**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 10-0, for their first home win of the year and their first shutout. The win snapped a five-game losing streak. **Manuel Mercedes** started and threw 5.2 innings, allowing three hits. **Nick Sinacola** threw the final 3.1 innings to close his first save in his professional career. Richmond opened a 4-0 lead in the first inning. **Jairo Pomares** hit an RBI double, **Diego Velasquez** and Pomares scored on wild pitches and **Adrian Sugastey** hit an RBI single in the inning. In the fifth, **Victor Bericoto** hit an RBI single, Sugastey brought in a run with a groundout and **Justin Wishkoski** added an RBI single to stretch the lead to 7-0. **Rodolfo Nolasco** and **Aeverson Arteaga** plated runs with sacrifice flies in the seventh. In the eighth, Bericoto hit a solo homer, his third of the year, to cap the scoring.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels are looking to pick up back-to-back wins for the first time this season.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7,951 fans per home game, which leads all 120 MiLB clubs.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** went 2-4 in last week's road trip to Harrisburg, dropping four-of-five after winning the opener. Their 3-10 start is tied for the worst in team history. In 2015, the team opened with a 3-2 record before losing their next 15 consecutive games to start the year 3-17. The 2015 team finished with a 72-68 record.

**THE BAYSOX** split last week's series against the SeaWolves at home after taking two-of-three at Altoona the previous weekend to begin the season. Bowie's roster includes five players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. (No. 6), RHP Patrick Reilly (No. 16), RHP Trace Bright (No. 17), RHP Alex Pham (No. 26) and RHP Zach Fruit (No. 30). Five players are ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Bradfield (No. 3), Reilly (No. 10), C Creed Willems (No. 12), Bright (No. 25) and Pham (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Jack Choate makes his third start of the season and the first of his career against the Baysox. He last pitched last Sunday at Harrisburg and allowed five runs over three innings, striking out five. In his season debut on April 6, he tied his career high with nine strikeouts, throwing 3.2 scoreless, two-hit innings against Akron at The Diamond. Last year, Choate spent most of the season with High-A Eugene, going 1-3 with a 2.90 ERA in 19 outings (18 starts). He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in August and made eight starts for the Flying Squirrels, posting a 1-4 record with a 5.82 ERA to close the season. Choate finished 2024 ranked first among qualified, full-season Giants minor-league pitchers in BAA (.231) and WHIP (1.21) while ranking second in ERA (3.79). Choate was selected by the Giants in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Assumption University. He entered 2025 ranked by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com. For more on Choate, see page two.

FOR CHESAPEAKE: Right-hander Patrick Reilly makes his third start of the season. In each of his first two starts, one on April 8 and the other on April 13, he threw 4.1 innings and allowed one run against the SeaWolves. Reilly was selected in the fifth round of the 2023 MLB Draft by the Pirates out of Vanderbilt. In his first full professional season last year, Reilly went 5-4 with a 3.38 ERA in 19 starts with High-A Greensboro. On July 30, he was traded from the Pirates to the Orioles for OF Billy Cook. Reilly spent the rest of the season with the Baysox, going 1-1 with a 3.73 ERA in eight games (six starts). Reilly is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 16 Orioles prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com.

**HOWELL AT THE MOON:** Carter Howell was named the 2024 Flying Squirrels Player of the Year in his first Double-A season. He spent all of last year in Richmond. For the season, he led the Eastern League in doubles (30) and triples (7). He also led the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.272), on-base percentage (.347), slugging percentage (.391), OPS (.738), hits (121), walks (47), extra-base hits (40), total bases (174), runs (64) and stolen bases (15). Through his first 13 games of 2025, Howell has reached base 22 times.

**BERI BOMBS:** Victor Bericoto hit two homers on Sunday afternoon at Harrisburg, belting a three-run homer in the first and a solo home run in the seventh. It was the first two-homer game of his Double-A career and the second of his professional career. He also had a two-homer game in 2023 with High-A Eugene. He went deep again on Friday night, the 25th over his Flying Squirrels career, which ties him with **Frankie Tostado** for eighth on the franchise's all-time home run list. In his last five games since Sunday, Bericoto is batting .526 (10-for-19) with three homers, three doubles, three walks and seven RBIs.

