- Connor O'Halloran played the role of stopper for the Blue Jays on Tuesday night, firing 6.2 scoreless innings to lead Dunedin to a 2-0 victory over Tampa, snapping a nine-game losing streak.
- O'Halloran turned in the best start of the year by a Blue Jays starter 6.2 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 9 Ks.
- O'Halloran out-dueled Tarpons starter Gabriel Barbosa to earn the win, as Tampa's hurler also pitched into the seventh and struck out nine.
- Dunedin claimed the lead in the second, as Manuel Beltre scored on a wild pitch. The lead grew to 2-0 in the sixth, as Yhoangel Aponte tripled and was driven in on Beltre's sac fly.
- Keiner Leon finished the seventh for Dunedin and then pitched a scoreless eighth. Yondrei Rojas nailed down the save with a 1-2-3 ninth his first save of the season.

#### STREAK SNAPPED

Dunedin snapped its nine-game losing streak last night, ending the team's longest losing streak since last year's Jays team also lost nine straight (July 5-18).

### YOU GET NOTHING!

The Blue Jays turned in their first shutout victory of the season last night, behind 6.2 shutout innings from starter Connor O'Halloran. The shutout win marks Dunedin's first nine-inning shutout win since July 22, 2023, when the Jays downed Lakeland 1-0.

#### **OFFENSIVE OUTAGE**

Dunedin's offense has slowed in its last 10 games, scoring just 21 runs (2.1 per game) while batting .192 with an OPS of .540. In the first 12 games of the season, the Blue Jays averaged 6.5 runs per game.

#### NO ROOM FOR ERROR

Each of the Blue Jays' last 11 games have been decided by fewer than four runs. Six of those games have been decided by two or fewer tallies. Eight of the team's first 11 games were decided by four or more runs.

### IT'S GOOD TO SEE YOU

Through the first seven games of the season series, Dunedin has dominated Tampa, outscoring the Tarpons 49-19. In the first series between the squads, the Jays batted to a team OPS of .732 in the set and stole 21 bases.

### WALKIN' ON SUNSHINE

This week's series pit the Florida State League's leaders in walks drawn and walks issued against each other. Tampa's 115 walks at the plate lead the league, ahead of Dunedin's 109. On the mound, the Blue Jays (112) and Tarpons (113) both rank top three in free passes. However, last night's series opener featured a combined three walks- the fewest in an FSL game last night.

#### LOOKING FOR SAVINGS

Last night's save from Yondrei Rojas marked just the third save by the Blue Jays this season - tied for the second fewest in the Florida State League.

#### WHAT A RELIEF!

Blue Jays relievers have been strong in the last seven games, posting a 1.95 ERA (6 ER) in 27.2 innings of work. Dunedin's 3.28 bullpen ERA ranks second in the league behind Daytona's 3.08.

### YOUNG GUN

Dunedin shortstop Arjun Nimmala is the second-youngest player in the Florida State league to open the season, at 18.5 years old (behind Daytona's Alfredo Duno at 18.2). Maykel Minoso joins Nimmala as the second 18 year old on the Blue Jays' roster.

### **COMING UP THE PIPELINE**

The D-Jays roster is loaded with eight of the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. The 30-man roster includes the Jays' last two first round draft picks; LHP Brandon Barriera (2022) and Infielder Arjun Nimmala (2023). Nimmala is ranked as the third-best prospect in the system, while Barriera is ranked fourth. Opening Day starter Fernando Perez is Pipeline's No. 24 Blue Jays prospect, after leading the FCL Blue Jays in innings pitched in 2023.
