Tonight: The Lugnuts play the opener in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, whom they recently lost four out of six games to from May 25-30 at Jackson® Field™. To date, that remains the only series the Lugnuts have played in which they have not split the six games with their opponent. Lansing is coming off halving a six-game set at LMCU Ballpark against the West Michigan Whitecaps.

On the Air: Tonight's game is on both MiLB.TV and accessible via streaming online audio via http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing, with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa on the call of the game.

Sunday: Lugnuts 6, Whitecaps 2. In Spencer Torkelson's and Dillon Dingler's final game in West Michigan, the Lugnuts scored solo tallies in six of the nine innings to clinch a six-game split, led by catcher **Drew Millas**, who singled, doubled, homered and drew two walks, becoming the first Nut to reach base five separate times in a game this season. It was also the final Lugnuts game for reliever Jack Weisenburger, who was promoted to Double-A Midland before tonight's game.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Meet the Boss: Scott Steinmann is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes.

Bienvenidos a Lansing: Outfielder Enrry Pantoja was added to the Lugnuts roster from Extended Spring Training on Friday, replacing the promoted Jake Suddleson, and made his Nuts debut yesterday with an unsuccessful pinch-hit plate appearance in the ninth. Pantoja is one of four native Cubans on Lansing's roster, joining pitcher Richard Guasch and outfielders Lazaro Armenteros and Lester Madden, Jr.

Seeking Health: Not only do the Nuts have four players -- pitchers Charlie Cerny and Jeff Criswell and outfielders Austin Beck and Lester Madden, Jr. -- on the Injured List, outfielder Michael Guldberg has not played in a game since May 29th and first baseman Patrick McColl has not had a plate ap-

1st in the High-A Central, but...: The Lugnuts' pitching staff tops the High-A Central with a 3.45 earned run average, leading second-place West Michigan (3.98), but that ERA took a hit with 26 earned runs allowed in the last four games, jumping the team ERA from where it stood on Thursday morning at a sparkling 3.02.

Heating Up: Missouri State product Drew Millas has excelled at the plate in his last 11 games, hitting .429 (18-for-42) and raising his batting average from .177 to .279. Millas had 10 hits in his last four games during the West Michigan series and enters today on a 17-game on-base streak

Getting Hits and Getting Hit: The Nuts rank second in the league in at-bats (1202), first in doubles (78), first in HBPs (36), rank second in fewest strikeouts (316), tied for second in sacrifice bunts (7); and third in hits (286).

Individual Effort: Infielder Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University) is first in the league in HBPs (11), tied for second in steals (22), and tied for third in runs scored (31, Schuemann's HBP total is tied for second in all of Minor League Baseball and his stolen base total is tied

Highs and Lows: The Lugnuts have scored at least seven runs in a game 13 times this season, but have also scored two runs or fewer in a game 15 times.

Keys to Success: When Lansing scores more than two runs in a game, the club is 15-6. When it scores two runs or fewer, the record is 2-13. Additionally, when the Nuts outhit the opposition, they are 14-1 this season. When they get outhit, however, they are 1-17.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: The Great Lakes Loons came one out from throwing their first no-hitter in franchise history, but Wes Helsabeck plunked John La Prise, Josh Almonte singled to center, and J.C. Cardenas, batting from the right side, hit a three-run homer. The Loons completed a 6-3 victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader at Cooley Law School Stadium. Cardenas had hit a three-run homer from the left side in Game 1, a 10-1 rout of Great Lakes.

Major League Lugnuts: Two former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, pitcher Ty Tice '18 and outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, with the duo making their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals.

Familiar Settings: 14 of the 30 Lugnuts active players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members Scott Steinmann, Don Schulze and Anthony Phillips all have experience in the league.

A Lineup of Starters: The Lugnuts have used ten starting pitchers this year, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Colin Peluse, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

Fly Like an Eagle: Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University.

Finally: Pitchers Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg are all making their pro debut this season.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); and the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama, and Ryan Gridley, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. Reid Birlingmair and Charlie Cerny pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons; though William Simoneit played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing Colin Peluse by a year, Peluse hosted Simoneit on his visit and convinced him to attend Wake.
