**Tonight:** The Lugnuts play the fourth game of a six-game series with the West Michigan Whitecaps, the tenth meeting of 24 total between the archrivals this season. After splitting a six-game set in June, the Nuts have won two of the first three games in the current series. Right-hander **Reid Birlingmair**, who has a 1.06 ERA in 17 innings this month, takes on 'Caps right-hander **Garrett Hill**, more than a valley, less than a mountain.

Last Night: Austin Beck 5, Whitecaps 2. Right fielder Austin Beck hit a first-inning grand slam and an eighth-inning RBI single and Jack Cushing tossed his third quality start in as many chances, striking out eight in six innings while allowing only a two-run Gage Workman double in the sixth. The game was played in a brisk two hours and 45 minutes.

On Deck: The Nuts play the Whitecaps through Sunday before returning home July 27-August 1 against the Fort Wayne TinCaps.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

# Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Lugnuts in the News: Pitcher Rich Hill, a 2003 Lugnut (15 G, 4 GS, 2.76, 29 1/3, 36 BB, 50 K, 9 WP, 3 HBP), was traded today by the Tampa Bay Rays to the New York Mets in exchange for Tommy Hunter and Matt Dyer.

No Place Like Close to Home: The Lugnuts are in the midst of a period of easy travel. Between June 28 and August 1, the Nuts don't leave the state of Michigan, with their only road trips to Midland (Great Lakes) and Comstock Park (West Michigan).

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor. He competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode, which aired last night.

Alumni Report: Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who played for the 2017 Lugnuts, is third in the Majors in batting average (.329), second in home runs (32), first in RBIs (79), first in on-base percentage (.430), first in slugging (.677), first in total bases (224), first in OPS (1.107) and first in runs (75). 2019 Lugs outfielder Griffin Conine, playing for Beloit (MIA), leads the minors with 23 homers.

Bruised: Hey, no one was hit by a pitch yesterday! Just in case it happens today, keep this in mind: The Lugnuts have been hit four times in three games in this series, 17 times in 19 games this month, and a league-leading 65 times this year. Meanwhile, Nuts pitchers have hit 18 batters in 19 games this month and 56 this year, third highest in

Living Up to Expectations: Outfielder Austin Beck, the sixth overall pick in the 2017 draft, has driven in 13 runs in his last six games, going 8-for-24 with three doubles and three home runs. Beck's grand slam last night was his second professional grand slam, with the first one hit against position-player-pitching Alvaro Rubalcaba in an 11-run 8th inning on August 18, 2018, for the Beloit Snappers against the Burlington Bees. The Snappers won the game, 18-4. Beck's slam was the Lugnuts' first grand slam since Ryan Gold hit a grand slam amid hitting for the cycle vs. Dayton on April 18, 2019.

Youth is Served: 20-year-old Jordan Diaz, the youngest player on the Lansing roster, is hitting .338/.427/.508 with 11 runs, 14 RBIs, 7 XBH (2 HRs) and a 10/6 BB/K ratio in 18 corner in July

Hoya Saxa: Right-hander Jack Cushing, a product of Georgetown, has been brilliant since joining the Lugnuts from Low-A Stockton. Cushing's appearances: six innings, one run vs. Dayton; a seven-inning complete game, one run at Great Lakes; five shutout innings of relief vs. Lake County; and last night's six innings, two runs at West Michigan. All told, Cushing has 25 strikeouts and five walks in 24 innings with a 1.50 ERA, allowing an OBA of .157.

Trusted Relief: This series involves the most heavily used relief pitchers in the High-A Central, with Jared Tobey and Dalton Sawyer (27 games, 1st), and Zack Hess and Charles Hall (25 games, T-3rd), and Angel Reyes (24 games, T-4th). Sawyer and Hall have already appeared twice in this series.

Whitecaps Killer: Catcher Drew Millas is hitting 12-for-28 (.429) with five runs, one double, two homers and six walks (.529 on-base percentage) in seven games against West Michigan this year.

# TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2007:** It took 16 innings, 10 combined errors and 29 combined hits, but the Lugnuts finally put away the Swing of the Quad Cities, 11-10, in a franchise record five hours and 31 minutes.

