Tonight's Game: The Sounds take on the Bulls in game three of the series tonight. Rehabbing Tampa Bay outfielder Brandon Lowe hit a grand slam in the fourth inning and the Bulls rode the four-spot to a 5-3 win over Nashville last night. Right-hander Chad Patrick looks to help the Sounds take back control of the series tonight. He'll face left-hander Joe Rock who gets the ball for Durham at 5:35 p.m. CDT.

Chad Patrick: The 25-year-old will become the third Sound to make six starts this season. The right-hander is 1-1 with a 4.01 ERA (24.2 IP/11 ER). Patrick worked his second quality start of the season in the loss vs. Norfolk on May 3. He held the Tides to two runs (1 ER) on four hits and two walks with nine strikeouts. His nine Ks tied an affiliated career high and was the most by a Sounds starter since Tobias Myers had 10 vs. St. Paul on April 6. This is Patrick's first outing against a Rays affiliate. He has an 8.38 ERA (9.1 IP/9 ER) away from First Horizon Park, compared to a 1.17 ERA (15.1 IP/2 ER) at the friendly confines in Hit City. He's holding right-handed hitters to a .184 average (9-for-49) and lefties to a .279 average (12-for-43). Patrick was acquired by Milwaukee in a trade that sent INF Abraham Toro to the Athletics on November 15, 2023. He was originally selected in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Purdue University Northwest.

Joe Rock: The 23-year-old makes his seventh appearance and fifth start for the Bulls tonight. He's 1-1 with a 5.19 ERA (26.0 IP/15 ER) this season. Rock last pitched on May 4 at Gwinnett in a no decision. He worked five two-run innings (1 ER), allowing six hits and a couple of walks with two strikeouts. The No. 18 prospect in the Rays organization (MLB Pipeline) has yet to find his groove with a 1.50 WHIP and .306 opponent batting average. This is Rork's first time he has begun the season at the Triple-A level - he made one appearance with Albuquerque last season. Rock was acquired by Tampa Bay on March 21, 2024 from Colorado in exchange for SS Greg Jones. He was an MiLB.com Organization All-Star while spending most of the 2022 season with High-A Spokane. The Rockies selected Rock from Ohio University (the Bobcats not Buckeyes) in the Competitive Balance Round B of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft.

The Champagne of Sounds: Owen Miller added his 10th multi-hit game of the season for Nashville, going 2-for-4 with a pair of singles. He also knocked in the first run of the game in the third. Since returning from Milwaukee on May 2, Miller is batting .400 (8-for-20) with four RBI, three walks and four runs scored. The Wisconsin hit .353 (18-for-51) with seven runs scored in his first stint with Nashville from Opening Day-April 14. Miller is a career .306 hitter (110-for-359) at the Triple-A level, having played in 48 games with Columbus in 2021 and 48 with Nashville over the past two seasons.

Haase Homer Time: Eric Haase hit his fourth homer of the season and first since April 14 at Memphis in the ninth inning last night. His blast snapped a four-game RBI-less streak after the catcher logged at least one RBI in 11 of his first 16 games of the season. The former backstop with Cleveland and Detroit spent most of the last week on Milwaukee's taxi squad but returned to the club to begin the series at Durham.

Awesomeness From Abner: Reliever Abner Uribe worked another scoreless inning since being optioned from Milwaukee on May 1. He totaled 10 pitches, including eight sinkers that clocked in at an average 97.8 miles an hour. After getting the call from Nashville following just seven appearances out of the bullpen, the Dominican Republic native has a 1.80 ERA (10.0 IP/2 ER) and .088 opponent batting average in his career at the Triple-A level.

Roster Moves: Before today's game, infielder Tyler Black and pitcher Janson Junk have returned to the Sounds roster. Black was optioned from Milwaukee to make room for Christian Yelich, who returned to the Brewers lineup following a stint on the injured list. Junk was optioned by Milwaukee on Monday to make room for Kevin Herget, who had his contract selected. Black hit .167 (3-for-18) in his first taste of MLB baseball. He's batting .303 (30-for-99) in 25 games with the Sounds this season, including 18 RBI, 20 runs scored and a .918 OPS.

Paredes Putting Them Away: Enoli Paredes locked down his fourth save of the season with two strikeouts in the tenth inning and only the ghost runner crossing the plate on Tuesday. It is the second straight game Paredes has recorded a save which is the first time he has done that since September 23/24, 2022. He has not allowed an earned run in his last seven appearances and has a 0.88 WHIP on the season. His 25/5 K/BB ratio is tied for second on the team with Jared Koening and trails Rob Zastryzny who has a 22/1 ratio. Paredes has converted 29 of his 40 save attempts in his minor league career including 12 of 17 for Sugarland last season.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 699-602 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,291-2,122 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

LAST OUTING: Patrick had his second quality start of the season in a 2-0 loss against Norfolk on May 3. He went a season-high 6.1 innings, allowing four hits, two runs (one earned), two walks and striking out nine. His nine strikeouts tied a career high set twice previously, with the last coming on August 5, 2023 at Frisco.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's first start against Durham.
