INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: After a series win at Victory Field last week against Buffalo, the Indianapolis Indians bats could not overcome an early deficit in a series opening loss to the Louisville Bats at Louisville Slugger Field on Tuesday night, 6-2 Indians starter Eric Lauer got two quick outs to open the bottom of the third inning, but on the heels of a single from Livan Soto and a walk issued to Rece Hinds, Bats designated hitter Edwin Ríos clubbed a three-run, 428-foot shot to straight-away center field to open scoring. The Bats struck again late with back-to-back RBI doubles from Blake Dunn and Soto in the seventh, before Indianapolis broke up the shutout bid with Nick Gonzales' fourth homer of the season. Peyton Burdick capped the Louisville run production with a solo home run in the eighth.

RAKE LAMB: Jake Lamb went 1-for-3 last night to extend his hitting streak to eight games since 4/25. He has now reached base safely in 24 of 25 games this season and leads the International League in batting average (.400, 32-for-80) and on-base percentage (.485). He also ranks fourth among leaders with a 1.085 OPS. During his hitting streak, he owns a .414 batting average (12-for-29) with seven runs, four doubles, one home run and six RBI. Since 4/18, when his current 13-game on-base streak began, he is hitting .463 (19-for-41) with nine runs, six doubles, one home run, 11 RBI, eight walks, a .519 on-base percentage and 1,202 OPS.

GONZO FOR EXTRA BASES: Nick Gonzales, who trails teammate Jake Lamb as the International League's second-best hitter with a .364 batting average (43-for-118) this season, doubled twice on Sunday to lead the league with 14 two-baggers and launched his fourth home run of the season to break up the shutout bid last night. Gonzales went 2-for-4 as one of two Indians batters to log extra-base hits, good for his 13th multi-hit performance in 28 games with the Indians. In addition to batting average and doubles, Gonzales also ranks among IL leaders in runs (1st, 32), hits (T-1st, 43), extra-base hits (3rd, 20), total bases (3rd, 73), slugging percentage (6th, .619) and OPS (6th, 1.043).

GILBERTO GOING OFF: Gilberto Celestino recorded his third consecutive multi-hit performance last night at Louisville, going 2-for-3 with a run scored. In his past three games, he is 7-for-9 with four runs scored, an RBI and walk. With the performances, he raised his batting average for the season from .241 on May 2 to .293 (27-for-91). The outfielder opened the season with a seven-game hitting streak and has logged six total multi-hit performances since going 3-for-4 on 3/31 at Louisville.

TODAY: The Indians will look to tie the six-game series at Louisville today in an 11:05 AM contest at Louisville Slugger Field. The Bats took two of three meetings during the opening series between the two teams from 3/29-3/31 and lead the season series, 3-1. Continuing the series for the Indians today is LHP Cam Alldred (1-3, 8.14), making his 11th career appearance (third start) against Louisville. Countering for the Bats is RHP Connor Phillips (2-2, 8.64), who gave up give runs in 4.0 innings against Indianapolis on Opening Night.

ALLDRED VS. THE BATS: Cam Alldred has been an effective force against Louisville in his career, going 4-0 with a 3.90 ERA (12er/27.2ip) and 24 strikeouts in 10 games (two starts) since making his Triple-A debut at Louisville on 9/8/21. Alldred's last appearance at Louisville Slugger Field came on 6/29/23, when he spun a quality start and career-high eight strikeouts to earn the win. In four games (one start) in Louisville, he is 2-0 with a 2.77 ERA (4er/13.0ip) and 13 strikeouts.

WELCOME HOME: University of Louisville product Henry Davis returns to his college town after being optioned by Pittsburgh last week. Davis began the season on the Pirates' Opening Day roster and hit .162 (11-for-68) with seven runs, three doubles and four RBI in 23 games with the big-league club before being optioned last week. In 14 career Triple-A games with Indy last season, he hit .375 (18-for-48) with seven runs, six extra-base hits, a .516 on-base percentage and 1.120 OPS. He was the first baseball player from Louisville to be selected first overall and the fourth student-athlete taken No. 1 overall from the school regardless of sport.

SNAKE EYES: Henry Davis (2021 First-Year Player Draft) joins right-hander Paul Skenes (2023) as two No. 1 overall draft picks on Indianapolis' roster. He and Skenes are the fourth and fifth first overall draft picks to appear with Indianapolis in franchise history, following right-handed pitchers Tim Belcher (1983 No. 1 overall, pitched for Indy in 1995), Bryan Bullington (2002 No. 1 overall, pitched for Indy in 2005, 2007-08) and Gerrit Cole (2011 No. 1 overall, pitched for Indy in 2012-14, 2016).

NEWBIES: Outfielder Matt Fraizer and right-handed pitcher Isaac Mattson were promoted from Double-A Altoona today ahead of Indianapolis' seriesopener at Louisville. Fraizer is set to make his Triple-A debut after spending the last two seasons with the Curve. Mattson was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent in the offseason and owns a career 1-2 record, 5.89 ERA (29er/44.1ip) and 57 strikeouts in 42 Triple-A appearances.

THIS DATE IN 1950: Indianapolis starting pitcher Bill Pierro took a no-hitter into the eighth inning until center fielder Archie Wilson broke up the bid with a two-out single for the Kansas City Blues. That was the only hit allowed by Pierro in his 9.0-inning complete-game effort that featured nine strikeouts.

Cam is the Man: Cam Alldred spent the 2023 season as the Indians' ultimate go-to man, making 17 starts and 14 appearances out of the bullpen. He recorded his first career quality start on 6/16 at lowa (6.0ip, 2r) to kick off a stretch of three consecutive such starts and four total on the season. He went 3-7 with a 4.44 ERA (39er/79.0ip) and 74 strikeouts as a starter and 5-1 with a 7.43 ERA (22er/26.2ip) and 24 strikeouts in relief.
