LATE HITTING PUSHES JACKSONVILLE TO 9-5 WIN
The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp clubbed three homers and plated four runs in the eighth inning to come away with a $9-5$ win over the Memphis Redbirds Thursday night. With the game tied entering the eighth inning, Jacksonville (15-9) pulled away from Memphis (10-13) courtesy of some clutch hitting. Dane Myers led off the inning with a base hit off Redbirds reliever Kyle Leahy (L, O-2). Jhonny Pereda doubled in the ensuing at-bat and Myers scored from first to give the Jumbo Shrimp a late 6-5 lead. Marty Costes followed with a base hit, plating Pereda for a two-run advantage. Following a sacrifice bunt from Jonathan Guzman, Victor Mesa Jr. (4) crushed a two-run home run to give Jacksonville a four-run cushion, 9-5.

## ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

 After homering last night, Jonah Bride has now homered four times in his last nine games. Bride began the season with Miami, batting just 1-for-7 in five games before getting optioned to Jacksonville. Since coming to the First Coast, Bride is 24 -for- $63(.381 / .519 / .778 / 1.297)$ with seven doubles, six home runs, 12 RBIs, 14 walks and 11 runs scored. Bride ranks first in the International League in on-base percentage, first in OPS, third in slugging percentage and third in batting average.
## SCORING IN BUNCHES

Jacksonville has scored a run in 58 of their 214 offensive innings thus far in 2024. Over those 58 innings, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored multiple runs in over half of those, a total of 29 frames. The club's biggest inning came during a sevenrun fifth inning on April 17 against Norfolk. Outside of that, the Jumbo Shrimp have logged two five-run innings, five four-run innings, seven frames of three runs and 16 two-run innings.

## SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 24 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 116 runs ( 4.8 per game), in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 51-for-216 (.236/.337/.380/.717, ranking 23rd, 24th, 24th and 24th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

## DANE TIME

Heading into play on Thursday, Jacksonville outfielder Dane Myers is riding a 20 -game on-base streak, the third-longest such run in the International League this season. Myers got off to a slow start on this streak; over the first eight games of the streak, he went just 6 -for- 29 (.207/.343/.207/.550) with one RBI and four walks. In the 13 games since, though, the Katy, Texas native is 21 -for-74 (.284/.391/.378/.769) with four doubles, one home run, seven RBIs, 11 walks and 16 runs scored. On the season, Myers' 58.0 percent ground ball rate is the 4th-highest among the 148 qualifiers in the International League. His ground ball rate was 46.6 percent in 2023 with Jacksonville.

## FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 14 of Jacksonville's 24 games ( 58.3 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled in these contests, going 11-3 (.786) in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games ( 57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over . 500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

## TEN COMMANDMENTS

Jacksonville began the season by losing two of three games against Gwinnett, but since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have won 14 of their last 21 games. 10 of those 14 victories have come by three runs or fewer, with Jacksonville actually being outscored by their opponents by a $84-83$ margin. The Jumbo Shrimp's pitching has excelled during this stretch, with the club placing third in ERA (4.19) in Triple-A during this stretch.

## SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has just six stolen base attempts and five stolen bases in the 16 games since April 5. Both figures are the fewest in Triple-A... Jumbo Shrimp starters have worked 107.2 innings this season, with the club's relievers combining for 106.1 frames. Thus, Jacksonville's starters have combined for 50.3 percent of the team's innings pitched... The Jumbo Shrimp's $24.7 \mathrm{AB} / \mathrm{HR}$ ranks sixth in Triple-A and their 33 home runs ranks T-4th in Triple-A.

-The Miami Marlins' first-round pick in 2016, Garrett made his professional debut in 2017 but lasted just four starts until an injured elbow forced him to undergo Tommy John Surgery. Garrett went under the knife on June 20, 2017 and missed the rest of the 2017 campaign, as well as the entirety of the 2018 season. While rehabbing, however, he roomed with fellow Marlins prospect Jordan Holloway, who had underwent Tommy John Surgery just five days before Garrett did so.
-Garrett began his high school career at Foley High School in Alabama. However, he moved to Florence when his father, Steve, became the Florence Falcons' head baseball coach.
-Under the tutelage of his father, Garrett was named Alabama's Mr. Baseball as a junior and the state's Gatorade Player of the Year and a first team USA Today AllAmerican as a senior, when he posted a 0.53 ERA with 131 strikeouts in 65.1 innings.

## 2024 SEASON

-Began rehab assignment from a left shoulder impingement on April 5 for Jacksonville.

## 2023 SEASON

-Garrett began the 2023 season as a long reliever but joined the Marlins starting rotation in April 2023 after Johnny Cueto injured his right biceps.
-Right-handed hitters batted .261/.300/.448/.748 against him in 503 plate appearances, but Garrett held left-handed batters to a .211/.276/.324/.600 line in 156 plate appearances.

## 2022 SEASON

-In the major leagues, right-handed hitters batted .280/.346/.455/.801 against him in 284 plate appearances. However, Garrett held southpaws to a .173/.247/.235/.482 mark in 90 plate appearances.

## 2021 SEASON

-Garrett was promoted on May 15 to Miami. He made a three-inning relief appearance that night at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles before being optioned back to Jacksonville the following day. The Marlins have recalled and optioned Garrett several more times throughout the 2021 season.
-Garrett's best major league start came on July 24 against San Diego, a game in which he yielded just two runs on four hits in 7.0 innings with 10 strikeouts against one walk.

## 2020 SEASON

-Garrett made his major league debut for the Marlins in game two of a doubleheader on September 13, 2020 against the Philadelphia Phillies. He ceded just one run on three hits in five innings, striking out six against two walks.
-The southpaw made one additional MLB start one week later, in the backend of a doubleheader against the Washington Nationals. However, Garrett surrendered five runs, four earned, on five hits and three walks in 2.2 frames.

## ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Had he not decided to turn pro, Garrett had signed to pitch at Vanderbilt University.
