## **EXPRESS SHUTOUT COMETS**

The Express took down the Comets by a final of 5-0 on Wednesday. Round Rock put two on in the second with a C Cooper Johnson walk and SS Jonathan Ornelas single. DH Chad Wallach sent Johnson around with a single and the Express took a 1-0 lead. In his next at-bat, Wallach singled and 2B Alex De Goti belted a two-run homer. De Goti's homer extended the E-Train lead to 3-0. LF Kellen Strahm continued the frame with a walk before 1B Blaine Crim doubled into the corner in left and Strahm came home moving the Express advantage to 4-0 after five. Round Rock scratched another run across in the sixth. Ornelas doubled and De Goti drew a walk. CF Alejandro Osuna tallied his second double of the night and drove in his first run for a 5-0 Express edge. RHP Adrian Houser held the Comets hitless through 6.2 innings before 1B Michael Chavis singled in the seventh. Houser finished the night with 8.2 scoreless innings allowing four hits, one walk and four strikeouts. RHP Codi Heuer shut the door with a strikeout as the E-Train won, 5-0.

## **BLACH GETS THE BALL**

LHP Ty Blach is set to make his second start with the E-Train. Blach signed a minor league contract with the Rangers on May 2 and made his Express debut on May 9 in El Paso. The lefty threw 6.0 shutout innings, allowed four hits, a walk and struck out six. Blach has appeared in the Major Leagues over parts of seven seasons with San Francisco, Baltimore and Colorado with 156 appearances, 70 starts and a 5.42 ERA (313 ER/520.0 IP).

## **HOUSER'S GEM**

RHP Adrian Houser threw 8.2 innings of scoreless baseball on Wednesday night. It is the longest outing of any Triple-A pitcher this season. Houser allowed four hits and one walk while striking out four batters. He collected 16 ground ball outs. Houser ranks third in innings pitched (39.1) in hte PCL, ninth in strikeouts (37), fourth in opposing average (.214) and fifth in WHIP (1.14). The last complete game Round Rock has had on the mound came June 16, 2016 when LHP Michael Roth blanked Colorado Springs.

## **BLAINE IS BACK**

After making his debut with the Rangers on May 2, INF Blaine Crim was optioned back to Round Rock on May 12. In his first two games back, he is 2-for-8 with a double, homer, two RBIs and a run scored. He is sixth in the PCL with eight homers, fourth in slugging (.577) and seventh in OPS (.940). He is tied for third in the league (min. 100 PA) with an average exit velocity of 92.4 MPH.

## TRY TO STOP STRAHM

OF Kellen Strahm stole his 14th base of the year in Wednesday's win. Strahm ranks third in the PCL in stolen bases and has only been caught once. He swiped 14 bases in 41 games with the Express last year and posted a career-high 29 stolen bags between Double-A and Triple-A a season ago.

## EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
