JUMBO SHRIMP WIN SIXTH STRAIGHT

Thanks to a four-run third inning and a three-run fifth, the Jumbo Shrimp rolled to an 8-2 victory Thursday against the Gwinnett Stripers. It was Jacksonville's sixth consecutive win, putting them at 8-7 on the season, the first time they've been over .500 in 2022. Eight of the nine batters in the order recorded at least one base hit, four Jumbo Shrimp tallied multi-hit games, and two notched multi-RBI games. Jeff Lindgren notched his first win of the season and the second quality start for a Jacksonville starter, as he threw six innings, allowing just one unearned run and only one hit.

SIXPENCE NONE THE RICHER

Jacksonville has won six consecutive games, their longest winning streak in an April since April 24-29, 2010, when they won six contests in a row. During their current six-game winning streak, the Jumbo Shrimp are outscoring their opponents 48-12 with a 69-22 advantage in hits and a 10-1 margin in home runs. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp currently rank second out of 120 Minor League Baseball teams in hits, tied for second in runs and tied for fifth in home runs over this span.

THE ARM BARN

The Jacksonville bullpen has been outstanding during the club's current six-game winning streak. During this run, the Jacksonville bullpen has ceded just five runs, all earned, on 13 hits in 25.1 innings for a 1.79 ERA (32 K, 10 BB). Seven pitchers in the bullpen have tossed at least one inning without allowing a run and all have at least one stikeout during this span. Additionally, the club's relievers posted a 14.1 scoreless innings streak from April 16-21.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 20 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking tied for third in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast of late; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 hombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009 when the Suns

SHRIMP ON THE BARBIE

The Jumbo Shrimp rank second in the International League in runs (94; 6.3 per game), and the biggest indication as to why has been the club's strong performance with runners on base. With the bases empty, Jacksonville is hitting .252/.345/.387, producing a .732 OPS that ranks ninth in the 20-team league. However, with runners on base, the club's batting line has surged to .298/.375/.528, with the resulting .903 OPS placing second in the circuit.

CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE

After bashing two home runs in Wednesday's 9-1 win over Gwinnett. Charles Leblanc continued with two hits and one RBI in Thursday's 8-2 win. Leblanc's two hits gives him five multi-hit games in 2022. On the season, the native of Laval, QC in Canada leads the International League in batting average (.410) and OPS (1.295) while ranking second in OBP (.500) and slugging (.795).

LEWIN AND CLARK BURDICK

Both Lewin Díaz and Peyton Burdick have gotten off to a strong starts. Díaz is 16-for-53, slashing .302/.397/.528/.925 with three doubles, three home runs, 14 RBIs and 11 runs scored. Meanwhile, Burdick, the Marlins' reigning Minor League Player of the Year, is 11-for-43, slashing .256/.407/.488/.895 with a double, three homers, six RBIs and a league-leading 16 runs. Thus, of the 94 runs the Jumbo Shrimp have scored this season - a figure that ranks second in the International League - the pair have accounted for 41 of those tallies (not double-counting the run scored and RBI from home runs), a ratio of 43.6 percent.

PITCH PERFECT

Through the season's first 10 games, Jacksonville starting pitchers ceded at least four runs on six different outings. posting a collective 7.85 ERA in the process. Over the last five games, though, Jumbo Shrimp starters have yielded just four runs, one earned, in 24.1 innings for a 0.37 ERA. During this five-game run, the club's lid-lifters have registered 17 strikeouts against 13 hits and 10 walks.



-Originally selected by the New York Yankees in the 16th round of the 2009 draft, Mitchell bypassed on a commitment to play at the University of North Carolina to begin his professional career.

-Mitchell made his major league debut for the Yankees on August 10, 2014 by tossing 2.0 scoreless innings of relief against Cleveland at Yankee Stadium.

-The Yankees traded Mitchell along with infielder Chase Headley on December 12, 2017 to the San Diego Padres in exchange for outfielder Jabari Blash. The Padres designated Mitchell for assignment on March 28, 2019, and after spending the entirety of that season with Triple-A El Paso and the AZL Padres, he elected free agency on October 1, 2019.

-On January 16, 2020, Mitchell signed a minor league contract with the Chicago White Sox. He was part of their player pool at the team's Alternate Training Site before being released on August 24, 2020.

-After signing with the Marlins on July 28, Mitchell's first three appearances with Jacksonville were all hitless, spanning a total of 8.0 innings (0 R, 3 BB, 9 K)

-Mitchell had his contract selected by the Marlins on August 19 and made a pair of appearances for them before being designated for assignment on August 25 and then outrighted to Jacksonville on August 27.

2019 SEASON

-Of Mitchell's 11 starts with El Paso, only four went for at least 5.0 innings of work..

2018 SEASON

-After posting an 0-3 record and 7.08 ERA in 12 games, seven starts, before the All-Star Break with San Diego, Mitchell went 2-1 with a 2.19 ERA in four starts in the season's second-half with the Padres.

-In 11 starts with San Diego, Mitchell went 2-4 with a 4.61 ERA over 56.2 innings (60 H, 34 BB, 31 K). However, in five relief appearances with the Padres, the right-hander was 0-0 with an 8.27 ERA in 16.1 innings (25 H, 9 BB, 7 K).
