RIDERS SPLIT DOUBLEHEADER AGAINST MIDLAND:

The Frisco RoughRiders followed a 12-9 loss on Friday night with a 6-1 victory to split a doubleheader with the Midland RockHounds at Riders Field. In the second game, **Evan Carter** lined a ball off the waterfall in right field for a two-run, go-ahead homer in the first inning. The RoughRiders (5-5, 36-42) added to the lead in the third inning when **Kellen Strahm** launched a three-run home run. After the first inning, Frisco held Midland (7-3, 39-40) scoreless. **Nick Krauth** (2-5) went five innings without a walk, one run allowed and four hits, all singles. Blake Beers (2-3) gave up all six runs in his 4.1 innings of work to suffer the loss. Carter went 2-for-3 to start a new hitting streak, having snapped an 11-game streak in the first game of the doubleheader. **Thomas Saggese** had two doubles in his two at-bats after being hit by a pitch. Between the two games, he went 4-for-6 with a home run and two doubles. **Justin Slaten** and **Antoine Kelly** kept Midland scoreless in the final two innings of the second game. In the first game of the doubleheader, Midland scored six runs in the first inning and chased **Jack Leiter** (2-5) from the game before the inning was over. Frisco trailed by seven runs on two occasions yet came back to bring the tying run to the plate in each of the final two innings, but never completed the comeback. In his start, Ryan Cusick (3-3) took the win with three runs allowed in five innings. Saggese homered for his 12th long ball to lead the team, while **Luisangel Acuña** totaled four hits and scored twice. **Jax Biggers** slammed a home run, his first at Riders Field in 2023 and fifth on the season.

WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 15 games since his return, he has seven multi-hit games, batting .414 (24-for-58)/.478/.707/1.185 with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, 14 RBIs and 13 runs scored. Carter is now fifth in the Texas League in batting average (.312), third in OBP (.423) and seventh in OPS (.894).

RISP-ECT THIS:

This season, the Riders are just seventh in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .255, though Frisco is fourth with 307 RBIs with RISP. Over the last 20 games (9-11 record), Frisco is hitting .259 (49-for-189) in those situations.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. He had a 15-game hitting streak ended on Thursday. In that streak, Saggese hit .443 (27-for-61)/.507/.803/1.310 with five doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs, eight walks, 13 runs scored and a steal. For his efforts against Springfield, Saggese was named the Texas League Player of the Week, hitting .591 (13-for-22)/.654/.955/1.609 with three doubles, one triple, one home run, seven RBIs, seven runs scored and four walks. Over his last 27 games, he is hitting .375/.468/.702/1.170 with eight home runs and 25 RBIs.

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League with a .615 average (16-for-26) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.643 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .472 (25-for-53) on the initial offering while his 25 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors.

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 34 and is on pace for a career-best 63 swipes. The RoughRiders are fifth in Texas League steals with 107 bases in 127 attempts (84 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect hit .300/.336/.460/.796 in June. Currently on an 11-game hitting streak, he is hitting .426/.460/.532/.992 during this stretch, including a four-hit game in game one of the doubleheader on Friday. He is third in the Texas League in batting average (.315), second in hits (95), fourth in doubles (19), third in runs (56) and first in steals (34). When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (119).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 382 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .355 team OBP is second in the Texas League. The Riders have four in the top eight players in Texas League walk rate this season: **Dustin Harris** (3rd, 15.8%), **Trevor Hauver** (4th, 15.7%) and **Evan Carter** (8th, 14.7%). Though he is not qualified for the standings, **Aaron Zavala** is walking at a 18.1% rate so far this season.

ABOUT NOAH

-Grew up in Berkeley, California and played under father, Matt, at Berkeley High School. Mother, Shelly Neufeld played basketball at University of California. Older brother, Tyler, played baseball at Baylor and was drafted in the 27th round by the Cubs in 2012 (Finished his minor league career with Double-A Jacksonville in 2017 after 164 career outings).

-Went to University of Washington for college. Earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American honors in 2015, going 6-3 with a 2.41 ERA. In 2016 and 2017, garnered All-Pac-12 honors with a 2.98 ERA and 3.15 ERA, respectively.

-Broke into the UW career and single-season record books including: career starts (T6th, 40), innings pitched (3rd, 284), career strikeouts (6th, 205) and single-season strikeouts (7th, 103) over his three seasons.

2023 SEASON

-Returned from Tommy John Surgery on June 5th and pitched four games with AZL Rangers. Surgery was performed on March 30th, 2022.

-Named Double-A Central Pitcher of the Week for 7/19-25 after fanning 7 batters, walking none, and allowing just 2 hits over a pair of scoreless relief outings (6.2 IP total).
