**AMARILLO, TX** - For the second straight night, the Naturals entered the ninth inning trailing by five, scored four times and put the tying run on third with two outs, but once again the team could not pull out the victory, losing, 13-12.

The loss marked the Naturals' third straight by one run, dropping the team to 3-16 in one-run games this season. It was the fourth time this year in seven losses to Amarillo that Northwest Arkansas has scored four runs in the last inning and still lost the game, all by one run.

- For the first time this week, the Naturals did not score first, instead the Sod Poodles jumped out to a 4-0 lead after one inning. However, Northwest Arkansas slowly chipped away at the deficit, eventually tying the game up.
- In the second inning, Maikel Garcia singled home a run, then Robbie Glendinning dropped a two-run homer in the third, his third straight game with a homer and his 11th of the season.
- After Amarillo added a run in the third inning, Northwest Arkansas scored three in the fourth to get within two runs The Sod Poodles scored for the fourth straight inning with a home run in the fourth, but Garcia homered in the fifth to bring the Naturals within one and Seuly Matias tied the game in the sixth with an RBI double.
- While the Sod Poodles scored a run to take the lead in the bottom of the sixth and then four runs of insurance in the seventh, the Naturals refused to give up in the ninth.
- Down by five runs and with three outs to work with, Logan Porter and Matias opened the ninth inning with back-to-back singles, then Jake Means drove Porter home with a double. Pinch-hitter Tucker Bradley walked to load the bases, then pinch-hitter John Rave brought home a run on what would have been a sacrifice fly, instead reaching on a dropped catch error from Amarillo's left fielder. Still with no outs and only down by three runs, Garcia flied a ball to center field to bring home the inning's third run, though Rave was forced out at second. After Nick Loftin walked, Tyler Gentry stepped to the plate with the bases loaded and flied out to the wall in right field, scoring Bradley from third to bring the Naturals within a run. However, Garcia was stranded on third base to end the game as the tying run, while Loftin was stranded on second as the go-ahead run.

### THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 4-9 all-time when playing on July 3

On July 3, 2016, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Frisco RoughRiders, 6-2 at Arvest Ballpark. After the RoughRiders struck for two runs in the first inning against starting pitcher Jakob Junis, he combined with relievers Evan Beal and Aroni Nina to keep Frisco off the board the rest of the night. The Naturals trailed 2-0 until the bottom of the fifth, when first baseman Ryan O'Hearn connected on a grand slam to put the club up 4-2. Designated hitter Frank Schwindel drilled a two-run homer in the seventh inning, adding insurance in the victory.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER**

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 18 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 9 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave** and **Ángel Zerpa**.

**EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 26-5, while when scoring six runs or less, just 6-36.
- The Naturals are 20-10 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 12-31.
- The Naturals are 30-11 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 2-30 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 21-13, whereas 11-28 when the opponent scores first ... the Naturals have scored first four times this series, in the first inning the first four games, but have only won once.

**ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY**

The Naturals are 3-16 in one-run games this season, meaning 16 of their 41 losses (39.0%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 17 losses this season (including 12 of their one-run losses).
- In three games this season (4/26, 7/1 & 7/2), the Naturals have entered the last inning trailing Amarillo by five runs, proceeded to score four runs and put the tying run on and either bring the winning run to the plate or put it on base, but failed to tie the game or win.

**YO, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?**

Through 73 games, the Naturals have stolen 98 bases in 117 attempts (average 1.34 steals/game, 83.76% success rate).

- 98 steals ranks second in the Texas League, tied fourth in Double-A and tied 27th in the Minors.
- **Maikel Garcia's** 23 steals (in 26 attempts) ranks third in the Texas League and tied fifth among all Double-A hitters/basestealers.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 14 times, meaning 28 of 98 steals this year (28.6%) have come on a double-steal.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 48 of 73 games this season, including 26 games with two or more steals ... there have been three occasions where the team has stolen five bases, with perfect 5-for-5 steal efforts as a club on 5/13 vs. Wichita and 5/21 @ Arkansas.
- Naturals players have stolen two bases in a game 11 times, led by FOUR two-steal games from Garcia.

**ROCKIN' ROBBIE**

After slumping for much of June, first baseman Robbie Glendinning has begun to heat back up in the last week.

