TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a sixgame road series against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos. This is the third of five series between the two clubs who will meet a total of 30 times (12 at Trustmark Park, 18 at Blue Wahoos Stadi-

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves tied the game in the ninth but ultimately fell 5-4 in 10 innings. The club hit three solo homers from Franklin V, Campbell, and Waddell, who went 3-for-4. Waddell tied the game in the ninth with a base hit to right field, but a sacrifice fly from Will Banfield walked off the M-Braves

LET THE GOOD TIMES ROLL: Over the last five series, the club is 2-0-3 (18-11 overall). The M-Braves scored 68 runs in nine games from May 27 to June 7, ranking 2nd in Double-A over that span.

AGAINST THE BLUE WAHOOS: The M-Braves lost five of six to Pensacola from May 2-7 despite losing the aggregate score 19-18. From May 23-28, the two clubs split a six-game set. with the M-Braves winning back-to-back games to close out the series

THESE TEAMS KNOW HOW TO PITCH: The M-Braves lead the Southern League in pitching, are 2nd in Double-A, and 12th in MiLB with a 3.74 ERA. M-Braves starters rank 12th in Double-A with a 4.26 ERA. The M-Braves finished May with the fourth best ERA in Milb at 2.99.

The Blue Wahoos are 2nd in the Southern League and 7th in Double-A with a 3.95 ERA. Pensacola starters rank 2nd in Double-A with a 3.65 ERA

PROSPECTING: 7 of Atlanta's Top 30 MLB Pipeline prospects are on the active roster: RHP Victor Vodnik (11), INF Cal Conley (13), OF Jesse Franklin V (14), RHP Alan Rangel (26), RHP Tanner Gordon (28), C Tyler Tolve (29) and LHP Luis De Avila (30).

HOME RUN ADVANTAGE AT HOME FIELD: The M-Braves have 64 homers - 38 on the road. 16 different players have at least one homer with Drew Lugbauer leading the way with 12 homers, ranking 1st in the Southern League.

The M-Braves hit 11 home runs at Trustmark Park this past week. M-Braves opponents have just eight home runs at Trustmark Park this sea-

WALK THE WALK-OFF: The M-Braves have four walk-off wins this season, including two walk-off home runs.

On Saturday, Landon Stephens hit a walk-off homer down the left field line to complete a three-run comeback. On April 22, Jacob Pearson's walk-off grand slam snapped an eightgame losing streak.

MUÑOZ GETS THE CALL: The Atlanta Braves recalled RHP Roddery Muñoz, the M-Braves Opening Day starter, on June 6. When Muñoz makes his MLB debut, he will become the fifth M-Braves alum to debut this season, joining RHP AJ Smith-Shawver (6/3), INF Braden Shewmake (5/5), LHP Dylan Dodd (4/4), and LHP Jared Shuster (4/2). 165 M-Braves alum have debuted in the MLB since 2005.

ALL HAIL KING SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer was placed on the 7-day IL on June 14. He homered in three straight games from May 23-25, becoming the sixth M-Brave to do so. Lugbauer achieved the feat from July 25-28, 2021.

The first baseman was forced to the 7-day Injured List on Wednesday, ranking among the league leaders in home runs (12, 1st), RBI (38, T-4th), SLG (.600, 1st), OPS (.986, 1st), OBP (.386, 6th) and XBH (25, 4th) at the time.

Lugbauer recorded his first career M-Braves triple on May 13 against the Lookouts, then another on May 16 at Montgomery. He made his profesional pitching debut on May 17 at Montgomery tossing 2/3 scoreless innings with a strikeout of Logan Driscoll on an 87 mph fastball. On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mileper-hour home run, which ranked 5th among MLB players for hardest hit balls at the time.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record 58 home runs over parts of three seasons, blowing past the previous record of 32 (Travis Demeritte/Connor Lien). He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record

"JESSE FRANKLIN V": Jesse Franklin V just lost a team-best, 10-game hit streak (5/24-6/9) and has hit in 13 of his last 14 games. The outfielder slashed .300/.396/.500 with a homer, five doubles, five walks, and six RBI over the streak.

WADDYYY: Luke Waddell has reached base eight times in the last two games, with a homer, three walks, four runs, and three RBI. The infielder is batting .284 with a .429 OBP, two home runs, and 13 RBI in 24 games for the M-Braves.

BUNNY HOPPIN': Cade Bunnell is off to a nice start in June, slashing .361/.455/.750 with four homers, two doubles, seven walks, and eight RBI in 10 games.

HOT VOD: Victor Vodnik has yet to allow a run in 9.2 innings over six appearances. Since the start of May, Vodnik has a 0.91 ERA in 19.2 innings over 13 appearances with 10 walks to 28 strikeouts.

BIG BAD BARGER: The 25-year-old reliever allowed a run for the first time on May 20 in his 12th relief appearance. He has four saves (T-5th, SL). Barger started the season with 15 shutout innings, with 19 strikeouts to seven walks, in 11 appearances. He currently has a 2.52 ERA in 25 innings.

WINNIN' WITH WILCOX: RHP Kyle Wilcox has allowed one earned run in 12.2 innings over 12 relief appearances with the M-Braves, including five walks to 20 strikeouts.

The right-hander was on Triple-A Gwinnett's roster from April 18-May 23, recording a 4.32 ERA in 12.1 innings.
