TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve continue their third series with the Akron RubberDucks today at Canal

On the mound, Tommy Mace is back for his third outing of the season against Altoona in the first of today's doubleheader. Mace was the 69th overall selection by Cleveland in 2021 out of the University of Florida. The Tampa native attended Sunlake High School in Florida and uses a 5-pitch arsenal that includes the addition of a cutter in his final season at Florida. He shared a staff with former Curve lefty Hunter Barco while at Florida. Mace makes his 9th appearance against Altoona today, he's 4-3 with a 4.14 ERA and has struck out 28 batters and walked 18 in 41.1 IP.

Austin Peterson starts game two for Akron. Peterson has a 2.04 ERA against the Curve in four career outings, covering 17.1 IP. Peterson was Cleveland's 9th round selection in 2022 out of the University of Connecticut, he hails from Chesterton, Indiana. He began his collegiate career at Purdue (2019) then spent one season at Wabash Valley Community College in Illinois (2020) and two years at UConn ('21 and '22) where he was a two-time All Big East selection and set the program's single-season record with 147 strikeouts in the 2022 season; he aided UConn to a Super Regional appearance at Stanford.

THE TERMINATOR: Termarr Johnson has reached in 10 straight games entering play on Thursday, May 22. During his current on-base streak (which includes a hit in each of his last 6 games), he's hitting .333 with 2 2B, 2 HR, 2 RBI and 9 BB, totaling a 1.078 OPS. His current 6-game hit streak is the third such streak for him this season, he began the season with a 7-game hit streak and remains one of the youngest Double-A players. <u>Johnson is one of six players at the level who have recorded an</u> .800 OPS or better this season when playing 2B.

FEELING PEACHY: Infielder Kervin Pichardo reached in all 5 of his plate appearances on Thursday, May 15 against Harrisburg. Pichardo matched his career-high with 3 runs scored and drove in 4 runs, one shy of his career-high. In 14 games in the Month of May, he's batting .326 with 5 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, and 10 RBI, totaling a .986 OPS. His .634 slugging percentage this month is 12th-best among Double-A players. Pichardo has reached in 7 straight games entering play on Thursday, May 22

JEBBIDIAH: Mitch Jebb has a hit in 14-of-17 games in the month of May, batting .364, 7th-best by a Double-A player. His 24 hits this month are 4th-most by a Double-A player.

CAPTAIN JACK: Infielder Jack Brannigan reached base safely in 23 straight games from April 23-May 20. Brannigan's streak is tied for the longest by a Double-A player this season and was the longest by an Eastern Leaguer. He picked up 22 hits and walked 10 times during this stretch, recording a .767 OPS. Brannigan has a hit in 12-of-17 games in the month of May.

MACMAN: Righty **Garrett McMillan** has allowed just one run in 10.0 innings with the Curve in his two starts. This season he's combined to go 4-0 with a 1.38 ERA (39.0 IP/6 ER) in 8 starts this season between Greensboro and Altoona, his 1.38 ERA is second-lowest among Pirates minor leaguers behind **Hunter Barco** (0.89).

ENTER SANDMAN: Closer Cam Sanders has dazzled in his 13 outings with the Curve this season. His .096 batting average against ranks 2nd among Double-A relievers (min. 15.0 IP), he is also 2nd in saves (9) among minor league players. Sanders has been unscored upon in 12-of-13 outings this season and became the first Curve reliever to pick up 7 saves in a calendar. month (April) since **Matt Eckelman** saved 8 games in June of 2019. **Justin Kaye** (June, 2005) and **Matt Peterson** (June, 2007) hold the record for saves in a month by a Curve pitcher with 9.

WE'RE AT THE DOTEL HOTEL: Starter Wilber Dotel has used a vastly improved splitter this season to become a true strikeout artist. This season, he holds a 22.2% K-BB% after he recorded an 11.2% mark in 2024 with Greensboro. Additionally, he struck out 6 or more batters in 5-of-his-last-6 starts. In his last 6 outings, he's struck out 40 batters in 26.2 IP. He ranks 3rd in the Eastern League in stikeouts (47) and T-1st in games started (8).

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU START: Curve starters tossed 15 scoreless innings to begin the season (Barco, Dotel, Solometo, Chen).

Overall, Curve starters held a 1.13 WHIP, 3rd among Double-A staffs and 3.19 ERA, 3rd among Double-A clubs through play on May 22.

THE PIRATES ARE THIEVES: Altoona enters play on Thursday, May 22, 5th among Double-A clubs with 60 stolen bases in 74 tries. Mitch Jebb leads the club with 16 steals, 1st among Eastern Leaguers.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

Andy Fox Manager (1st Season) Career Record: 45-94

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

Matt Ford **Pitching Coach** 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

Casey Harms Hitting Coach 1st season/11th overall

Harms begins his fifth season as a Pirates instructor in 2025 and ioins Altoona after serving as Greensboro's Bench Coach in 2024. Harms joined the Pirates in 2021 as the Hitting Coach in the FCL. He played outfield at Division III Occidental College in Los Angeles and went on to coach in the collegiate ranks at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018) and Santa Barbara City College (2019-2021). He also spent two seasons as the Manager for the Waterloo Bucks in the Northwoods League (2019-20) and led the team to a 28-13 record and a league champion-ship in 2020.

Gary Green Bench Coach 4th season/20th overall

Green returns for a fourth season in Altoona and his 20th season as a minor league instructor with the Pirates. He has previously served as the Bench Coach in Indianapolis (2022) as well as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Field Instructor for the Pirates (2011-2021). A Pittsburgh native, Green's father, Fred, won a World Series with the Pirates in 1960. Green spent 11 seasons managing in the Tigers minor league system (99-10). A former Major League infielder for parts of five seasons, Green was drafted 27th overall by the Padres in 1984 and played on Team USA in the 1984 Olympic Games.


