**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Akron RubberDucks, 9-5, at Canal Park. The Flying Squirrels struck first in the fourth with a sac fly from **Frankie Tostado**, but left the bases loaded. In the bottom of the fourth, Akron scored its only five runs of the game. Bo Naylor reached on catcher interference with the bases loaded to bring in the tying run. Chris Roller hit a two-run single and Jose Fermin added a two-run double to give the Ducks a 5-1 lead. In the sixth, **Will Wilson** hit an RBI single to bring Richmond back within three runs. **Diego Rincones** hit a three-run homer, his third in the last three games, to tie the score, 5-5, in the sixth. In the eighth, Wilson gave the Flying Squirrels the lead with a two-run single. Two more runs scored in the frame on two separate wild pitches. Relievers **Patrick Ruotolo**, **Joey Marciano** and **Jose Marte** each pitched a scoreless inning.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. The series is the first of the year between the two teams and the Flying Squirrels' only visit to Canal Park this year. The Flying Squirrels are 16-15 in games against the Southwest Division, including an 8-5 mark in road games. Richmond is 22-15 in games following a win and 3-6 in day games.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won 12 of their last 16 games. They are tied for second place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 1.0 game behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .237 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked tied for third in the league with a 3.90 ERA for the season.

**THE RUBBERDUCKS** have won six of their last nine games but have lost three of the last four. They are currently in first place in the Southwest Division, 1.0 game ahead of Bowie, Erie and Richmond. Akron's offense is ranked third in the league with a .259 batting average. The pitching staff has the league's second-best ERA at 3.86. The Akron roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Cleveland Indians prospects, including SS Tyler Freeman (No. 2), C Bo Naylor (No. 3), RHP Ethan Hankins (No. 9 - on IL), RHP Carlos Vargas (No. 17 - on IL), LHP Joey Cantillo (No. 21 - on IL), LHP Logan Allen (No. 22) and 2B/OF Richie Palacios (No. 28).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Caleb Kilian** makes his tenth Double-A start. Last time out, he worked 5.2 innings and allowed two runs, both in the sixth inning, in a no-decision against Somerset on Thursday. After throwing the first complete-game shut-out of the season on July 9 at Bowie, Kilian was named Double-A Northeast Pitcher of the Week on July 12. He opened the season with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.25 ERA in four starts with 32 strikeouts in 21.2 innings. He was named High-A West Pitcher of the Week twice in the three weeks he spent with the Emeralds. He was drafted by the Giants in the eighth round in 2019 out of Texas Tech, where he was a First-Team All-Big 12 pitcher. **For more on Kilian, see page two.**

**KILIAN RANKED:** Among Double-A pitchers with at least 50.0 innings pitched this season, **Caleb Kilian** is ranked second in ERA (2.21), first in BB/9 (1.19), first in K/BB (7.43), first in HR/9 (0.17), third in K% (25.5), first in BB% (3.4), tied for third in BAA (.214), tied for first in WHIP (0.92), first in FIP (2.28), first in GB/FB (1.68), first in complete games (2) and first in shutouts (1)

**FOR AKRON:** Right-hander **Cody Morris** makes his third Double-A start and his Canal Park debut. After an injury this spring, Morris got his season started on a rehab assignment in the Arizona League on July 1 against the AZL White Sox, allowing two runs (one earned) with 12 strikeouts in 4.1 innings. He was reinstated on July 6 and made his Double-A debut two days later, firing 4.0 scoreless innings at Altoona. In his second and most recent outing, Morris tossed 4.0 scoreless innings last Wednesday at Harrisburg, striking out six with no walks. Morris was drafted by Cleveland in the seventh round in 2018 out of the University of South Carolina. He made his professional debut in 2019, splitting the season between Low-A Lake County and High-A Lynchburg, combining to go 7-4 with a 4.35 ERA in 21 outings (20 starts).

