FRES-NOTES

HOLDING ALL THE CARDS: With San Jose already locked in as first-half champion, the final California League North playoff spot comes down to whoever finishes second in the second half — and that race is now a two-team fight between Fresno and Stockton, with Visalia eliminated from postseason contention. Fresno sits a game ahead of Stockton in the second-half standings (32-28 to 31-29) with six games left to play, and even if the two teams finish tied, the tiebreaker favors the Grizzlies — Fresno has already beaten Stockton 7-5 in the second half matchup to hold the tiebreaker if the teams end up tied in the second half standings at the end of the week. The Grizzlies also hold an overall 14-10 mark in their season series against the Ports for good measure. Whichever team claims the spot will face San Jose in the playoffs next week.

THE LONE HOLDOUT: San Jose is the only team in the California League that Fresno doesn't own a winning record against this season. The Grizzlies are 8-10 in their 18 meetings with the Giants, the outlier on an otherwise strong ledger that includes winning records against Stockton (14-10), Visalia (13-11), Inland Empire (7-5), Lake Elsinore (7-5) and Ontario (10-8), plus an even split with Rancho Cucamonga (9-9). Fitting measuring stick — San Jose has run away with the division at 75-51, and Fresno gets one more crack at the Giants this week before the second-half race is decided.

SIZING UP THE GIANTS: Fresno's bats have had a boom-and-bust relationship with San Jose this season, hitting .255 with eight home runs and 85 RBI across the 18-game season series. The high point came May 7 at Excite Ballpark in San Jose, when the Grizzlies pounded out 14 hits, four home runs and 11 RBI in a single game — still the offense's signature outing of the series. The bats stayed hot for most of that first six-game trip (.289, five homers), but production has cooled since — .259 with one homer over the next six meetings, then .214 with two homers in the most recent series in August. Even with the recent dip, Fresno drew 66 walks over the 18 games and was shut out twice.

MEASURING UP: Fresno's pitching staff has had its moments against San Jose this season, going 8-10 with a 5.19 ERA and 167 strikeouts across the 18-game series. The staff was sharpest in the second six-game series in late May, posting a 3.67 ERA even though the results only broke even — including a hard-luck loss on May 28, when the Grizzlies allowed just one run over nine innings and still lost. The best individual outing came May 10 in San Jose, a nine-inning, two-run effort that helped Fresno take that opening series 4-2, while the most recent series in August was the roughest of the three, producing a 5.64 ERA with two starts of nine or more earned runs allowed.
