JUMBO SHRIMP ROLL TO 7-1 VICTORY

Cody Poteet fanned 10 batters in 5.2 innings and the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp received home runs from **Monte Harrison**, **Luis Marte** and **Brian Navarreto** Thursday to beat the Norfolk Tides 7-1 from 121 Financial Ballpark. Harrison blasted a leadoff shot in the bottom of the first, but Norfolk's **Rylan Bannon** tied the game on a home run of his own in the second. Marte homered to begin the fourth, and two batters later, Navarreto scampered home on a wild pitch. A four-run fifth, highlighted by Navarreto's three-run bomb, got the tally to 7-1. **Alexander Guillen** pitched 3.1 scoreless innings of relief with three strikeouts to earn the save.

BLACK DEATH LINEUP

Through the season's first three games, Jacksonville's 28 runs scored leads Triple-A, with the club also ranking first in hits (37), tied for first in home runs (seven), second in doubles (eight), third in slugging percentage (.642) and OPS (1.049) and fourth batting average (.339) and on-base percentage (.407). Several reasons may in part explain the club's searing offensive start. For one, the Jumbo Shrimp are receiving production from every single part of the lineup; in each of the campaign's first three contests, every single position player in the lineup has reached base at least once. Additionally, Jacksonville is putting the ball in play with frequency; the Jumbo Shrimp's 19 strikeouts are tied for the second-fewest in Triple-A East, and the club's 15.4 percent strikeout rate is far below the MLB average of roughly 24 percent. When Jacksonville batters have put the ball in play, they are batting .357.

BASH BROTHERS

Jacksonville first baseman **Lewin Díaz** and outfielder **Jesús Sánchez** have each gotten off to a pair of scorching starts to begin the season. In fact, Díaz and Sánchez have driven in 16 of the Jumbo Shrimp's 28 runs on the season (57.1 percent). Sánchez is 9-for-13 (.692) on the season with one triple, two home runs and a Triple-A-leading nine RBIs. His nine hits also lead all of Triple-A. Meanwhile, Díaz's five runs scored is tied for the Triple-A lead. He has also collected four extra-base hits to tie for tops in the level. The Santiago, D.R., native is 5-for-14 (.357) with two doubles, two homers and seven RBIs to start the season.

THE FOUR IS LAVA

On Tuesday, Jacksonville won on Opening Day for the first time since 2017. The Jumbo Shrimp followed that up Wednesday by winning again to improve to 2-0, marking the first time since 2016 that Jacksonville has begun the season undefeated in the first two games. By winning again on Thursday, Jacksonville collected a 3-0 start to the season for the first time since 2013. However, 4-0 beginnings to a campaign have been rather elusive for the franchise of late. Should the Jumbo Shrimp win again on Friday, it would mark the club's first 4-0 start since 2004, when Jacksonville won its first seven games of the season. The Jumbo Shrimp are just two wins away from equaling their season-best winning streak of five in 2019.

SECOND HELPINGS

Jacksonville's 28 runs through the season's first two games are the most in Triple-A while also ranking tied for fifth among the 120 teams that make up Minor League Baseball. The Jumbo Shrimp's offensive prowess has mainly been powered by gigantic second innings; Jacksonville has tallied nine second-inning runs thus far, a figure that is more than 29 minor league teams have mustered on the entire season. As a team, the Jumbo Shrimp are 10-for-19 in the second inning this year, slashing .526/.591/.632.

YOU'LL NEVER WALK ALONE

Though the Jumbo Shrimp offense deserves most of the credit for the team's 3-0 start, Jacksonville's pitching staff has helped itself quite a bit by not lending free passes to opposing hitters. After **Braxton Garrett** walked the first batter of the season on Tuesday, Jumbo Shrimp pitchers went 58 hitters in a row without issuing a free pass. In total, Jacksonville's five walks through the season's first two games mark the fewest total in Triple-A East. Jumbo Shrimp pitchers have walked just 4.5 percent of opposing hitters.

SHRIMP SKEWERS

Jacksonville infielder **Eddy Alvarez** has played shortstop, second base and third base through the season's first three games. Additionally, the Miami native has reached base multiple times in each contest. His .600 on-base percentage ranks in a tie for 10th in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp have been retired in order in just six of their 24 offensive innings.

ABOUT NICK

-Neidert was originally selected by the Seattle Mariners in the second round of the 2015 draft out of Peachtree High School in Suwanee, Ga. He signed with Seattle for a reported \$1.2 million, forgoing a scholarship to the University of South Carolina.

-Neidert grew up in the Atlanta area about a 30-minute drive from the Braves' Truist Park. He was a Braves fan as a kid, when he grew up watching Atlanta's spectacular rotation trio of Greg Maddux, Tom Glavine and John Smoltz.

-The Mariners traded Neidert along with RHP Robert Dugger and INF Chris Torres on December 7, 2017 to the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Dee Strange-Gordon.

-MLB Pipeline ranks Neidert as the Marlins' 10th-best prospect.

2020 SEASON

-Made his major league debut on July 25, 2020 at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia. Pitched 2.1 scoreless innings.

2019 SEASON

-Neidert posted reverse platoon splits in 2019; right-handed hitters batter .347 against him in 98 at-bats. Left-handed batters batted .175 in 63 at-bats.

2018 SEASON

-Pitched 7.0 innings or more on 10 occasions out of his 26 starts and posted double-digit strikeouts three times, including a career-high 13 in 8.0 innings on August 4, 2018 at the Biloxi Shuckers.

-Registered reverse platoon splits; lefties hit .207 in 232 at-bats while right-handed batters notched a .279 in 337 at-bats.

-Yielded just 14 runs in the first and second innings all season long, recording a 2.42 ERA in those frames.

2017 SEASON

-Did not walk more than three batters in any of his 25 starts between both High-A Modesto and Double-A Arkansas. He struck out at least seven hitters on eight different occasions, including in an eight-inning outing on June 26, 2017 against Visalia.

-Held opponents to a .187 batting average with runners in scoring position.
