Today: It's Game 2 of a 12-game, 13-day homestand, with the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, playing the second of a six-game series against the Quad Cities River Bandits, the High-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. Tonight is also a Dog Days of Summer, with dogs welcome to the park!

Starting Matchup: Right-hander **Christian Fernandez**, acquired by Oakland via trade from Tampa Bay for Christian Bethancourt last year, makes his third start of the season for the Lugnuts. Quad Cities counters with dominant southpaw **Noah Cameron**, who leads the Midwest League with an 18.5% swinging strike percentage and ranks second in xFIP (1.70) behind teammate Luinder Avila, tomorrow night's starter.

Last Night: Lugnuts 6, River Bandits 5 (10 innings). **Lazaro Armenteros** hit a two-run homer in the first inning and scored the game-winning run on a **Parker Harm** wild pitch in the tenth inning, helping the Lugnuts recover from losing a 5-0 lead to take the series opener against Quad Cities. It was the Nuts' first win vs. the Bandits since a 3-2 win on July 20, 2017 (which was sandwiched between 20-3 and 14-3 losses at QC.)

LUG•NOTES

Let 'Em Know: 2022 fifth-rounder **Jack Perkins** only tossed ten innings last year in his pro debut; this year, Perkins has dominated the MWL through three starts, allowing one run on seven hits in 15 1/3 innings, with 17 strikeouts compared to five walks. His 0.78 WHIP ranks first among all pitchers with at least 15 innings, his 0.59 ERA is tied for 1st and his .132 opponent batting average ranks second. The Indiana Hoosier fanned eight River Bandits in 5 1/3 scoreless innings last night, striking out Royals No. 1 prospect Gavin Cross in all three of their meetings.

Streaking: OF **Caeden Trenkle** went 0-for-4 but drew a walk last night, extending his on-base streak to 13 games, every game he has played.

On a Tear-os: **Lazaro Armenteros** has belted five home runs in his last five games (going 8-for-17 in that span), placing him in a first-place tie with Wisconsin's Alex Hall. He leads the Midwest League in slugging percentage (.794) and OPS (1.209).

Tuesday Thrillers: Not only did Lansing walk off Quad Cities last night, the Nuts' first walk-off win of the year, but Double-A Midland roared back from a six-run deficit to stun Corpus Christi, 15-14, on **Lawrence Butler**'s two-out, two-run single in the bottom of the ninth. Aiding the comeback effort: outfielder **Denzel Clarke**, a 2022 Lugnut, made his Double-A debut and, after striking out in his first at-bat, hit a two-run homer, a three-run homer, drew a pair of walks, and scored four runs.

Arriving at the Port: Also newsworthy in the system, A's prospects **Henry Bolte** (the 2022 2nd-round selection), **Tommy Stevenson** (2022 19th-rounder) and **Bjay Cooke** (a two-way player from Australia) were transferred in to Single-A Stockton yesterday from Extended Spring Training.

Power Switch, Flipped On: After not homering in their first six games of the year, the Nuts have hit ten roundtrippers in their last nine games.

Pitcher's Best Friend: The Lugnuts' infield turned another double play yesterday, giving them at least one double play in 12 of their 15 games, and a league-leading 17 double plays in total.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mauer); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: The Lugnuts score five runs in the fifth inning to defeat the Spartans in the 4th Annual Crosstown Showdown presented by Auto-Owners Insurance, 5-4. The game lasts nine innings, with 6,778 in attendance. The game was originally scheduled to be played on April 7th but was postponed due to rain.

2011: SS Gustavo Pierre committed a franchise record four errors (two throwing, one missed catch, one fielding) and went 0-for-4 with three strikeouts in a 5-3 loss at home to Great Lakes. The bad day brought Pierre's error total to 15 errors in 17 Lugnuts games.

2019: Josh Winckowski struck out eight in seven scoreless innings, Jackson Rees handled the final two frames, and the Lugnuts blanked the high-scoring Hot Rods, 4-0, at Bowling Green Ballpark.

Life as a Lugnut in 2022: Assigned to Lansing on July 10 after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays with Triple-A outfielder Cal Stevenson on July 9 for Christian Bethancourt... debuted for the Nuts on July 13 at Fort Wayne, looking great with a 1-2-3 first inning before allowing three runs on three singles and two walks in the second inning and then a fourth run in the third inning on two singles sandwiched around a wild pitch... after delay due to All-Star Break, made second start on July 27th, allowing seven runs at Great Lakes in two innings (four runs in 1st, three in 2nd... gave up leadoff home run in each frame (Eddys Leonard, Edwin Mateo)... impressed with five hitless innings at Dayton, August 10th.

The Early Word: When announcing the trade with the Rays, Athletics general manager Dan Feinstein summed up Fernandez to the media, "A four-pitch mix. Fastball averages 93. Three really good off-speed pitches. The change-up is probably the best one. Has the ability to get swings and misses, plus a slider and curve ball." Feinstein also informed the media that Fernandez missed the 2021 season with an unspecified arm injury.

Home Cooking: Home of Cabimas is located in northwestern Venezuela on the shore of Maracaibo Lake in the state of Zulia... notables from Cabimas include MLB ace Pablo López and longtime Major Leaguer Vic Davalillo (1963-1980).

Path Through the Pros: Debuted in 2016 in Dominican Summer League working entirely out of the bullpen... converted to starting pitcher in 2017 DSL with greater success... split 2018 between DSL and Gulf Coast League... spent 2019 in Appalachian League... missed 2020 (canceled MiLB season) and 2021 (injury).

2022 Dominance in the Rays' System: Opened this season as a middle reliever in the Charleston RiverDogs bullpen, striking out five in 2 1/3 innings vs. Myrtle Beach on April 10 in season debut; it had been 958 days since his last MiLB appearance on August 27, 2019... pitched out of the bullpen through late May, peaking in final appearance with eight strikeouts in four innings vs. August, May 20... moved into the starting rotation May 26 vs. Delmarva and responded with four scoreless innings, six strikeouts... made five starts in June: 3.27 ERA, 22 IP, 10 BB, 30 K, .195 avg. ... in two starts in July: 2.79 ERA, 9 2/3 IP, 3 BB, 10 K, .263 avg. ... excelled at home (33 2/3 IP, 2.14 ERA, .197 avg., 1 HR) compared to road (24 1/3 IP, 3.70 ERA, .207 avg., 5 HR)... because of change-up, very tough on lefties (.179, 0 HR) vs. righties (.223, 5 HR)... limited opposition to .179 avg. with runners in scoring position.
