YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Erie SeaWolves, 7-3. Josh Crouch opened the scoring with an RBI single in the second to give Erie a 1-0 lead. Erie scored three runs in the fourth to open a 4-0 lead. In the bottom of the fourth, **Diego Rincones** and **Will Wilson** hit back-to-back homers to close the score to 4-2. Andrew Navigato hit a three-run homer in the ninth to extend the SeaWolves' lead to 7-2.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This week's set is the final series of the 2022 regular season and the SeaWolves' second visit to The Diamond this year. The Flying Squirrels dropped four-of-six at UPMC Park from April 19-24. In a six-game series in Richmond from June 7-12, the Flying Squirrels won five games, clinching a winning record against the SeaWolves in the first half.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 23-40 in the second half. They are 17-32 in the last 49 games. The Flying Squirrels have won eight series, lost 10 and split five this year. Last week in Bowie, the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win of the second half. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,440 strikeouts, the most in the history of the Eastern League, and rank tied for third with 159 homers. Richmond is 26-26 in games decided by two-or-less runs.

THE SEAWOLVES are in first place in the Southwest Division standings with five games remaining, one game ahead of the Baysox. If Erie and Bowie finish the second half tied, the SeaWolves hold the tiebreaker and would earn a spot in the Eastern League playoffs. Erie lost four-of-six in last week's series against Akron and split the previous week against the Baysox. On the year, Erie is tied for the highest team batting average (.248) and rank second in homers (169). Erie's roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (3), RHP Ty Madden (4), RHP Reese Olson (9), C Dillon Dingler (10), OF Parker Meadows (17), LHP Brant Hurter (22), SS Luis Garcia (24) and RHP Elvis Alvarado (27).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Kyle Harrison** makes his 18th Double-A start and his second against the SeaWolves. He last pitched on Friday at Bowie and threw four scoreless innings, allowing one hit and striking out seven. He faced the SeaWolves in his third Double-A start on June 9 at The Diamond and allowed three runs, including two homers, over four innings with eight strikeouts. On the season, Harrison ranks first in the minors in strikeout percentage (40.1), SO/9 IP (15.0) and K-BB% (29.2). He is second in the minors with 180 strikeouts. Since the start of the 2021 season and his professional debut, he has recorded 337 strikeouts, the second-most in the minors, trailing only 362 by Diamondbacks minor leaguer Brandon Pfaadt. Harrison was selected to represent the Giants in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium on July 16. With his Flying Squirrels debut on May 27, he became the youngest pitcher in team history. He also picked up the second-most strikeouts in a debut in franchise history with nine. Harrison began the season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, where he went 0-1 with a 1.55 ERA in seven starts. At the time of his promotion to Richmond, Harrison ranked third in the Northwest League in ERA (1.55), second in strikeouts (59), third in BAA (.179) and tied for fifth in WHIP (1.00). Harrison was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2020 MLB Draft by the Giants out of De La Salle High School in Concord, Calif. He is currently rated by MLB.com as the Giants' No. 2 prospect, No. 22-overall prospect and the No. 1 LHP prospect. *Baseball America* ranks Harrison as the Giants' No. 2 prospect, the No. 21-overall prospect and the No. 1 LHP prospect. **For more on Harrison, see page two.**

WHIFF: For the season, **Kyle Harrison** leads the minors in strikeouts-per-nine-innings at 15.0. That would be the highest rate for a pitcher in the minors (min. 100 IP) dating back to 1960. Others on the list include Royber Salinas (2022 with Rome and Augusta, 14.4), Dwight Gooden (1983 with Lynchburg, 14.1), A.J. Burnett (1998 with Kane County, 14.1), Grayson Rodriguez (2021 with Bowie and Aberdeen, 14.1) and Bob O'Brien (1969 with Ogden, 14.0).

