### CAPTAINS LOG

#### DOUBLEHEADER SPLIT

The Captains split a doubleheader with the Great Lakes Loons on Thursday night at Dow Diamond in Midland, Michigan. Lake County fell in Game 1 by a final score of 0-4 in 8 innings and won Game 2 by a final score of 3-2 in 7 innings.

In Game 1, after trailing 4-0 entering the 7th inning, the Captains rallied to tie the game thanks to an RBI single from 1B Nolan Schubart and a 3-run home run from 2B Welbyn Francisca. His 1st career High-A home run. Great Lakes eventually won the contest thanks to a walk-off fielder's choice in the 8th inning. In Game 2, after trailing 2-0 entering the bottom of the 6th inning, Lake County tied the game with a 2-out, 2-run double from OF Jace LaViolette. An inning later, 1B Nolan Schubart hit a walk-off solo home run at Dow Diamond to win the contest (makeup of 9/9 home game).

#### FIRST HALF TEAM NOTABLES

Offensively, the Captains led High-A and ranked 2nd in MILB with 401 RB during the First Half, while ranking top-3 in the Midwest League with 88 HR (2nd), 361 RBI, and a .374 OBP. The Lake County pitching staff led the Midwest League with 281 BB (fewest), while ranking top-3 in the league with a 1.46 WHIP (T-2nd), 37 wins (3rd), and 17 saves (3rd).

#### ON-BASE MACHINES

C Bennett Thompson leads MILB with a .482 OBP, while INF Dean Curley ranks 1-2nd in MILB with 62 BB. Thompson has reached base in 43 of 46 games with 1+ PA, while Curley has reached base in 47 of 54 games played.

#### WALTON'S WORLD

OF Aaron Walton ranks top-5 in the Midwest League with 19 2B (2nd), 32 XBH (2nd), 122 TB (4th), and 65 H (5th). He is the only High-A player and 1 of just 4 MILB players with 45+ RBI, 30+ XBH, and 15+ SB this season.

#### SCHUBART THE SUPER SLUGGER

1B/OF Nolan Schubart is tied for the Midwest League lead with 55 RBI, while ranking top-10 with 15 HR (T-2nd), 52 BB (5th), and 46 R (9th). The 2026 3rd-round pick out of Oklahoma State is currently on a 26-game on-base streak, batting .326 with 31 H, 27 R, 5 2B, 9 HR, 31 RBI, 22 BB, and a 1.12 OPS during this span.

### MANAGERIAL CAREER

- Omir Santos enters his 4th season as Lake County's manager, and 9th season as a coach in the Guardians organization.
- The 44-year-old was named the 15th Manager in Captains history on February 7, 2023.
- Santos is both the **winningest (216 wins)** and **longest-tenured (3 seasons entering 2026)** in Lake County franchise history.

- Omir Jr. currently plays baseball (catcher) at Eastern Florida State College (JUCO).

### 2025

- Guided the Captains to clinch the Midwest League East Division Second Half playoff spot, Lake County's 9th-ever postseason appearance.
- Became the 1st manager in Lake County franchise history to serve as Captains manager **for more than 2 seasons**.
- With his 171st win at the helm on June 8 @ West Michigan, **became the winningest manager in Captains franchise history**.
- Under his leadership, the 2025 Captains produced 3 Midwest League All-Stars, **including Midwest League Pitcher of the Year Josh Hartle**.

### 2024

- **Won the 2024 Midwest League Championship**, managing the Captains to their 2nd title in franchise history.
- Under his leadership, the 2024 Captains produced 4 Midwest League All-Stars **and were named Baseball America's 2024 MiLB Team of the Year**.
- According to MiLB.com's Ben Weinrib, **the 2024 Captains became the first team since 2011 to lead the Midwest League in both runs scored (632) and fewest runs allowed (507)**.

- Guided the Captains to a 65-64 record, their 4th consecutive winning campaign.

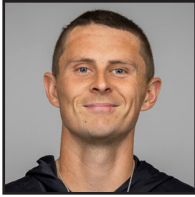

She made a strong impact for Lake County both on and off the field in her first season as the team's Bat Dog. On the field, Mokoro retrieved bats during all Thursday home games for the Captains, who advanced to the Midwest League Playoffs for the third time in the last four seasons. Off the field, her in-game snack deliveries to Roto-Rooter Toilet Row were seen by over 1 million local and national fans, which raised incredible visibility for Mission Empawthy, LLC. Mokoro, along with Brody, also joined the Captains' broadcast booth for a half-inning during Lake County's game on Sept. 4, 2025. This guest broadcast appearance was featured on MiLB's social media platforms, MiLB.com, and ESPN's "SportsCenter." Mokoro is named after a type of dugout canoe found in Botswana. These vessels, which usually carry 1-2 passengers, are commonly used to navigate the Okavango Delta for both transport and game viewing safaris. LAST TIME OUT: On Wednesday, June 10, LHP Michael Kennedy (L, 5-3) suffered his 3rd loss of the season in a 8-4 Captains home defeat to the West Michigan Whitecaps. The portsider allowed 2 runs on 3 hits, striking out 5 and walking 4 in 4 innings of work. His 2 runs allowed were courtesy of a pair of RBI singles in the 2nd inning.

