POP UP FROG NIGHT: After seeing a ninth inning comeback come up one run short last night, the FredNats transform into the Fredericksburg Frogs once again for game two of this six-game series with the Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Houston Astros). Tonight's Frog game is a make-up from Friday's rainout. RHP Braynan Romero starts today for Fredericksburg and will face Fayetteville for the second time this season. In his first FredNat start of the year in Fayetteville, Romero pitched 4.2 innings of scoreless baseball. However, Romero has a career ERA of 8.56 at VACU Stadium in two season with Fredericksburg. He faces Woodpecker righty Dylan Howard, who has not faced Fredericksburg in his career.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Fayetteville lead 4-0 after four innings, scoring four runs (two earned) off FredNat starter Bryan Polanco, and eventually held on for a 6-5 win in the series opener last night. Everett Cooper III had his best offensive game as a pro, finishing a double short of the cycle and driving in four out of the five FredNat runs, including a three-run homer to draw FBG back within a run in the ninth inning. Cristhian Vaquero had two hits and the other Fredericksburg RBI, and Kevin Dowdell had a scoreless relief outing.

DON'T EVEN TRY IT: The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach has been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers this season. After throwing out three more potential base stealers last night, Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading season total is up to 71, five ahead of Fayetteville, who is in second place in that category. However, Fredericksburg has allowed 80 fewer stolen bases than Fayetteville. Heading into play today, Bazzell leads MiLB by two with 45 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 41% of would-be base stealers. Rombach has 26 caught stealings himself, a top-25 mark in Minor League baseball, and is throwing out 35% of potential base stealers.

SECOND HALF VAQUERO: FredNat outfield prospect Cristhian Vaquero has enjoyed a very strong second half of the season offensively, pairing his hot bat with his exceptional outfield defense. In 22 second half games, Vaquero is hitting .325 (7th in CL) with an .898 OPS (6th). He's second in the league in the half with 44 total bases, his 27 hits are the third-most in the league, and his eight extra-base hits are sixth. Since the All-Star break, Vaquero is 7-for-11 with a triple and two stolen bases. His seven hits since the break are the most in Single-A baseball despite playing one fewer game than most every other team.

MISSED YA, MOTA: Jorgelys Mota returned from a three-week trip to the injured list with a strained hamstring on July 1, and since coming back, he's been one of the most impactful bats in all of the Carolina League. Since coming back from the IL, Mota is hitting .400 with four doubles, six RBI, two stolen bases and two walks.

NEARLY PERFECT PABLO: FredNat reliever Pablo Aldonis currently has the longest scoreless inning streak (19.1) among active pitchers in the Carolina League, and his current streak is the second-longest among active Single-A pitchers. Aldonis has not allowed a run since May 31st, and he has played practically every role for the FredNat bullpen. In that scoreless time frame, Aldonis has 25 strikeouts against five walks, and has allowed 10 total hits in that time frame.

THIS BULLPEN IS INSANE: The FredNat bullpen has been central to the team's efforts all season, but the group has taken it to a new level since June 1. Since then, FBG's bullpen ERA is 2.47, which is currently number two in professional baseball (150 total teams) after taking a small step back in the last three games. Fredericksburg is 32-1 when leading after seven innings this season, and 26-1 when leading after eight innings. Fredericksburg's 15 saves in that time frame is also tied for the second-most in Minor League Baseball.

THE STAFF: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

MEET HIM: Brayan David Romero...(pronounced: Bryan) was activated from the injured list and returned to Fredericksburg on 6/7 after completing a rehab assignment with the FCL Nationals.

NOT THE FIRST TIME: Romero is making his second stint with the FredNats after making seven regular season starts in FXBG last year. The righty posted a 5.52 ERA across 29.1 IP with 13 strikeouts to five walks. This is his third season in the Nationals organization.

LAST TIME OUT: Romero had a bounceback start in his last outing before the All-Star break, allowing just two hits across 4.2 innings at Carolina on 7/12. The Colombia native surrendered two runs, but only one of them was earned, as he got a no decision.

FIRESTARTER: Romero started game one of the Carolina League Championship series in 2024 at Kannapolis. In an eventual FredNat win, he threw 4.1 innings, giving up three earned runs to the Cannon Ballers.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordez, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordez has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