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Elvis Alvarado makes his first Double-A start. He has pitched 18 relief outings for the SeaWolves this year, most recently in Sunday's series finale against Altoona when he worked one inning and allowed an unearned run in extras. Alvarado is making his 48th-overall appearance of the year across three different levels with the Tigers organization.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,110) and rank third in total attendance (372,726). Richmond is 15th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 159 home runs this season, which is tied for third in the Eastern League. On August 7 in the 101st game of the season, **Riley Mahan** hit a grand slam to give the Flying Squirrels their 128th homer of the season, breaking the previous franchise record. Last year, the Flying Squirrels broke the team record for homers with 127 in just 113 games, passing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 164 home runs. **Sean Roby** is tied for fourth in the league with 25 homers on the season, with 21 coming at The Diamond.

CASEY AT THE BAT: Infielder **Casey Schmitt** was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 9. After going 0-for-3 in his Double-A debut on August 10, Schmitt has hit .357 (35-for-98) with three homers, nine doubles, a triple and 16 RBIs in his last 24 games since August 11. On September 8, he homered twice and drove in four runs. The next night, he collected three hits, including two doubles, and drove in three runs. He picked up three hits in Sunday's series finale at Bowie.

FITZ ON FIRE: **Tyler Fitzgerald** has 21 homers this season, which ranks as the second-most in a season in franchise history, one homer ahead of **David Villar's** previous franchise record of 20 set last year and trailing 25 by **Sean Roby** this year. Over his last 38 games since July 28, Fitzgerald is batting .307 (47-for-153) with seven homers, nine doubles, one triple and 23 RBIs, which has raised his season batting average from .194 to .233.

BRAND NEW MAN: **Will Wilson** returned to action late last month after missing nearly three months with a broken hamate. After a rehab assignment in the Arizona Complex League, Wilson was assigned to Richmond on August 24. He hit .160 (4-for-25) in his first seven games back with Richmond. Over his last 11 games, Wilson is batting .293 (12-for-41) with two homers, a double, seven walks and six RBIs. After going 0-for-9 in a three-game stretch, he had two hits in Sunday's finale in Bowie, including a go-ahead homer in the top of the ninth inning, and added a solo homer on Tuesday night.

SHANE TRAIN: On Tuesday night, **Shane Matheny** hit a two-run homer against the Baysox. It was his 12th Double-A homer of the season and his fifth against the Baysox. He hit two homers in a win over Bowie on May 1 at The Diamond. He added homers in back-to-back games played on June 28 and June 30 at Prince George's Stadium. After going 20 games without a homer from August 6-September 2, Matheny has homered twice in his last eight games since last September 3. In last week's series against the Baysox, Matheny hit .273 (6-for-22) with a homer, a double and three RBIs.

SAY HEY: **Jacob Heyward** clubbed two-run homers in back-to-back games on Wednesday and Thursday. He now has six homers in his last 20 games played, giving him 32 for his Richmond career, which is the second-most in franchise history, trailing on 37 by **Ricky Oropesa** (2013-16). He has also extended his career franchise walks record to 157.

SCORELESS STREAK: Reliever **Clay Helvey** has worked 12 consecutive games without allowing an earned run dating back to August 5, the longest active streak in the Eastern League. In that span, he has worked 18.1 innings with 21 strikeouts, eight walks, seven hits allowed and one unearned run. It's the second-longest streak for a Richmond pitcher this year and tied for the fifth-longest in the Eastern League in 2022.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Sean Roby** is tied for fourth in homers (25). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for ninth in stolen bases (24). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is 10th in homers (21) and tied for second in runs scored (73). **Shane Matheny** is third in OBP (.380) and tied for seventh with 56 walks. **Ryan Walker** is tied for eighth in games pitched (43).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Casey Schmitt** (2), **Vaun Brown** (10), **Ryan Murphy** (15 - on IL), **Will Wilson** (22) and **Ricardo Genoves** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. Schmitt is listed as the "Best Defensive Infielder" and "Best Infield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Schmitt (6), Murphy (15), **Tristan Peters** (21), **Will Wilson** (26) and **Landen Roupp** (28). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 20 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 22 overall prospect.
