YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox committed a season-high four errors in a 7-4 series opening loss to the Hartford Yard Goats on Tuesday. Hartford scored six of its seven runs in the first three innings against **Braxton Bragg**, marking the first earned runs allowed this season by the right-hander. **Frederick Bencosme** doubled in a run in the third, **Adam Retzbach** was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded and **Hudson Haskin** singled in a pair. **Preston Johnson** set down all seven batters faced in 2.1 innings of relief.

CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** had his 10-game hit streak end on Tuesday, which is tied for the third-longest hit streak in the Eastern League this season. His 15-game on-base streak also came to an end, which is also the third-longest in the league. During his hit streak, the Orioles No. 12 prospect batted .333 (12-for-36) with three doubles, two homers and six RBI. The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the team.

ACTION JACKSON

IF **Jeremiah Jackson** is tied for ninth in the Eastern League in hits (22) and is tied for the league lead in doubles (8) to start the season. The 25-year-old has hits in seven of his last 10 games with multi-hit performances in four of those games. Jackson has struck out only 11 times in 89 total plate appearances (12% strikeout rate), while averaging a 27.5% strikeout rate in his career. **The former Angels and Mets farmhand is three homers away from 100 on his career.**

ARMS RACE

Chesapeake pitching has allowed four earned runs or fewer in 18 of the 22 games played this season, which is tied for the Eastern League lead along with Erie. **The Baysox staff has punched out the third-most hitters in the league (216) while the bullpen has the third-lowest ERA in the circuit (2.83).** The Baysox are also the only Double-A team that has yet to blow a save (9 saves in 9 chances).

WALK THIS WAY

C **Silas Ardoin** drew nine walks last week against Altoona pitching, which was the most by any Double-A hitter. Ardoin has drawn eight walks over his last five games played. The 24-year-old currently leads the Eastern League in walks (18) which has bumped his OBP to 10th-best in the league (.393).

BRIGHT LIGHTS

RHP **Trace Bright** makes his fifth start of the season for the Baysox and his third career start against the Yard Goats. In his last start at Dunkin' Park on April 14, 2024, Bright struck out a Double-A high eight batters in five innings. The Orioles No. 25 prospect struck out the eighth-most batters in the Eastern League last year (120) but also walked the most batters in the league (60).

ONE RUN WONDERS

Despite having scored the third-fewest runs in all of Double-A (64), Chesapeake currently leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in one-run victories with **eight** so far this season. Last year, the Baysox had the third-most one-run wins in the Eastern League (25).

THE GOATS ARE GOING YARD

The Hartford Yard Goats are the Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. The Yard Goats most recently split their road trip in Somerset. Hartford won the first half of the season last year but lost in the Northeast Division Finals to Somerset. Hartford's active roster features five Rockies' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com): OF/SS Cole Carrigg (No. 3), OF Benny Montgomery (No. 15), RHP Gabriel Hughes (No. 16), IF Kyle Karros (No. 20) and RHP Jack Mahoney (No. 28).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Gabriel Hughes makes his fifth start of the season for Hartford and his first career start against Chesapeake. The 23-year-old has allowed just two walks in 16.2 innings pitched. Hughes delivered his first five inning start of the season against Somerset on Thursday, allowing one run on two hits with one walk and a season-high six strikeouts. Hughes missed all of last season due to Tommy John surgery. The Rockies drafted him with the 10th overall pick in 2022 out of Gonzaga.

- Arsenal: Fastball, Cutter, Curveball, Changeup, Splitter
- Ranked the Orioles No. 25 prospect, via MLB Pipeline
- Delivered 1,305th Baysox strikeout last year, setting new franchise single-season record

2025: Earned first Double-A win in 32 career starts after delivering first hitless start of AA career on 4/12 vs ERI (Gm 2) with 5.2 IP. Enters third stint (second full season) with Chesapeake.

2024: Completed third season in Orioles organization and first full season in Double-A with Bowie as a full-time starter. Eclipsed 100.0 IP for first time in career with 112.0 IP but allowed a career-high 60 BB. 2nd on team in IP and K (120). Led Eastern League in walks but finished 8th in K. Delivered 1,305th strikeout of the season in final start of year, which set a new Baysox single-season franchise record. Threw 4th-most IP, struck out 8th-most batters, and allowed 2nd-most BB in O's system. One of two winless starters in all of Double-A (minimum 20 starts). Went 5.0+ IP in only four starts. Baysox went 9-18 when Bright started. Started season strong with a 2.41 ERA in month of April (9th-lowest in EL) over 18.2 IP with 23 K. Ended season strong with a 1.93 ERA in 14.0 IP in September.

Career Notes: Began '23 in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in K. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in K. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least 4.0 innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.... Debuted professionally in '22 with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were 4th- most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with 3rd round pick Nolan McLean...Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
