Only three batters reached base, with all occurring in consecutive 2nd inning ABs. **Jedi Master Sweet**: Manager Rick Sweet collected his 301st win at the helm of the Nashville club last night, He trails Rick Renick (1993-96) for second on the all-time Sounds manager wins list. In order for Sweet to catch Trent Jewett (1998-00, 2003-04) for the most wins in Sounds history, Nashville would need to win 20 of their next 32 games. Sweet has a 301-236 record in four seasons as Nashville's skipper.
