TONIGHT'S RODEO

Round Rock and Sugar Land will play game five of the series on Saturday from Round Rock. Express RHP Spencer Howard is slated to start against Space Cowboys RHP Shawn Dubin. First pitch at Dell Diamond is scheduled for 6:05 p.m. CT.

TOOK EM' TO THE TRAIN STATION

Express 2B Justin Foscue led off with a home run in the bottom of the first to give the E-Train a 1-0 lead. Foscue homered again in the second to give Round Rock a 4-0 advantage. The Express added an insurance run in the fourth inning after C Matt Whately's sacrifice fly made it a 5-0 game. The Space Cowboys got a run back in the fifth frame after SS Rylan Bannon scored on the second wild pitch of the frame to cut the lead to 5-1. In the fifth, CF Bubba Thompson was hit by a pitch and stole two bases. He was caught in a rundown between third base and home plate on a grounder from DH Sam Huff. Thompson somehow scored to extend the lead to 6-1. RF Elmer Hernandez doubled to score Huff and increase the lead to 7-1. In the seventh, Hernandez smashed a two-run home run to make it a 9-1 game. RHP Jonathan Hernandez and RHP Fer Ozuna each tossed an inning to collect the final six outs.

PROTECTING THE BRAND

Express RHP Spencer Howard is slated to make his second start of the season for the E-Train. Howard has made five of his six appearances at home this year. At Dell Diamond, he owns a 2.79 ERA (3 ER/9.2 IP). In his lone road outing and lone start this year at Las Vegas on July 1, Howard allowed two earned runs on two hits with one home run.

EPISODE 50 SETS A NEW RECORD

With yesterday's win, the Express hit the 50-game win mark 84 games into the season. Fifty wins at game 84 is tied for the second-fastest the Express have reached 50 wins in Triple-A history after doing it in 2019. The fastest that Round Rock has hit the 50-win mark came in 2006, when it took the team 81 games to achieve 50 victories.

FOSS RUNS THE RANCH

Express 2B Justin Foscue posted his second multi-homer game of the season on Friday. Foscue hit two home runs on May 27 at Albuquerque. It is the fourth multi-homer game of his career. He posted a 2-for-4 night with four RBI, two runs scored and a walk. Foscue is riding a four-game hitting streak.

JOHN DUTTON OF ROUND ROCK

DH Sam Huff finished the night 3-for-4 with a double, an RBI and a run scored. In five games since he was optioned from the Texas Rangers, Huff is 13-for-21 with four doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, six runs scored and four walks. The right-hander is 10 hits away from 500 in his minor league career. In 63 games for Round Rock last year, Huff had four doubles. He has 10 doubles in 46 games this season.

COWBOYS OF SUMMER

Since June 1, the Express have the best record among Triple-A clubs at 22-9. They lead the Pacific Coast League in ERA (4.64) and the offense leads the league in runs scored (244). The E-Train also lead all Triple-A clubs in home runs (59), slugging percentage (.538) and OPS (.931) during this stretch. Since June 1, the Louisville Bats are the next closest team in OPS (.902).

HERDING THE CATTLE

Round Rock RHP Ian Kennedy and RHP Ryan Tepera bring over 800 Major League games to the Express bullpen. In four games, Kennedy owns a 4.50 ERA (3 ER/6.0 IP) and tossed a scoreless inning with two strikeouts last night. In six games, Tepera is 4-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER/7.0 IP). He struck out the side in his inning of work on Thursday.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

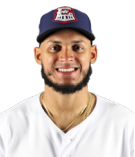
