MONDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Reading Fightin Phils, 15-7, on Independence Day in front of a sellout crowd of 9,810 fans. Richmond scored its 15 runs over the first four innings. Frankie Tostado opened the scoring in the first inning with an RBI double and Sean Roby added a two-run homer, his team-record 21st of the year. After two Reading runs in the second, Ricardo Genoves hit a two-run homer in the second, a run scored on a wild pitch and Brett Auerbach picked up a sac fly to extend the lead to 7-2. In the third, Shane Matheny hit a two-run double, Auerbach added an RBI single, a run scored on an error and Diego Rincones punched an RBI single to push the lead to 12-2. Jacob Heyward hit a three-run homer in the fourth to give Richmond a 15-2 lead. Reading scored two in the fifth and three in the seventh.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series is the only match-up of the season between the two teams. Last year, the Flying Squirrels went 8-4 against the Fightin Phils, including a 3-3 mark at The Diamond.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 2-5 to open the second half, including dropping five-of-six last week at Bowie, but have won two-of-the-last-three games. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost four and split two this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 849 strikeouts and rank second with 100 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 23-14 at home this year. Richmond is 19-11 in games decided by two-or-less runs.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS went 29-40 in the first half, finishing in fifth place in the Northeast Division and ninth overall in the Eastern League. In their first series of the second half, they went 4-2 at home against first-half Northeast Division-champion Somerset in last week's series. Reading's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects, including C Logan O'Hoppe (3), OF Johan Rojas (4), RHP Griff McGarry (8), RHP Francisco Morales (9), OF Jhailyn Ortiz (11), OF Simon Muzziotti (19) and RHP McKinley Moore (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Ryan Murphy makes second Double-A start. In his debut last Thursday at Bowie, Murphy allowed a career-high nine runs over 3.2 innings in a loss. After missing the start of the season with a back injury, Murphy joined High-A in Eugene in May. He made seven starts for the Emeralds, going 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond on June 28. During his time pitching for Eugene from May 15-June 22, Murphy led the Northwest League with 47 strikeouts, ranked seventh with a 2.90 ERA and ranked third with a 1.03 WHIP. Last year in his professional debut season, Murphy pitched for Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene. He finished the year second in the Giants system and third in the minors with 164 strikeouts, earning a selection as an Mills.com Giants Organization All-Star. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Giants out of NCAA DII Le Moyne College in New York. He is currently rated by MLB.com as the No. 11 Giants prospect and No. 10 by Baseball America. For more on Murphy, see page two.

FOR READING: Right-hander Griff McGarry makes his Double-A debut. He last pitched last Wednesday with High-A Jersey Shore at Wilmington and worked six scoreless, one-hit innings with 11 strikeouts in a win. In 12 starts with the Blue Claws, McGarry went 3-3 with a 3.86 ERA. McGarry was selected in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Phillies out of the University of Virginia. In his pro debut year last season with Low-A Clearwater and High-A Jersey Shore, McGarry combined to go 1-0 with a 2.96 ERA in eight games, including four starts.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,298) and total attendance (226,729). Richmond is 11th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 100 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League with Somerset (103). **Sean Roby** is second in the league with 21 homers on the season, with 16 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 182 homer runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in 2010 (71), 2011 (83) 2012 (76), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83), 2017 (93) and 2019 (84).

GO, DIEGO, GO!: After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, Diego Rincones is batting .423 (30-for-71) with four doubles, five homers and 18 RBIs over his last 18 games since June 7. On June 12 against the SeaWolves, he picked up his first three-hit game of the year, capped with a walk-off single, his second walk-off winning with the Flying Squirrels. He has homered in four of his last 10 games played. In last week's series at Bowie, Rincones hit .600 (12-for-20) with a homer and two RBIs and struck out twice. He picked up a season-high four hits last Tuesday in the series opener.

SHANE TRAIN: Since May 1, Shane Matheny is batting .301 (40-for-133) with eight homers, six doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 41 games. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season, even with a 13-game streak for Portland's Pedro Castellanos from May 6-22. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season. In the Eastern League this season, Matheny is ranked sixth in batting average (.290), third in OBP (.426) and fifth in OPS (.929).

TOASTY: Frankie Tostado has picked up five hits in his last three games after batting .175 (10-for-57) over a 16-game stretch from June 9-29. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked fifth in batting average (.297), tied for second in hits (76) and tied for eighth in total bases (123).

ROBUST: Sean Roby hit his 21st homer of the year on Monday night against the Fightin Phils, moving him ahead of David Villar for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. Roby is second in the EL in home runs this year, trailing Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 17 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by Adam Duvall in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Frankie Tostado is ranked fifth in batting average (.297), tied for second in hits (76) and tied for eighth in total bases (123). Sean Roby is second in homers (21) and 101th in total bases (122). Shane Matheny is sixth in batting average (.290), third in OBP (.426) and fifth in OPS (.929), Mike Gigliotti is tied for fourth in stolen bases (19). Ryan Walker is tied for first in wins (6). Chris Wright is tied for fifth in saves (6). Matt Frisbee is tied for first in complete games (1).

WHERE THE FIGHTIN PHILS RANK: In the Eastern League, Logan O'Hoppe is tied for seventh in homers (14), seventh in SLG (.531), seventh in OPS (.912) and tied for ninth in runs (42). Josh Ockimey is sixth in OPS (.407) and first in walks (56). Vito Friscia is seventh in OPS (.398) and third in walks (49). Jonathan Guzman and Kevin Vicuna are tied for second in triples (4). Brian Marconi is tied for second in games pitched (28) and tied for first in saves (10). McKinley Moore is fourth in games pitched (27) and Bubby Rossman is tied for fifth fifth (26).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Kyle Harrison (2), Ryan Murphy (10), Ricardo Genovés (24) and Chris Wright (27). Franklin Labour is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Simon Whiteman is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), Brett Auerbach (27), Genovés (29) and Kai-Wei Teng (30). Harrison is Baseball America's No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.

LOOKING AT THE FUTURE: On Wednesday, it was announced by Major League Baseball that LHP Kyle Harrison will participate in the 2022 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles on Saturday, July 16. Harrison, currently rated by MLB.com as the San Francisco Giants' No. 2 prospect and the No. 27 overall prospect in baseball, will represent the Giants in the annual prospect showcase as part of MLB's All-Star festivities. The 2022 Futures Game features the top Minor League prospects competing as part of the first-ever All-Star Saturday. It will once again feature a National League vs. American League format, which was introduced in 2019 following 20 years of U.S. vs. World matchups. The game, which is scheduled for seven innings, will begin at 7 p.m. ET/4 PT exclusively on Peacock and SiriusXM.
