TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve play a critical Second Half series with the Harrisburg Senators. Altoona is 9-5 against the Senators this season.

Lefty Alex Clemmey takes the ball for the Senators tonight. Clemmey attended Bishop Hendricken HS in Rhode Island, same HS ás Padres RHP Michael King, and was drafted in the 2nd round by Cleveland in 2023, the Nationals acquired him last July in the deal for OF Lane Thomas. Clemmey, who pitched for the National League in the Futures Game this year, makes his third Double-A start tonight, he's allowed 13 runs in 7.0 innings in his first two outings. He recorded a 2.47 ERA in 19 games with 113 strikeouts in 87 IP at High-A Wilmington this year.

RECORD WATCH: With three projected starts remaining in the 2025 season, righty Wilber Dotel has a chance to finish in the top-5 of strikeouts in a single-season in franchise history. His 119 strikeouts are just 5 shy of Tom Gorzelanny's 2005 campaign in which he struck out 124. Ian Snell holds the franchise record with 142 strikeouts in 2004. Luis Ortiz in 2022 was the most recent Curve pitcher to threaten the franchise record for strikeouts, earning 126 that season.

DUCE IS LOOSE: Infielder Duce Gourson has emerged as one of Altoona's most underrated players in the Second Half of the season. In his last 17 games, he is 23-for-60 (.383) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBI and 12 BB (since August 7).

HOTLANTA: Infielder Termarr Johnson has seven multi-hit games since July 28, batting .359 (28-for-78) with six extra base hits in his last 20 games. Johnson is batting .417 during his current 12-game on-base streak (August 12).

THE SAGINAW KID: Infielder Mitch Jebb has picked up seven multi-hit games across his last 20 games, he's batting .366 (26-for-71) with a .447 on-base percentage, 5 2B, 1 3B and 7 RBI.

Jebb picked up his 32nd stolen base of the season Tuesday, August 26 at Harrisburg, 5th-most by an Eastern League player this year. He is the first Curve player to steal 30 bases in a season since **Jared Oliva** stole 36 bases in 2019. Only two players in franchsie history (**Rajai Davis** and **Rich Thompson** in 2005) have stolen 40 bases in a season for the Curve.

No. 1: Baseball's top prospect, Konnor Griffin, joined the Curve on Monday, August 18. Griffin, at 19 years, 3 months and 26 days, he is the youngest player in franchise history to suit up for The Curve. Griffin is the tenth player in franchise history, just the third infielder, to join Altoona while ranked as the No. 1 prospect in baseball, first since Paul Skenes in 2023. Griffin ranks among all minor league players in runs scored (2nd, 102), stolen bases (7th, 64), hits (4th, 142), and batting average. (5th, .330).

Griffin is the first Pirates minor leaguer to steal 60 bases since Manny Ravelo stole 70 bases in 2001 with Single-A Lynchburg and Hickory.

POSTSEASON CURVE: With 16 games remaining in the Second Half, Altoona holds a 1.0 game lead over Harrisburg in the Southwest Division. The Curve were last in the postseason in 2018 when they fell to the Akron RubberDucks in the Division

NICK AT NIGHT: First baseman Nick Cimillo has returned from the All-Star break with a vengeance. In his last 30 games, he's picked up 17 extra base hits (.900 OPS). In that time he ranks 2nd among Double-A players in HR (9), 6th in XBH (17), 7th in SLG% (.559) and 12th in OPS (.900).

CLOSE WINS: 25 of Altoona's last 32 wins (since June 18) have all come in a save situation for the bullpen. 60 of the team's 121 games this year (49%) have been decided by two runs or fewer.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

## **ALTOONA CURVE COACHING STAFF**

Andy Fox Manager (1st Season) Career Record: 45-94

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching career has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rangers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

#### Matt Ford Pitching Coach 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an instructor in the Pirates system, previously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

#### Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

#### Casey Harms Hitting Coach 1st season/11th overall

Harms begins his fifth season as a Pirates instructor in 2025 and joins Altoona after serving as Greensboro's Bench Coach in 2024. Harms joined the Pirates in 2021 as the Hitting Coach in the FCL. He played outfield at Division III Occidental College in Los Angeles and went on to coach in the collegiate ranks at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018) and Santa Barbara City College (2019-2021). He also spent two seasons as the Manager for the Waterloo Bucks in the Northwoods League (2019-20) and led the team to a 28-13 record and a league championship in 2020.

#### Gary Green Bench Coach 4th season/20th overall

Green returns for a fourth season in Altoona and his 20th season as a minor league instructor with the Pirates. He has previously served as the Bench Coach in Indianapolis (2022) as well as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Field Instructor for the Pirates (2011-2021). A Pittsburgh native, Green's father, Fred, won a World Series with the Pirates in 1960. Green spent 11 seasons managing in the Tigers minor league system (99-10). A former Major League infielder for parts of five seasons, Green was drafted 27th overall by the Padres in 1984 and played on Team USA in the 1984 Olympic Games.
