San Jose Giants (6-5) RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (7-4)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! Your first-place Quakes continue a six-game set against the San Jose Giants (SF) today with game three of the series. Tonight is our first Thirsty Thursday of the year, as fans can enjoy drink specials throughout the night, including \$3 Pepsi products and beer specials starting at just \$5. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE GIANTS: Today's game is the third of 18 games against the Giants and the third of 12 here at home. The Quakes are currently 2-0 against the Giants. Rancho was 7-5 against the Giants in 2024, 4-2 here at LoanMart Field. LAST GAME: Five unearned runs in the fourth were enough to keep the Quakes perfect at home, as Rancho defeated San Jose on Wednesday night by a final of 5-3. A defensive error at shortstop and three walks led to a five-run fourth against Giants' starter Niko Mazza (0-1), with Kellon Lindsey's two-run single capping the frame. The Rancho bullpen was outstanding on Wednesday, as Alex Makarewich (1-0) struck out five over 2.2 innings, while Jholbran Herder fired 3.1 innings of scoreless baseball for his first save. The win is Rancho's third straight overall, matching their longest win streak of the year. It's also their fifth straight home win to open the season, making them 5-0 at LoanMart Field. The loss for San Jose is their second straight, after winning six in a row.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a roster move early Tuesday morning, placing Oswaldo Osorio on the Injured List. Taking his place is infielder Eduardo Guerrero, who joined the team from High-A Great Lakes.

STILL WEARING THE SAME SHOE: The Quakes have welcomed back Manager John Shoemaker, who returns to Rancho to guide the Quakes for a fifth straight year, a franchise record. The club is 271-243 in four seasons under "Shoe", having made the playoffs twice, including one appearance in the Championship Series (2023). The Quakes have only one returning coach to this year's club, as pitching coach Ramon Troncoso returns to Rancho, joining Shoemaker for his fifth year as well. New members of the coaching staff include hitting coach Johermyn Chavez, pitching coach Brandon Bailey, Bench Coach Dunior Zerpa, Bullpen Coach and former Quake Marco Hernandez, Athletic Trainer Alfredo Casillas, Performance Coach Jake Taylor and Video Associate Max Delorme.

PROSPECT HEAVY: According to MLB Pipeline's rankings the Dodgers have stocked the Quakes with seven of their top-30 prospects. In order, they are: INF Kellon Lindsey (#8), OF Eduardo Quintero (#9), INF Joendry Vargas (#12), RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (#17), OF Mike Sirota (#21), OF Jaron Elkins and RHP Samuel Sanchez (#28). Of the 29 active players on the Rancho roster, 15 of them saw time in a Quakes' uniform in 2024.

AIDAN FOELLER: Right-hander Aidan Foeller makes his third start and his fifth career appearance as a pro, his first against San Jose. In his last start overall, he allowed one run on one hit, but struggled with his command, walking six batters while striking out eight over 3.2 innings of work in a no-decision at Stockton on April 11th. Last season, Foeller got a brief taste of the Cal League, striking out four, without surrendering a hit or run over three scoreless innings for Rancho. Foeller was an 11th-round selection in last year's draft, out of Southern Illinois.

DRAKE GEORGE: Right-hander Drake George makes his third appearance, second start, and first against the Quakes. In his last outing overall, he started and scattered just two hits over four scoreless innings in a no-decision vs Visalia on April 10th. George played college ball at Lewis and Clark State in Idaho and was drafted by the Giants in the 13th round of the 2024 draft.
