straight loss. Also racked up season-high four walks and four strikeouts. Four walks was one shy of career-high. Was on Development List from Apr. 14-21. Struggled with comman Apr. 21 at Binghamton, lasing just 2.2 innings and walking four for second-straight outing. Placed on 7-day II. Apr. 23 and activated prior to start on May 8. Best outing of season May 8 vs Hartford, where he tossed season-high 4.1 innings pitched in no-decision. Lasted just one-plus inning May 16 at RIC, allowing five hits and six runs in loss to Flying Squirrels. Allowed three-earned runs over four innings May 21 vs BNG. First win of season came in best outing of year May 26 vs BNG. Pitched four innings out of bullpen, serving as bulk guy behind Kolby Allard. Struck out season-high eight hitters and allowed just one walk and run. Came out of bullpen for second-straight outing May 31 at HFD, allowing three runs over four innings.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Signed a minor league contract with the San Diego Padres as an International Free Agent on July 8, 2017. Elected free agency from the Padres on November 6, 2023. Signed a minor league contract with the Philadelphia Phillies on December 16, 2023.

2023: Spent the entire season with Double-A San Antonio in the Padres organization. Led the team in strikeouts and innings pitched. Earned his first win since 2019 on May 11 against Corpus Christi, pitching six innings, allowing no-earned runs, and picking up eight strikeouts. Had a 3.88 strikeout to walk ratio (31 SO, 8 BB) in five May starts and struck out 31.8% of the batters faced (34-107) in five June starts. Had at least six strikeouts in seven-straight games from May 23 through June 28, which was tied for the longest such streak in the Texas League. Pitched in one postseason game.

2022: Made all his appearances with High-A Fort Wayne after starting the season on the injured list. Posted a 2.45 ERA (5 ER, 18.1 IP) and a 0.93 WHIP (10 H, 7 BB) in five appearances (four starts) for Peoria in the Arizona Fall League.

2021: Missed the entire season recovering from Tommy John Surgery. 2020: Did not pitch as season was cancelled due to COVID-19 Pandemic.

2019: Spent the season with Single-A Fort Wayne. Went 3-0 with a 2.81 ERA (8 ER, 25.2 IP) and limited hitters to a .194 average (18-93) in five May starts.
