LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox and SeaWolves went to extra innings for a second straight night and Erie defeated Bowie 4-3 in 10 innings. Bowie held a one-run lead entering the ninth but Austin Murr tied the score with an RBI single to force extras. Ben Malgeri hit a two-run homer off **Connor Pavolony** to give the SeaWolves their first lead of the night. **Collin Burns** pulled Bowie within a run with an RBI double in the 10th and represented the tying run but **Samuel Basallo** struck out against RJ Petit to end the game.

START ME UP

In the month of August, the Bowie starting rotation has the lowest ERA in Double-A at 2.20. The rotation also owns the third-lowest WHIP (1.03). Despite throwing the fewest number of innings in Double-A, Baysox starters have recorded the fourth-best strikeouts per 9 innings at 9.79.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday after going 9-for-20 (.450) with four extra base hits, including four consecutive multi-hit games, in Altoona. Beavers has reached base in 81 of 100 games played this season. The Orioles No. 8 prospect is second in the Eastern League in walks (59) and tied for third in stolen bases (27).

BASALLO BASHES

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, is second in the Eastern League in total bases (174) and is tied for second in hits (109). The No. 3 O's/ No. 11 MLB prospect is tied for the league lead this month with 23 hits in 67 at-bats (.343).

BRADFIELD TO BOWIE

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** went 3-for-3 with two RBI, two runs scored, two stolen bases, and was a homer shy of the cycle in his home debut on Tuesday. The Orioles No. 6 prospect has four stolen bases already at Double-A and 63 total on the season, which is the second-most in all of MiLB. Bradfield was drafted with the 17th overall pick by the Orioles last year out of Vanderbilt.

THE JOSEN ONE

Since being promoted to Bowie last Tuesday, IF/OF **Tavian Josenberger** has registered his first Double-A hit, RBI, stolen base and walk off in his first seven games. On Tuesday, he laid down the sacrifice bunt to bring home the winning run after a throwing error in the 10th. Josenberger is tied for 11th in all of MiLB with 50 stolen bases.

REED IS ROLLIN'

OF **Reed Trimble** blasted his first Double-A homer on Tuesday, which traveled 392 feet. In his first six games, Trimble is 8-for-23 (.348) with a homer, three doubles and six RBI. The 24-year-old switch hitter has also stolen a career-high 29 bases this season without being caught.

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST

Bowie has scored in the first inning in nine of its last 14 games. When the Baysox score first, they are 38-19 this season compared to 17-41 when they do not. The Baysox have scored the second-most first inning runs in the Eastern League (68).

SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

Entering this week, the Erie SeaWolves are second in the Southwest Division with a record of 25-19. The Double-A affiliate of the Tigers won the first half in the Southwest Division. Four of the Tigers top 30 prospects are on the SeaWolves active roster - RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 2), IF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 8), RHP Troy Melton (No. 12), and RHP Eric Silva (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Troy Melton makes his 22nd start of the season for the SeaWolves in his first year at Double-A. The 23-year-old has struck out the 11th-most batters in the Eastern League (109) in 92.2 innings pitched. Melton lasted only two innings in his most recent start vs Akron, allowing seven runs on eight hits with three walks and five strikeouts. The Tigers No. 12 prospect faced Bowie on May 4 and threw four innings of one-run ball with six strikeouts in a no decision.

2024: Has thrown 6th-most innings (89.2) and has struck out 8th-most batters (102) in O's system this season. Threw 4.2 IP, allowed 1 R with 7 K (one shy of matching season-high) in most recent start on 8/16 @ ALT. Longest start since 6/30 @ REA. Owns a 5.01 ERA in second half. Recorded a 4.08 ERA in the first half. Looking to pitch five innings for first time since 4/26 @ RIC and still looking for first win of season. Owns a 4.93 ERA in 11 home starts. Baysox are 7-15 when Bright starts. Finished month of May with a 3.68 ERA over 22 IP. Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA (9th lowest in EL) over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts. Went five innings each in three straight starts from 4/14 - 4/26. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