**2018:** Jordan Barrett fired seven scoreless innings and the Lugnuts blanked the Cedar Rapids Kernels at Cooley Law School Stadium, for the franchise's 1600th win. The Nuts had been stuck at 1599 wins for a little while; the victory over the Kernels stopped a nine-game losing streak.

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's a larger crowd than any of the Blue Jays' home games this season in Dunedin or Buffalo and it's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Oakland Athletics, Miami Marlins and Toronto/Buffalo/Dunedin Blue Jays. Only eight of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Roster Index: The newest Nut, José Mora, is the 845th Lugnut all-time and the 41st player used this year. The 2021 Lugnuts have surpassed the total number of players used in the 1996 (40), 1999 (38), 2001 (40) and 2009 (38) seasons. The franchise record for most players used in a single year is 54, set in 2017. Currently, 18.6% of all Lugnuts have reached the Major Leagues (157 of 845). If that percentage continues to hold true, at least seven of the 41 players to see time this year with the Nuts will reach MLB.

Major League Lugnuts: Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, and pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went 1-for-3 with two RBis, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard University, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth College and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell University before grad-transferring to Wake Forest. Speaking of outstanding academic institutions, starter Jack Cushing spent four years at Georgetown University.

International Appeal: In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Nevada (Connor Hughes), North Carolina, Ohio (Scott Steinmann), Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 14 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

**Personal:** Reid's last name is pronounced "BIR-ling-MY-er"... instructor at the K's Training Academy in the offseason, located in Normal, as is college/Lugnuts teammate and best friend Charlie Cerny (pronounced "Cher-nee").

Last Outing: July 17 vs. Lake County... pitched wonderfully, allowing only a third-inning unearned run in five innings... departed with a 7-1 lead... Lugnuts appeared to be sailing right along before the bullpen gave up 12 runs in three innings in a 13-9 loss.

- Allowing 5.67 ERA, .257 OBA in 6 home starts (27 IP)... 2.81 ERA, .217 OBA in 5 road starts (25 2/3 IP).
- Allowing .297 / .379 / .516 w/ 3 HR to left-handed hitters compared to .186 / .304 / .279 w/ 1 HR to right-handers.
- ERA by month: 3.54 in May (20 1/3 IP), 8.80 in June (15 1/3), and now 1.06 in July (17 IP), allowing .153 OBA.
- Started fourth game of the season, May 7th vs. Lake County: allowed solo home run to Austen Wade... picked Joe Naranjo off first base in the 4th inning... departed with Nuts trailing 3-0... Lugnuts lost, 6-2.
- May 14th at Dayton: only run scored came inherited, vs. Charles Hall in the 5th on a Jacob Hurtubise sac. and Brian Rey SF.
- May 21 at Fort Wayne: pitched brilliantly, shutting out the TinCaps through six innings, allowing only one hit.
- May 28 vs. Great Lakes: all four runs allowed came in the 3rd, thanks to five straight hits... set down final seven batters. June 4 vs. South Bend: unraveled in the 3rd, allowing a leadoff single, walking three consecutive Cubs, an RBI single, a
- double-play ball, and then departing after hitting Caleb Knight... the Nuts erased the 3-0 deficit with 17 unanswered runs. June 11 at West Michigan: Lugnuts built leads of 3-0 and 4-1, but Birlingmair allowed one run in the 4th (Torkelson triple/Dingler RBI groundout) and two runs in the 5th (Packard RBI fielder's choice, Torkelson SF)... Whitecaps then scored six runs in the 6th against Charles Hall and Aiden McIntyre, capped by a three-run Torkelson HR and Dingler solo HR.
- June 18 vs. Great Lakes: gave up three-run homers to Ryan Ward in both the 1st and 2nd innings... had only allowed one home run in 122 batters faced before Ward took him deep in the first inning.
- June 25 at Cedar Rapids: gave up solo home run to Jair Camargo in the 2nd inning... departed in the 5th with the bases loaded, and reliever Dalton Sawyer balked an inherited runner home before stranding the other two runners.
- July 3 vs. Dayton: Lugnuts won in a one-hitter, with Quin Cotton's third-inning double denying the Lugnuts a no-hitter.
- July 10 at Great Lakes: shut out Loons for five innings before allowing two runs in the 6th.
- July 17 vs. Lake County: allowed one unearned run in five innings... bullpen collapsed, blowing a 7-1 lead going to the 7th inning and an 8-7 lead heading into the 8th... pen allowed 12 runs in the final three innings in a 13-9 Lugnuts loss.

