JACKSONVILLE WINS FIFTH-STRAIGHT

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp plated two runs in the eighth inning, coming away with a 5-4 win over the Rochester Red Wings for their fifth-straight win, Saturday night. Trailing 4-3 in the eighth, Jacksonville (42-26) took advantage of Rochester's (22-44) bullpen in the late innings for the fourth-consecutive game. **Graham Pauley** (2) started the inning with a solo homer off Red Wings reliever **Parker Dunshee** (L, 1-2). In the ensuing at-bat, **Matt Mervis** doubled and scored the go-ahead run two batters later on a double from **Maximo**

SUMMER DAYS DRIFTING AWAY

Jacksonville began the 2025 campaign on a tear, posting a 21-8 record through the first 29 games of the season. After posting a Triple-A best, ERA (2.80), batting average against (.205) and tied for the best record (21-8), the Jumbo Shrimp have cooled off heading in to summer. In their last 38 games (May 1-present), Jacksonville is 21-18 but have a -12 run differential. Their .682 OPS is the second-lowest in Triple-A while their 346 strikeouts are the 10th-most.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the season opener, Jacksonville has recorded a stolen base in 55 of their last 67 games, with multiple steals in 42 contests. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have eight games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. With two stolen bases last night, the Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A and are fourth in the minors with 153 steals.

EXIT (VELOCITY) STRATEGY

Jacksonville's biggest strength in 2025, along with stealing bases, has been its pitching and defense. The club ranks second in Triple-A with a 3.64 ERA, and their 266 runs allowed are the third-fewest at the level. Interestingly, Jacksonville's staff ranks only 15th in Triple-A in strikeouts (594), but their 478 hits allowed are the level's fewest, meaning the club has supressed quite a few balls put in play. Opponents have mustered an average exit velocity of 87.1 against the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff, the fourth-lowest such mark in Triple-A.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD

Jacksonville's bullpen went nearly a week between earned runs, yielding three runs in the ninth inning of their May 24 contest against Memphis before a ninth-inning tally on Friday for Gwinnett. Over their last 18 games dating back to May 25, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to surrender 31 runs, 27 earned, on 64 hits in 82.2 innings for a 2.94 ERA. Jacksonville relievers have combined for 81 strikeouts against 40 walks during this stretch.

WALK IT OUT

Through 68 games thus far in 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp have totaled 251 free passes (3.7 BB/G). **Jakob Marsee** rans second in walks in the International League (46). Among the 106 qualified players in the circuit, Marsee ranks 11th in walk rate (16.5%). Including Marsee, Jacksonville has four other players scattered among the 106 other qualified players in walk rate in the IL. (**Maximo Acosta**, 11.1%; **Jacob Berry**, 9.5%; **Troy Johnston**, 8.1%; **Andrew Pintar**, 6.6%).

PITCH PERFECT

Jacksonville's 42 wins in 2025 can be attributed to the strength of their pitching staff. Not does the staff own the third-best ERA in Triple-A (3.64), they've coupled that with the 15th-most strikeouts (594) and the fourth-fewest walks (251). The low strikeout number isn't necessarily troubling because the staff is tied for the second-fewest pitches per inning (16.25). Meaning, that opposing hitters don't draw a ton of three-ball counts, but they also don't drive up the pitch counts of Jacksonville hurlers. Jumbo Shrimp starters average 4.0 IP per contest and own a Triple-A-best 15.78 pitches per inning. In addition, the bullpen averages 4.2 IP per game and is third in Triple-A in pitches/inning (16.64) behind Durham (16.56) & Nashville (16.63).

SHRIMP BITES

In years past, the Jumbo Shrimp flexed their muscles, ranking near the top of the International League in home runs, however this year has been a little different. Through the club's first 68 games in 2022, they averaged 26.2 AB/HR and hit the third-most in the circuit (89). In 2023, they clubbed 77 HR in their first 68 games (29.4 HR/AB), ranking 13th. This year, Jacksonville has clubbed 60 HR (T-6th-Fewest) and are averaging 36.6 AB/HR, which ranks 15th in the IL.
