LAST TIME OUT: Emmanuel Rodriguez's third inning grand slam provided an early spark, but the Worcester Red Sox scored five unanswered to finish off the afternoon in a 5-4 win over the Saints on Wednesday at CHS Field. With the Saints leading 4-1 headed to the seventh, the WooSox chipped away with a run. Back-to-back free passes put a pair on before Mikey Romero's single loaded the bases and Kristian Campbell's sacrifice fly cut the lead down to two. In the eighth, Tsung-Che Cheng, who homered to get Worcester on the board in the fourth, singled to lead off inning, eventually scoring on Matt Thaiss's ground-rule double. In the ninth, Marco Raya allowed four straight baserunners with one out, including sac bunt from Cheng that tied it and an RBI single from Thaiss that gave the Sox the lead with Matt Lloyd just evading the tag at the plate. Worcester pounded out 13 hits for the second night in-a-row and got four runs off the Saints bullpen after Andrew Bash's 4.0 innings of one-run ball.

WALK IT OUT: Saints outfielder Alan Roden has walked eight times in five games to open the season, and ranks tied for 3rd in all of baseball (MLB & Triple-A) in free passes drawn, trailing only Mike Trout (10) and Francisco Lindor (9) entering play Friday. It's the second-time ever that a Saints hitter has drawn at least eight free passes five games into St. Paul's season in franchise history and just the fourth time that a St. Paul batter has drawn at least eight walks in their first five games of the year with the Saints:

VARIETY IS THE SPICE OF LIFE: In his first five games as Saints manager, Brian Dinkelman has turned in five unique lineup cards. No Saints hitter has batted from the same spot in the order more than three times through the first five games and only Eric Wagaman has made at least four starts at a given position (first base) after Wednesday's action.

E-ROD WITH AN A-BOMB: Twins' No. 2 prospect Emmanuel Rodriguez clubbed a 451-foot grand slam off the bat at 113.6 mph on Wednesday afternoon, marking the 8th-hardest hit ball by exit velo in Triple-A this season, and the hardest-hit ball that's gone for a home run thus far. Including Major League Statcast data, Rodriguez has the second hardest-hit home run in baseball this season entering play on Thursday, only narrowly trailing Luke Raley's 113.8 mph blast off Tanner Bibbee on Opening Day for the Mariners. Rodriguez touts two of the top-10 hardest hit balls by exit velocity in Triple-A this year and four of the Top-50.

IT'S GOOD TO BE HOME: The Saints are now 3-3 all-time in home openers as a Triple-A franchise, having won the season lid-lifter at CHS Field each of the previous two seasons, including an 11-0 rout of Indianapolis last year on March 28. Despite just a 62-85 record overall last season, the Saints were a respectable 36-38 on home turf. Since becoming a Triple-A franchise, the Saints' .550 winning% at home (199-163) is 7th among 30 Triple-A clubs. Only Nashville (MIL), Tacoma (SEA), Durham (TBR), Indianapolis (PIT), Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (NYY), & Toledo (DET) have won more home games than the Saints in that run.

TWINS OF TOMORROW: The Saints open the season with nine of the Twins' Top-30 ranked prospects according to MLB.com, marking the most players listed on MLB's Minnesota Top-30 list to open a campaign in the Saints' history as a Triple-A franchise. Between Walker Jenkins, Kaelen Culpepper, Emmanuel Rodriguez, & Connor Prielipp, they also tout four prospects on either the MLB.com or Baseball America Top-100 list, surpassing last year's total of three when Rodriguez, Luke Keaschall, and Zebby Matthews all began the year with the Saints. Jenkins, the Twins' consensus top prospect, became the youngest player in Saints franchise history when he debuted at 20 years, 6 months, and 7 days of age last year. After a 1-for-20 start, the North Carolina prep product hit .296 (21-71) with eight extra-base hits, including his first two Triple-A homers, in his last 17 games. Culpepper, Minnesota's No. 2 prospect (MLB.com) and last year's Twins Minor League Player of the Year, made his Triple-A debut on Opening Day and hit safely in his first four games at the level. Prielipp, the Twins No. 4 (BA) prospect, returns in a Saints uniform after finishing last season in St. Paul. The remaining ranked prospects include Gabriel Gonzalez (7/10), Andrew Morris (13/13), Marco Raya (18/21), and John Klein (20/23). Left-hander Kendry Rojas (10/8) will also open the year on the Saints' injured list, but is expected to join the rotation within the first few weeks.