Professional Career: Made his professional debut in the AZL in 2018 (1.45 ERA, 18 2/3 IP, 5 R, 6 BB, 25 K) before moving up to Vermont on August 8 (2.25 ERA, 5 G, 3 GS, 16.0 IP, 10 BB, 8 K)... spent full 2019 in Beloit (4.02 ERA, 123 IP, 108 H, 50 BB, 120 K), pitching at least six innings in nine games, topping out at 7-IP, 1-R, 8-K on July 24th... faced the Lugnuts once (3 IP, 0 R) on May 4th... had overall numbers skewed by one bad month: 1.46 ERA in 24.2 IP in May, 10.72 ERA in 22.2 IP in June, 2.78 in 35.2 IP in July, 2.36 in 34.1 IP in August.

**Draft Day:** Selected 833rd overall in the 28th round from the University of Illinois at Chicago (the "Flames") in 2018... signed by Derek Lee... drafted 21 rounds after Charlie Cerny... the 2018 draft was fruitful for the Lugnuts roster, also producing Bryce Nightengale (16th round), Cobie Vance (18th round), Max Schuemann (20th round), Aiden McIntyre (22nd round).

Life as a Flame: Reid struggled as a freshman at the University of Illinois, Chicago (8.81 ERA, 17 G, 3 GS, 31 2/3 IP, 33 R, 24 BB, 27 K, 11 HBP) but bounced back to have a strong sophomore season (3.10, 15 GS, 1 ShO, 93.0 IP, 34 R, 25 BB, 81 K, 5 HBP) and better junior season (2.12, 10 G, 8 GS, 51.0 IP, 12 R, 21 BB, 57 K, 5 HBP), though he missed time from March 23-April 24 with an injury.

Baseball Over Nursing: In an interview with White Cleat Beat, Reid shared that nursing had been his first pursuit, starting with volunteering at OSF St. Joseph Medical Center, Carle BroMenn Medical Center, and Camp Quality (serving children with cancer and their families). He applied to the nursing school at UIC as a sophomore before turning his attention fully toward baseball, majoring in liberal arts with a minor in psychology.

Major League Standouts: Only three UIC Flames have ever made the Majors, but each one is notable: Pete Mackanin (1973-1981), who managed the Pirates in 2005, the Reds in 2007 and the Phillies in 2015-2017; Ken Holtzman (1965-1979), who threw no-hitters for the Chicago Cubs in 1969 (despite not striking out a batter) and 1971 and was an American League All-Star with the Oakland Athletics' World Series champions in 1972 and 1973; and three-time All-Star Curtis Granderson (2004-2019), who was taken by Detroit in the third round in 2002 and collected exactly 1800 hits in his 16-vear MLB career.

High School Success, On and Off the Field...: Pitched and played shortstop at Normal West High School, where he was named 3x 1st Team All-Big 12 and the Big 12 Conference Pitcher of the year as a Senior... in the 2015 Illinois Coaches Association (ICA) All-Star Game, he played second base... he was also a member of the National Honor Society and Spanish Honor Society.

A Normal Background Check: Birlingmair's hometown, Normal, was originally named North Bloomington in 1854. The name changed in 1865 to reflect its place as the home of Illinois State Normal University, a teaching school, now called simply Illinois State University. (Teaching schools were known as "normal schools" because their purpose was to instruct the students, future teachers, in properly understanding and instilling the societal norms at the time. Many state schools began as normal schools, like UCLA, which was originally named the Los Angeles California State Normal School.) Normal is the home of the Normal Combelters, a member of the Frontier League from 2010-2018 and now a member of the Prospect League, playing their home games at The Corn Crib.
