### GAME RECAP:

Jhailyn Ortiz hit a walk-off single in the bottom of the 11th inning to send the R-Phils home in celebration as they defeated the Bowie Baysox 11-10 at home on Friday. Ortiz and Ockimey both had homers in the contest, while McKinley Moore took home the win in the R-Phils first extra innings victory.

### EXTRAS EXTRAS:

Every game played by affiliates of the Philadelphia Phillies on Friday went into extra innings. Jhailyn Ortiz's hit in the bottom of the eleventh inning sent the Fightins home with an 11-10 win at home. The Philadelphia Phillies beat the Dodgers 12-10 in 10 innings and the Clearwater Threshers (A) defeated the Daytona Tortugas 9-8 in 10 innings. The Jersey Shore Blue Claws (A+) and the Lehigh Valley Ironpigs both lost by one run and in 10 innings.

### DEFENSIVE SHOWCASE:

Reading's defense was clicking on all cylinders last night as three Baysox runners were thrown out by the home team's outfielders. From right field, Jhailyn Ortiz gunned down a runner at third base and one attempting to score. Aldrem Corredor threw out a Bowie runner at third base from left field. Three outfield assists are the most the team's had in a single game this season. Ortiz's two are his first of the season and Jack Conley leads the team with four outfield assists in 2022.

### ORTIZ IN MAY:

Jhailyn Ortiz hit his stride at the plate so far in May. So far this month, Ortiz has batted .372 with an on-base percentage of .449, 16 hits, 12 RBIs and 10 runs scored. This week against the Baysox, he hit the first grand slam of the season and had the walk-off hit in the eleventh inning. Ortiz currently leads the team with 29 hits, 21 runs, 19 RBIs and 7 home runs.

### BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:

The Phillies defeated the Dodgers 8-3 on the road last night to clinch a series win. Bryce Harper and former R-Phil Rhys Hoskins each had 3 hits, including a home run apiece. The Phillies hit a total of four home runs on Saturday. Jean Segura and Kyle Schwarber each went yard in addition to Harper and Hoskins. Ranger Suarez went seven innings for the win, giving up five hits and three earned runs while striking out six batters.

### ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALLTOWN HISTORY:

**May 15-16, 2018:** At Reading, the Fightin Phils win a crazy game that was originally scheduled to be played in Portland and then took 2 days and extra innings to complete at FirstEnergy Stadium. On May 15, the Sea Dogs looked certain to sweep a doubleheader after they won the first game 8-4 and took a 7-0 lead into the 6th inning of game 2. But the Fightin Phils (wearing their grey uniforms and playing as the visiting team) rallied for 7 in the 6th, tying the game on Brandon Bednar's 3-run homer after he entered the game because Emmanuel Marrero didn't run out a popup in the 5th. The homer was Bednar's second of the day - he had hit his first of the season in game 1. Cord Sandberg's 2-run homer in the top of the 9th gave Reading its first lead, but a severe thunderstorm halted the game in the middle of the 9th as the grounds crew battled to keep the tarp from sailing away in a wild scene. With Berks County high school semifinals also scheduled for that night, the game was suspended and finally completed the next morning (after a rain-delayed start). Seth McGarry struck out Chad De La Guerra with the tying run on 3rd to complete the 9-8 victory.