- The West Australian is riding an eight-game hitting streak, during which he's collected six multi-hit games, including four straight to start the streak ... since June 24, Robbie is hitting .441 (15-for-34) with four doubles, five home runs and a 1.500 OPS, including homers the last THREE games.
- 20 multi-hit games this season ranks third among Naturals hitters, 19 being two-hit games ... Robbie recorded his first 3-hit game on June 25 against Springfield, a 3-for-4 game with a double and home run.
- He has reached base in 57 of 63 games he's played this season (90.5%), with hits in 42 of 63.
- His homer in the 8th inning on June 25 snapped a drought of 100 plate appearances and 24 games without a home run, the longest between two home runs for any Natural this season.

**GAR-SEE YA ON BASE**

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** has reached base in 59 of the 69 games he has played in this season (85.5%), reaching base multiple times on a team-best 39 occasions, including a team-best 23 multi-hit games.

- In 328 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 120 times (83 hits + 37 walks), for a .368 on-base percentage.
- Garcia has walked 37 times and struck out 56 times, a 0.66 K/BB rate that ranks third among Royals minor league hitters with at least 250 plate appearances.
- The shortstop has the second-most hits in the Texas League (83), ranks third in the league in steals (23) and tied third in doubles (22), while tied seventh in runs scored (53) ... among all Double-A hitters, fourth in hits, tied sixth in steals and tied sixth in doubles.
- Maikel's 22 doubles are the most among all Royals Minor League hitters, while he ranks second in the organization with 83 hits, 23 steals and 53 runs scored ... he ranks tied third in the system in walks (37), tied fourth in total bases (116), tied fifth in extra-base hits (26), sixth in batting average (.289) and seventh in on-base percentage (.368).
- His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year, tied for the 15th-longest in club history and tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

**PUSHIN P(ORTER)**

Catcher **Logan Porter** has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks SIXTH in on-base percentage (.446) and fifth among all Double-A hitters in OBP ... in the Texas League, he is fourth in OBP and ninth in OPS (.924).
- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest on-base percentage, ranks third in OPS and batting average (.300) and fifth in slugging percentage (.478) ... his 43 walks are tied for the most in the system, with Omaha's Nick Pratto.
- Porter has reached base in 49 of 54 games he's played this season (90.7%), with hits in 45 of 54 and 17 multi-hit games, nine of which came in May.
- Porter's 17-game on-base streak between May 31 and June 23 is tied with Robbie Glendinning for the longest on the team this season, a stretch where he hit .321 (17-for-53) with 15 walks and a .493 on-base percentage.

**LOFTIN THE BALL OVER THE FENCE**

Naturals utility player Nick Loftin has loved playing in Amarillo, with home runs in each of the first four games of this series.

- Loftin has gone 6-for-18 at the plate this week, with his first four hits leaving the ballpark ... a ninth-inning two-run homer on Tuesday, June 28, a first-inning solo homer on Wednesday, June 29, a third-inning homer on Thursday, June 30 and a fifth-inning homer on Friday, July 1.
- Loftin's stretch of four straight games with home runs is just the fourth in Naturals franchise history, the last being Wil Myers from May 5 to 8 in 2012.
- Loftin is the second player in the Texas League to homer in more than three consecutive games, the other being Frisco's Trey Hair, who left the park in five straight games, June 7 to 12 for the RoughRiders, here in Amarillo against the Sod Poodles.
- Tuesday's home run snapped a 70-plate appearance stretch without a homer, his longest of the season between two home runs, his last having come in the first game of the Naturals' doubleheader at Tulsa on June 9.
- Loftin has reached base in 51 of 62 games (82.3%) where he has at least one plate appearance this season, with hits in 44 of 62 games and a whopping 21 multi-hit games.

**Pitchers of the Month (1)**

\* **May: LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

**Players of the Week (2)**

\* **April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.

\* **May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

**Pitchers of the Week (3)**

\* **May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.

\* **May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.

\* **June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.

- Accola graduated from the University of Central Missouri in 2014 and previously held an athletic training internship with the Denver Broncos in 2013.

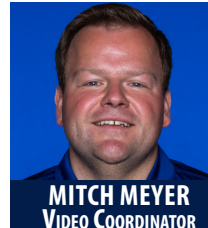