**PLAY THE HITS:** The Flying Squirrels have collected 107 hits through their first 12 games this season, which is the second-most in the Eastern League. The team is batting .249 (105-for-422), which is also second-highest in the league. However, the Richmond offense is batting .203 (24-for-118) with runners in scoring position, which is last in the league, but they went 6-for-15 in Friday's 10-0 win.

**FAMILIAR FACES:** This year's season-opening Flying Squirrels roster includes 22 players who have previously played for the Flying Squirrels. There are six players who have made their team debuts, including **Aeverson Arteaga, Sabin Ceballos, Manuel Mercedes, Rodolfo Nolasco, Braxton Roxby** and **Joe Whitman**. Roxby, acquired from the Reds in a trade earlier this year, is the only newcomer with previous Double-A experience.

WHERE DID THESE GUYS COME FROM?: There are players from six different counties on the Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster, including the United States (20 players), Venezuela (3), the Dominican Republic (2), Cuba (1), Panama (1) and Puerto Rico (1). Among the 20 American-born players, 11 different states are represented, including North Carolina (3), Florida (3), Ohio (3), California (2), Michigan (2), Pennsylvania (2), Kentucky (1), Minnesota (1), North Dakota (1), Rhode Island (1) and Texas (1). There are 11 players who joined the Giants organization out of the MLB Draft, six were signed as non-drafted free agents, six a international free agents, four who were picked up in trades and one who was claimed in the minor-league phase of the Rule 5 Draft. For 23 players, the Giants were their original affiliated organization and five have played with other major-league organizations.

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: Last season, 14 former Flying Squirrels players reached the majors for the first time. That was the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors last season were Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023), Grant McCray (2024), Sandro Fabian (2021) and Trevor McDonald (2024). Christian Koss (2024) made his debut for the Giants earlier this week as the first new former Flying Squirrel in the majors this year. Dating back to 2022, 23-of-the-last-26 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers), Fabian (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. The 2023 season saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Victor Bericoto is tied for second in the Eastern League in hits (15), tied for third in extra-base hits (7), tied for third in total bases (28), fourth in OPS (1.035), tied for fourth in home runs (3), tied for fourth in SLG (.596), tied for fourth in walks (10), sixth in batting average (.319) and eighth in OBP (.439). Jairo Pomares is ranked tied for third in extra-base hits (7), tied for fourth in homers (3), fifth in runs (26) and tied for fifth in runs (10).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes six players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also six players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27)

# THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1970: The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 1-0, at Parker Field for the second consecutive game. In his Triple-A debut, Mike McQueen started and allowed four hits over seven innings with 11 strike-outs. Bob Duliba finished the shutout with two innings. Jim Breazeale brought in the only run of the game with a groundout in the fourth inning. 1972: The Richmond Braves beat the Syracuse Chiefs, 12-3, at Parker Field. Bob Didier had four hits and drove in seven runs, including an inside-the-park grand slam. It was one of his two homers in the 1972 season. 1974: The Richmond Braves won on Opening Day at Parker Field against the Syracuse Chiefs, 4-3, in 10 innings. Sonny Jackson won the game with a two-out, infield single in the bottom of the 10th. Joe Niekro threw three scoreless relief innings to pick up the win. 1984: After rainouts on back-to-back days, the Richmond Braves finally got what would be their final home-opener at Parker Field under way against the Columbus Clippers. The game was suspended after one scoreless inning because of wet grounds. 1988: The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens on the road, 3-0. Tommy Greene threw seven scoreless innings to pick up his first Triple-A win. David Justice hit a three-run homer in the eighth for the game's only runs. Jose Alvarez recorded the final six outs to finish the shutout. 2023: The Richmond Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 11-2. Randy Rodriguez picked up his first Double-A win with three scoreless relief innings. Tyler Fitzgerald had three hits including a two-run homer in the fifth. Ismael Munguia and Andy Thomas also had three hits.
