SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

THE COMEBACK KIDS: The Shuckers picked up their third-straight comeback win on Wednesday, scoring three runs in the bottom of the eighth in a 5-4 win over the Chattanooga Lookouts... **OF Noah Campbell** delivered the go-ahead two-RBI double off Cincinnati Reds No. 27 prospect RHP Zach Maxwell... Campbell faced four straight pitches at 100+ MPH before lining his two-RBI single... Four of Biloxi's seven wins have come in comeback fashion, including three of their four home games... In two of the three games, the Shuckers completed the comeback in the eighth inning or later.

WWWWINNING WAYS: The Shuckers enter today with five straight wins, the fourth-longest active win streak in Minor League Baseball and the second-longest in the Southern League in 2024... Over the five-game win streak, the Shuckers have outscored opponents 22-9, including a 1.60 ERA from the pitching staff... Over that span, the Shuckers ran second in Double-A in on-base percentage (.386) and tied for fourth in stolen bases (11).

IT'S BEEN A MINUTE: RHP James Meeker picked up his second-career Double-A save and his 25th save in Minor League Baseball with two scoreless outs in the ninth inning on Wednesday... The save was Meeker's first since May 21, 2023 against the Chattanooga Lookouts when he closed out a 10-inning win at AT&T Field... Meeker previously had 17 saves with High-A Wisconsin during the 2022 season, a career-best.

ONE RUN DARLINGS: The Shuckers picked up their fourth one-run win of the season on Wednesday, tied with the Arkansas Travelers of the Texas League for the most in Double-A... The Shuckers have played five one-run games in 2024, tied with the Mississippi Braves for the most in the Southern League... The Shuckers are one of 15 teams in Minor League Baseball with at least four one-run wins in 2024.

PITCHING IS THE WAY: The Biloxi Shuckers enter today with a 1.98 team ERA, the second-lowest in Double-A and the third-lowest in Minor League Baseball... The Shuckers are one of three teams in Minor League Baseball with a team ERA under two... The Shuckers have allowed nine runs over the team's five game win streak, an average of 1.8 runs per game.

☞ Biloxi is one of 41 teams in Minor League Baseball since 2005 across all levels to have a team ERA under 2.00 through 11 games.

☞ The Shuckers pitching staff is one of three since the start of the 2016 season to have an ERA under 2.00 through 11 games, joining the Pensacola Blue Wahoos in 2016 and 2019... They're one of seven Southern League teams since 2005 to reach the mark.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP BRADLEY BLALOCK (2-0, 0.00): After 11 straight scoreless innings to start his Double-A career, Blalock makes his third start of the season and his second home start... In his last start, Blalock tied his career-high with six shutout innings, no walks and five strikeouts against the Mississippi Braves... Through two starts, Blalock has used his fastball 52% of the time with a 70% strikeout rate and tallied seven strikeouts with the pitch... Blalock enters today among the Double-A leaders in ERA (T-1st, 0.00) and opponent's average (10th, .135).