YOU'RE A SAINT: The Saints Opening Day roster features 16 players that saw action in a St. Paul uniform previously and 12 new faces in their first year in St. Paul. Among the 16 returners, 14 played for the Saints last season with catcher David Banuelos and Matt Bowman also returning to St. Paul after stints with other organizations. Among the 12 new players, only Kaelen Culpepper does not have previous Triple-A experience. With an average age of 26.7 on the active roster, the Saints are slightly younger than the average age for a Triple-A team last year (26.9). St. Paul's roster have 14 different U.S. states represented by hometown with 23 of the 28 on the active roster being American-born players. Internationally, the Saints tout three of their ranks from Venezuela (Gabby Gonzalez, Orlando Arcia, & Eduardo Salazar) and two from the Dominican Republic (E. Rodriguez & R. Brito).

BULLPEN MARCO: In just his 13th professional appearance in relief and his first in a save situation, Marco Raya held down the lead in the ninth for the Saints on Saturday. After appearing in just two games in relief over his first three professional seasons, Raya transitioned to a reliever role with the Saints last season, making nine straight appearances out of the St. Paul bullpen and ten total on the season. On Saturday, Raya punched out three of four batters faced in his season debut while generating six swings-and-misses. His average 4-seam fastball (96.5) and cutter (91.8) velocities were both up a tick from last season.

LAST APPEARANCE: Started Opening Day Friday at Indianapolis...after walking two of the first three batters he faced followed by an RBI single in the 1st, settled in to retire 11 in-a-row to end the outing...threw 25 four-seamers (41%), 18 sliders (30%), 10 curveballs (16%), 5 changeups (8%), and 3 sinkers (5%). Generated eight swings-and-misses, led by four on the four-seamer & 3 on the slider.

LETTING HIM LOOSE: Prielipp was called up for his Triple-A debut on August 19 at CHS Field last year having already thrown 61.2 innings with Double-A Wichita to start the season, a workload that exceeded his innings from the past five years combined (2020-24) going back to his freshman season at the University of Alabama. Between the COVID-19 pandemic cutting his All-American season short at just 21.0 innings in 2020, Tommy John limiting him to less than 10.0 as a sophomore in 2021, and another UCL surgery (internal brace) that limited him to fewer than 10.0 innings in his pro debut in 2023, Prielipp had already thrown more innings in a season across his pro and college career this year when he made his eighth start with the Wind Surge on May 14.

PRIELIPP'S GOT THE STUFF: Before injuries kept him off the field for much of the early portion of his college and pro career, Prielipp was considered to be a top-5 pick in the draft following his freshman season at Alabama, possessing the potential for three "plus" pitches. The southpaw touts an upper-90's fastball that's rare for a pitcher from the left side, as well as a devastating slider that uses a unique grip that the MLB Pipeline described as "one of the most devastating pitches in the college class of 2022" at the time, not to mention a terrific changeup that Baseball America rated as the "best changeup" in the Twins organization entering the 2026 season.

COME AND SMELL OUR DAIRY AIR: A native of Tomah, Wisconsin, Prielipp was one of the top high school pitching prospects in the Badger State as he wrapped up his prep career. He was named the Gatorade Wisconsin Player of the Year as well as a Collegiate Baseball News 1st Team All-American as a senior at Tomah High School in 2019 after going 6-2 with a 0.85 ERA and 118 strikeouts against just five walks in 49.0 innings as a 12th grader. Prielipp was also drafted in the 37th round that summer by the Boston Red Sox, becoming the first Tomah HS product ever taken in the MLB Draft.