HISTORY OUT OF THE BULLPEN: On June 4, Kennedy earned his 5th win of the season in a 10-4 Captains road victory over the Fort Wayne TinCaps. The portsider allowed just 1 hit and 1 walk in 5 scoreless innings of piggyback relief, striking out 9 in 67 pitches (44 strikes). Kennedy retired 15 of 17 batters faced, including each of his first 12. **His 9 strikeouts were tied for the most by a Captains reliever in a game since at least 2005, and he became the first Lake County bullpen arm to achieve the mark since LHP Thomas Pannone on May 15, 2015 vs. Dayton.**

2025 IN LAKE COUNTY: Besides his injury rehab stint with the ACL Guardians, LHP Michael Kennedy spent the entire 2025 season with the Captains. He made 16 appearances (9 starts) for Lake County, going 2-2 with a 3.32 ERA and 1 save, throwing 61 strikeouts to 25 walks in 62.1 innings pitched.

CAPTAIN OF THE WEEK: On Monday, Aug. 11, 2025, Kennedy was named the 18<sup>th</sup> Captain of the Week, presented by Official League, for the 2025 season. **The southpaw tied his High-A-best with 5.2 innings pitched in a road start against the Dayton Dragons on Saturday, Aug. 9, 2025.** He did not record a decision, allowing just 1 run on 7 hits, while throwing 5 strikeouts to 3 walks in an eventual 2-1 Captains defeat.

WELCOME BACK, KENNEDY: After being placed on the 7-day injured list on May 7, 2025 with R knee soreness, Kennedy was activated on Thursday, June 26, 2025. **The southpaw made 2 rehab starts for the ACL Guardians on June 12 and June 19, 2025,** permitting 7 hits, 7 runs (5 earned), and 6 walks to 4 strikeouts in 3 combined innings of work.

FORMER TOP 20 PROSPECT: At one point during the 2025 season, Kennedy was the Guardians' No. 20 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. **MLB Pipeline on Kennedy:** "Kennedy's fastball averaged just under 90 mph and peaked at 93 last season [2024], though it was effective because he creates deception and carry with a flat approach angle. Hitters also can't sit on his heater because he has a pair of solid secondary pitches that elicit a lot of chases. His sweeping low-80s slider keeps left-handers in check and his sinking low-80s changeup keeps right-handers at bay." In his career with the Pirates organization, the left-hander compiled a 3.11 ERA, with a 158/44 K/BB ratio over 130.1 innings pitched. **In 2024, Kennedy had just a 6% walk rate, which ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> among teenagers in MiLB (min. 80 IP).**

FORMER TOP 30 PROSPECT: At one point during the 2025 season, Kennedy was also the Guardians' No. 27 prospect according to Baseball America. **Baseball America on Kennedy:** "...a deceptive low-slot release and shorter arm path have allowed the sturdily-built lefthander to elicit whiffs at the top of the zone with his heater and mostly stymie lower-level hitters... Kennedy throws plenty of strikes and repeats his delivery well."

WELCOME TO THE LAND: On Dec. 10, 2024, Kennedy was traded to the Cleveland Guardians from the Pittsburgh Pirates. He was traded to Cleveland along with former Captains LHP Josh Hartle and current Guardians RHP Luis Ortiz in exchange for INF Spencer Horwitz.

ROOKIE BALL LEGEND: With the FCL Pirates in 2023, Kennedy was awarded FCL Pitcher of the Month for August and was named a Baseball America Rookie Leagues All-Star. In August, he had a 0.61 ERA in 14.2 innings pitched, holding opponents to just a .109 AVG. Kennedy threw back-to-back scoreless starts on 8/8 and 8/15, tallying 8.2 straight scoreless innings. **Kennedy's 0.61 ERA in August ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> in all of Rookie Ball (min. 14 IP), and his 6.00 K/BB ratio ranked 4<sup>th</sup> in all of professional baseball in the month of August.**

FIDGET SPINNERS: According to Baseball America's Tim Williams, Kennedy was bored in his house in Bradenton, Florida during 2024 Spring Training, so he decided to purchase fidget spinners from Amazon. He brought them to the clubhouse, and they were an immediate hit. **As a result, the left-hander purchased a Pirates-branded fidget spinner for each Single-A Bradenton pitcher.** That season, Kennedy finished 5<sup>th</sup> on Bradenton in strikeouts (80), innings pitched (73), and games started (15, tied), **proving the fidget spinners to be effective.**

THE FLYING HORSE: A two-way star in high school at Troy High School in Troy, New York, Kennedy was named New York's 2021-22 Gatorade Player of the Year following an incredible senior season both at the plate and on the mound. **The southpaw went a perfect 6-0 with a 0.60 ERA and 65 strikeouts in just 35 innings pitched for the Flying Horses during his senior season in 2022. He also batted .361 with two home runs and 12 RBI at the plate.** During his junior year in 2021, Kennedy helped the Flying Horses win their first-ever Section II, Class A Championship. The left-hander went a perfect 7-0 with a 0.32 ERA and 89 strikeouts in just 44 innings pitched, while recording a team-best .547 batting average at the plate. **In the final game of his high school career, Kennedy threw a no-hitter vs. Albany Academy, propelling Troy to the Section II, Class A Semifinals.** As a hitter, he finished his high school career batting .437 with 7 home runs.