**RAMOS MOVIN' UP:** Outfielder **Heliot Ramos** was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento today. Over his last 11 games from July 4-18, Ramos hit .310 (13-for-42) with five homers, four doubles and 11 RBIs while scoring 11 runs. Last Thursday, he hit a 448-foot homer over the batters' eye in center field at The Diamond. On Sunday, he hit his second homer in the four games, a solo shot to right field. He began the season hitting .314 with three homers and 12 RBIs in 22 May games. In June, he posted a .155 batting average and homered twice with three RBIs in 26 games. Ramos represented the Giants and the Flying Squirrels at the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Coors Field on July 11.

**POWER SURGE:** Over the last 13 games since July 6, the Flying Squirrels have hit 23 home runs, which is the most in the Double-A Northeast. **Vince Fernandez** has hit six homers in his 11 games played during that stretch. **Heliot Ramos** has hit four homers in that span and **Diego Rincones** has three. **Sandro Fabian** and **Frankie Tostado** each have two homers. **Andres Angulo**, **Brandon Martorano**, **Andy Sugilio**, **David Villar**, **Simon Whiteman** and **Will Wilson** have each hit one homer in that span. For the season, the Flying Squirrels ranked tied for sixth in the circuit with 74 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 133 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 108 in 2013. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Fernandez leads the team with 13 home runs this season. In 2019, **Gio Brusa** led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season. This year, the team has combined for a .396 slugging percentage, which would be the highest in the franchise's history.

**SWINGING FOR THE VINCE:** In his last 14 games since June 30, **Vince Fernandez** is batting .432 (19-for-44) with six home runs, two doubles and 17 RBIs. Fernandez is ranked first on the team with 12 homers this season and second with 33 RBIs. He has homered three times in the last five games. Last Wednesday against the Patriots, Fernandez went 4-for-5 with a homer, a double, a walk and five RBIs, capping his performance with a walk-off single in the bottom of the 11th inning. It was the 18th five-RBI performance by a Flying Squirrels hitter in the franchise's history and the second this season. On Friday, he hit a game-winning, two-run homer in the bottom of the eighth inning to top Somerset, 6-4. He added a solo home run to center on Saturday night.

**TOASTY:** Over his last 33 games since June 6, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .312 (39-for-125) with seven homers, eight doubles and 32 RBIs. Tostado is tied for eighth in the league with 42 RBIs this season and ranks tied for ninth with 62 hits. He leads qualified Richmond batters with a .284 batting average for the season. Tostado is playing his first season at Double-A, skipping over the High-A level after spending 2019 with Low-A Augusta.

**BREAKING OUT:** **David Villar** has hit .333 (36-for-108) with six homers and 15 RBIs over his last 29 games since June 16. He has hit .318 (7-for-22) in six games during last week's series against Somerset, picking up four doubles. For the season, Villar is second on the team with 11 homers and third with 31 RBIs.

**GO, DIEGO, GO!:** **Diego Rincones** hit his first Double-A home run on Saturday against Somerset, a three-run shot in the second inning that tied the game, 3-3, in a 7-3 Flying Squirrels win. He followed with a two-run, go-ahead homer in the bottom of the eighth inning in the series finale against Somerset on Sunday night in an 8-7 win. On Tuesday, he belted a game-tying three-run homer at Akron. Rincones has picked up 10 RBIs in his last five games dating back to last Wednesday.

**PITCHERS WHO RAKE:** For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with nine hits, six walks and six RBIs by pitchers at the plate. On the year, Richmond has gone 26-16 (.619) against National League affiliates, but have gone 12-13 (.480) against affiliates of American League clubs. The Flying Squirrels now face American League clubs for the remaining four sets in July and will use the designated hitter.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Vince Fernandez** is ranked tied for sixth with 13 home runs. **Frankie Tostado** is ranked tied for eighth in the Double-A Northeast with 42 RBIs and tied for ninth with 62 hits. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for fifth with 11 stolen bases. **Frank Rubio** and **Joey Marciano** are tied for fifth with 23 games pitched. **RJ Dabovich**, **Norwith Gudino** and **Patrick Ruotolo** are tied for seventh in the circuit with five saves. **Caleb Kilian** is ranked first in complete games (2) and shutouts (1).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (13), **Sean Hjelle** (14) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system. Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Five players, including Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
