History vs. Quad Cities

The Lugnuts are 83-89 all-time vs. the River Bandits, 45-38 at home and 38-51 in Davenport.

The Nuts have played at Quad Cities for four straight seasons, 2023-2026, but the River Bandits have traveled to Michigan's state capital only once in the last five years: 2023, when the Lugnuts won four of six.

Today is 517 Day - and since the area code for Lansing is 517, the Lugnuts are celebrating Lansing by playing as the Olive Burgers on a Capital City Market Kids Day with postgame Kids Run the Bases. It's also the finale of a six-game series vs. the Quad Cities River Bandits; the Nuts won the first four games before the Bandits prevailed yesterday.

We Love the Olive Burger: Take a ground beef hamburger patty and add olive sauce, and you'll have the pride of Lansing, dating back to the 1920s and Weston's Kewpee Sandwich Shop. There is no food more associated specifically with Lansing than the olive burger (though Adam Jaksa would remind you that the bacon cheeseburger is also a Lansing invention, so be doubly proud!).

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa have the call of the game on milb.streamguys1.com/lansing, MiLB TV and Bally Live.

On Deck: It's off to the road as the Lugnuts open an 18-game season series with the Lake County Captains, playing a six-game set in Eastlake, Ohio. Then it's time to come back home to host the reeling West Michigan Whitecaps to close out May; the Whitecaps have lost 18 of their last 19 games.

LUG-NOTES

Welcome Aboard: Reliever **Jay Dill** joined the Lugnuts from Class-A Stockton yesterday; when he first appears in a game for Lansing, he'll become the 999th player in Lansing Lugnuts team history. Drafted last year in the 18th round from Troy, Dill was 3-0 with a 1.08 ERA in 12 appearances spanning 16 2/3 innings for the Ports, walking seven while striking out 21.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**) and No. 24 (**Nate Nankil**).

Taylor-Made Success: Outfielder **Devin Taylor** leads the Midwest League runs batted in (31) while ranking 2nd in base hits (43), 5th in walks (33) and 9th in OBP (.437). The Indiana Hoosier is batting .375/.479/.550 this year against Quad Cities, reaching base 23 times (15 hits, 8 walks) in 11 games.

Hello, John Miller: The home plate umpire for today's game, Mr. Miller, was also behind the plate on Wednesday, when the Lugnuts drew seven straight walks in the sixth inning en route to 10 walks in the frame and 13 walks in the game; and behind the plate on Friday, when the Nuts tied a single game franchise record with 14 walks. Credit to official scorer **Tim Zeko** for this: 22% of all batters have drawn walks in the games that Miller has umpired this series.

Dettmer Encore: Today's starting pitcher for Lansing, **Nathan Dettmer**, made his 2026 Midwest League debut with 6 1/3 innings of one-hit ball last Sunday at South Bend, taking a no-hitter into the seventh before it was broken up by Cameron Sisneros. Dettmer struck out seven batters in the gem; he was nosed out for MWL Pitcher of the Week by Dayton's Nestor Lorant (7 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 7 K). As for South Bend, they've scored a remarkable 74 runs in five games at Wisconsin, including 25-run and 24-run outputs.

Patience is a Virtue: The Nuts have drawn 84 walks in 11 total games against Quad Cities, leaving the club with a .392 on-base percentage despite a .239 batting average (while the River Bandits are batting .286 against Lugnuts pitching but with a .378 OBP).

Green Power: **Rodney Green, Jr.**'s 490-foot home run last Tuesday was the longest tracked home run of the 2026 season, Major League or Minor League; it was also Green's first home run since he blasted a pair on Opening Day against Dayton on April 2.

Bolting to the Show: The most recent Lugnut to make his MLB debut was 2024 Lugnuts outfielder **Henry Bolte** p, who went 2-for-2 for the A's on May 13 to become the 203rd all-time Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues and the third this season.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

MAY 17 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: The Lugnuts and Dragons went to the 12th inning in a scoreless tie, but Dayton snapped the deadlock with three runs against Jonas Cuotto for a 3-0 win. The game was played in three hours and 19 minutes. (This was a bad year for the Lugnuts in extra innings: They went 1-14, losing their first 12 extra-inning games of the year.)

2019: The Lugnuts lost a franchise record tenth straight road game, 3-2 at Fort Wayne, after Cobi Johnson allowed three first-inning runs, including a Justin Lopez two-run homer. Sam Keating struck out eight in 5 1/3 innings, with Henry Henry recording his second save with two scoreless innings of relief.
