LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox snapped their season-long three-game losing streak in a 2-1 victory over the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Thursday night, despite collecting only two hits all night. Bowie was no-hit for the first six innings by Richmond starter John Michael Bertrand but tied up the game on its first hit in the seventh on a TT Bowens RBI double. Bowie took the lead on a Samuel Basallo RBI single in the eighth with two strikes and two outs. Dylan Heid earned the win after 1.2 innings of scoreless relief.

TWO IS TIMELY

The last time Bowie won a game while recording only two hits was on September 8, 2021 in a 1-0 six-inning rain-shortened win at Harrisburg. Andrew Daschbach and Zach Watson collected the only two hits of the game with Daschbach launching a solo homer in the fifth. David Lebron and Ryan Conroy combined for a six-inning shutout at FNB Field.

BIG TIME BASALLO

C Samuel Basallo delivered in the clutch last night in the eighth with a two-strike, two out go-ahead RBI single to put Bowie ahead 2-1 for good. The 19-year-old now has two go-ahead RBI hits in the eighth this season. In late/close contests, the Orioles No. 2 prospect is batting .333 (4-for-12) with two home runs and five RBI. After posting a .274 OBP in April, Basallo now has a .324 OBP in May.

JUD FLEXIN' ON EM

OF Jud Fabian has continued to stay hot in the month of May. The Orioles No. 12 prospect launched his team-leading eighth homer of the season in the first inning on Tuesday with a two-run shot. The homer was Fabian's sixth of the month, which is tied for the league lead along with Harrisburg's Brady House. In the month of May, Fabian has a .935 OPS with six homers and 15 RBI. The 23-year-old is fifth in the Eastern League in home runs.

CLOSE AND COMPETITIVE

Yesterday marked Bowie's seventh one-run victory of the season. The Baysox are 7-2 in one-run games and have lost the fewest number of one-run games in the Eastern League. Eight of the last 10 games have been decided by four runs or less and six of the nine games against Richmond this season have been decided by four runs or less.

YOU GOOD PHAM

RHP Alex Pham makes his ninth start of the season and his second against the Squirrels. The Orioles No. 24 prospect most recently dealt 4.2 innings of one-run ball with a season-high seven strikeouts at Binghamton last Saturday. After recording a 7.78 ERA in the month of April, Pham has rebounded in May with a 1.88 ERA over 14.1 innings thrown, the 7th-lowest ERA this month in the Eastern League. In his last start on April 24 at Richmond, Pham struck out six over five innings but gave up three runs on three hits and three walks in a no-decision.

SIZING UP THE SQUIRRELS

Entering this week, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are fifth in the Southwest Division at 17-22 but most recently took five of six against Reading at home. The Double-A affiliate of the Giants took four of six against Bowie in the first meeting of the season at The Diamond. Seven of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), OF Grant McCray (OF), OF Vaun Brown (No. 15), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19), C Adrian Sugastey (No. 23), OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26), and RHP Carson Ragsdale (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Carson Ragsdale makes his ninth start of the season and his third against the Baysox. The former Phillies farmhand is coming off his first scoreless start of May with 5.0 strong innings over three hits, no walks and a season-high nine strikeouts last Saturday vs Reading. In two starts vs the Baysox this season, Ragsdale has a 1.93 ERA over 9.1 innings pitched with 10 strikeouts and four walks. The 25-year-old turns 26 tomorrow.

2024: Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. **Struck out season-high 7 over 4.2 IP of one-run ball in most recent start on 5/18 @ BNG. Owns a 1.88 ERA in three May starts, which is 7th-lowest in the league. Opposing batters hitting .232, which is 4th-lowest in O's system. Has struck out 5+ batters in five of eight starts.** Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after dealing 5.0 IP with 6 K, matching season-high.

2023: Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

2022: Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings, soon finding himself on the injured list for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season. Allowed one run in 2.1 innings of postseason action for Aberdeen.

2021: Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

Personal: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
