All four of his Triple-A wins and three quality starts have come in away contests (June 12 at Nashville, Aug. 20 at Toledo, Sept. 7 at Louisville, Sept. 12 at Louisville). On Sunday, he surrendered just two hits over 6.0 scoreless innings with eight strikeouts. In four starts on the road against Triple-A East opponents this season, Kranick owns a 0.39 ERA (1er/23.0ip), 0.78 WHIP and .143 average against (11-for- 77). His numbers on the road are in stark comparison to his stats at Victory Field, where he is 0-4 with a 6.89 ERA (24er/31.1ip), 1.63 WHIP and .316 average against (42-for-133) in eight starts.MAKE IT A BAKER'S DOZEN: Bligh Madris extended his team-high hitting streak to 13 games on Sunday afternoon with a single in the fourth inning.
