#### Leading Off

Reading continues this week's series at New Hampshire with game four. The Fisher Cats have won the first three games of the week.

Reading fell 11-8 in a rain-shortened game that was called in the bottom of the seventh. The R-Phils jumped out to an 8-1 lead, but ten-unanswered runs from New Hampshire in the final two innings led them to victory. Nick Ward had three hits, three runs, two homers and five RBI. Oliver Dunn also homered and had two hits. Mick Abel started and went five innings, striking out nine and walking four.

Reading Manager Al Pedrique sits just two wins shy of 1,000 in his Major/Minor League managerial career. Pedrique's win totals with each organization have been: Royals (102), Astros (158), Diamondbacks (225), Yankees (394), Miami (75) and Phillies (44).

#### He Dunn Can't Be Stopped

Oliver Dunn's red-hot stretch continued with a home run, double and three RBI last night. He has homers in back-to-back games, which is the fifth time he's done that this season. In August, Dunn is slashing .457/.474/1.086, with a 1.560 OPS. He also has six homers, 18 RBI and nine runs scored. His recent stretch see's Dunn ranked at the following in the league: 6th AVG, T5th HR, T7th Hits, 3rd RBI, 3rd SLG and 2nd OBP.

Nick Ward's second start with Reading came with multiple career highs. Ward's three runs matched a career high, two homers set a career high, along with his three extra-base hits. His five RBI was a career best as well. He is the sixth R-Phil to have five RBI in a game this season and the eighth to hit two homers in a contest (fifth over the last month). His leadoff home run was the third time Reading has done that in 2023.

#### **New Prospect Rankings**

MLB Pipeline dropped a new set of prospect rankins last night. Reading has five players ranked in the Phillies Top 30: Mick Abel (2), Carlos De La Cruz (7), Orion Kerkering (8), Ethan Wilson (17) and Tommy McCollum (22). Former R-Phils listed were Andrew Painter (1), Johan Rojas (5), Griff McGarry (6) and Simon Muzziotti (9). Orion Kerkering had the biggest jump amongst R-Phils, going from 20 to eight and Tommy McCollum went from 28 to 22. The Phillies had four players ranked in the MLB Top 100: Andrew Painter (29), Mick Abel (49), Justin Crawford (83) and 2023 First Round Pick Aidan Miller (97).

#### Around the Organization

The Phillies won 6-2 over the Nationals to take thrree-of-four and begin a series with Minnesota tonight. Lehigh Valley beat Rochester 17-6. Kody Clemens hit three homers, which tied Dylan Cozens for most homers in an Iron Pigs game ever. Darick Hall had five hits and five RBI, while Matthew Kroon chipped in a trifecta of hits. Jersey Shore won 2-1 over Hudson Valley as five pitchers comvined to allow just one run. Clearwater split a doubleheader with Tampa as Justin Crawford had two hits in the first game.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

August 11, 1918: At Lauer's Park, Shoeless Joe Jackson hits a two-run homer over the right field fence in the 8th inning to lift the Reading Steel Casting Company to a 3-1 victory over Chester Shipbuilding. Lefty Williams goes the distance and strikes out nine for the win.

### Scouting the Cats

New Hampshire has struggled in the second half, with a 13-20 record. Overall, the Fisher Cats are 48-53 after a solid first half. Last week, they took two-of-six at Binghamton and play seven games at Hartford next week.

#### Cat on the Bump

Lefty Ricky Tiedemann makes his long-awaited return to New Hampshire's rotation tonight. Toronto's top prospect made multiple trips to the IL and has not pitched for New Hampshire since May 4. With New Hampshire, he's 0-1 with a 4.97 ERA (12.2 IP, 9 H, 7 BB, 23 SO). Tiedemann's made rehab stops with both Dunedin and the Rookie League Blue Jays. He split 2022 between Single-A Dunedin, High-A Vancouver and New Hampshire, going 5-4 with a 2.17 ERA over 18 starts. Toronto drafted him in the 3rd Round in 2021 out of Gordon West JC in California. Tiedemann was named Toronto's 2022 Minor League Player of the Year and has no relation to Portland Sea Dogs' broadcaster Emma Tiedemann.