2025

- **Jim Rantz Award Winner, Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Year**
- Totaled 82.2 IP between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, a new career-high after logging just 58.0 IP the previous five years combined (2020-24)
- Ranked 5th among Twins farmhands in K-Rate (27%), 3rd K-BB% (min 70 IP)
- Opened the season with Double-A Wichita, and went 0-6, 3.65 ERA (25 ER, 61.2 IP) with 73 strikeouts and 18 walks...pitched in short spurts, not going beyond the fourth inning and topping out at 76 pitches in a single outing
- Was named the Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July after recording a 1.20 ERA (2 ER, 15.0 IP) with five walks and 17 SO across 4 GS
- Was promoted for his Triple-A debut on Aug. 19 vs Round Rock and allowed 2 runs in 3.1 IP while striking out five against four walks
- Across five appearances (4 GS) with the Saints to end the season: went 1-3, 5.14 ERA (12 ER, 21.0 IP), 25 SO (27 K%) and 13 walks (14 BB%)

2024

- Began season on the 60-Day IL with High-A Cedar Rapids after appearing in just two games the year prior in his pro debut and undergoing UCL surgery
- After a pair of rehab appearances with FCL Twins & Low-A Fort Myers, joined the Kernels for his first outing of the season on July 27 @Quad Cities, where he fired 2.0 scoreless innings and was limited to 32 pitches
- Totaled 7 appearances (7 starts) while going 0-1, 3.26 ERA...struck out 32 (41.6 K%) and walked just seven (9.1 BB%) over 19.1 innings
- Went no more than 3.0 innings in a single start and fewer than 50 pitches in each outing

2023

- Pitched in just two games in his pro debut
- Was shutdown and placed on the 7-day IL with soreness and inflammation, returned for one rehab appearance on June 9 with FCL Twins and faced 13 batters over 2.2 IP before being shut down (UCL Surgery)

COLLEGE CAREER

- Limited to just 28.0 innings over two seasons at the University of Alabama
- Earned the Opening Day start for the Crimson Tide his freshman year in 2020...was 1-of-2 freshman in the Crimson Tide's history to start an opener since they became Division 1 (circa 1968)...only freshman in school history to record a win in the season lid-lifter
- Won his first three starts with Alabama, the first freshman since 1998 to do so
- Named a 1st Team All-American and National Freshman of the Year by Collegiate Baseball News in 2020

2025 Season: Playing in his 10th season in The Show, hit just .202 (41-203), 3 HR, 13 RBI and a .529 OPS in 76 games split between the Atlanta Braves & Colorado Rockies

- >Marked the Venezuela native's worst MLB season by OPS while also notching the fewest HR and RBI of his career...spent the whole year in the majors
- Broke camp with the Braves and went 6-for-30 (.200) at the plate in 10 games before landing on the 10-day IL with a left wrist fracture
- >Returned to action on May 6 with Atlanta but appeared in just four games and only received 1 AB before being released on May 25
- Signed as a free agent with Colorado on May 28 and closed the year hitting .203, 3 HR 12 RBI and a .544 OPS in 62 games with the Rox
- >Was mired in a 1-for-29 (.034) slide from July 5-July 26
- Graded as an above average defender at shortstop in the big leagues, posting a +2 Outs Above Average, in the 78th percentile of big leaguers at the position

- A 2021 World Series champion with Atlanta...saw just 4 AB in the postseason and drew a walk in one of his 5 PA
- >A .247 career postseason hitter (19-77) with 5 HR in 29 games...drilled 3 HR in the first 6 games of Milwaukee's 2018 run to the NLCS after 3 in 119 gm in reg. season
- Started his career with the Milwaukee Brewers organization, where he ascended to the big leagues for the first time in 2016 & spent six seasons with the club
- >Was traded to the Braves on April 6, 2021 in exchange for RHP Chad Sobotka and RHP Patrick Weigel
- In 2024, opened the Braves' season with back-to-back 3-hit games @PHI, 1-of-5 players in the Braves' modern era to do so

- >Raised his batting average 70 points & his OPS by 230+ points from his first season in Double-A in 2024
- Following his first Triple-A promotion to St. Paul, hit .234/.364/.458 (.822 OPS), 7 HR, 16 RBI in 39 games in the International League
