TODAY'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds conclude a 13-game homestand and a seven-game series against the Gwinnett Stripers (Triple-A, Atlanta Braves) on Sunday afternoon. Right-handed pitcher Sem Robberse is scheduled to start for Memphis opposite left-handed pitcher Dylan Dodd for Gwinnett.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Memphis Redbirds continued a 13-game homestand and a seven-game series with a 6-1 win over the Gwinnett Stripers (Triple-A, Atlanta Braves) on Saturday night at AutoZone Park. First baseman Luken Baker became the first Memphis batter with a multi-homer game with a solo shot in the fourth and a two-run homer in the sixth. Baker's home run in the fourth inning was the second end of back-to-back home runs following a shortstop Jose Fermin home run. Baker now has 11 home runs this season and is 10 home runs shy of breaking the Memphis Redbirds career home run record. Memphis added another run of insurance in the bottom of the eighth on a right fielder Matt Koperniak solo home run. Koperniak finished the night 3-for-4, his third three-hit game of the series. Starting pitcher Adam Kloffenstein (1-4) earned his first win of the season with his best outing of the year on Saturday night. The right-handed pitcher allowed one run on three hits, walked one and struck out three in 6.0 innings.

AGAINST GWINNETT: The Redbirds traveled to face the Stripers in a six-game series in mid-April. With the final game of the series postponed to rain (to be made up in a doubleheader in Memphis on May 14), Memphis won the series 3-2. Offensively, The Redbirds were led by infielder Thomas Saggese. The right-handed hitter batted .381 in the series with a 1.102 OPS, hit a home run, drove in five runs and smacked three doubles. Infielder Jose Fermin drilled two leadoff home runs in the series, coming on back-to-back days. On the mound, right-handed pitcher Sem Robberse dominated in his start. Robberse, who earned International League Pitcher of the Week for his work, tossed 8.0 innings, allowed one unearned run on just one hit, walked two and struck out nine batters. Robberse is scheduled to start on Tuesday and Sunday in the series against Gwinnett this week at AutoZone Park.

HAPPY 25th, AZP: To commemorate the 25th anniversary season of Redbirds baseball at AutoZone Park, the Redbirds will host a plethora of promotions and theme nights to celebrate. Since the opening of the downtown ballpark in 2000, many credit the stadium with the revitalization of downtown Memphis. The support of the Redbirds at AutoZone Park caught the attention of Michael Heisley, who then brought the Grizzlies to the city. “(AutoZone Park) was a catalyst for a lot of the things that downtown is today,” Memphis Redbirds President and General Manager Craig Unger said. “So, I think even to this day today, you still see development going on around here. The Commonwealth building a few years ago, you know, Stewart and the group there that, that did that building talked about AutoZone Park. This entire block around Madison is still the catalyst for growth there. Sports is that catalyst.”

BASEBALL AMERICA OUTLOOK: The St. Louis Cardinals enter the 2024 season with the No. 20 Minor League system in all of baseball according to BaseballAmerica. St. Louis currently has five players ranked in the Top-100 (No. 39 Masyn Winn, MLB, No. 75 Tekoah Roby, AA, No. 83 Victor Scott II, MLB, No. 84 Tink Hence, AA, No. 85 Thomas Saggese, AAA). BaseballAmerica’s preview on the Cardinals system states “Jordan Walker’s successful graduation to the majors has dropped the Cardinals’ farm system back, though exciting up-the-middle hitters like Masyn Winn and Victor Scott II are ready to follow Walker to St. Louis. Getting the most out of arms like Tekoah Roby and Tink Hence is going to be crucial. The Cardinals pulled off the neat trick of adding two Top 100 Prospects when they dealt Jordan Montgomery to the Rangers for Roby and Thomas Saggese in July.

MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

Ben Johnson enters his sixth season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his sixth year in the Cardinals organization.

- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

- Marrero, 43, is beginning his 12th season in the Cardinals organization and second with Memphis.

COACHING CAREER

- As of 2023, Ten current members of the St. Louis Cardinals 40-man roster have come through Springfield since Marrero’s tenure began in 2017. Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

PLAYING CAREER

- Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

- Clark is beginning his second season in the Cardinals organization and second with Memphis

COACHING CAREER

- In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

PLAYING CAREER

- Clark played parts of six seasons in MLB with the Baltimore Orioles, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays from 2002 to 2008.
- Clark batted .262 with three home runs and 26 RBI in his career

TODAY'S START: Right-handed pitcher Sem Robberse is scheduled to make his ninth start of the season on Sunday afternoon against the Gwinnett Stripers.

LAST TIME OUT: Robberse allowed one run on four hits in his complete-game loss in game two of the doubleheader on Tuesday night against Gwinnett. The right-handed hitter allowed the run on three hits in the first inning and was out-dueled by Gwinnett stater Zach Logue (CG one-hit shutout).

LAST SEASON: The young right-handed pitcher was acquired at the trade deadline from TOR, along with RHP Adam Kloffenstein, in exchange for reliever Jordan Hicks. Robberse struggled early in his first looks at Triple-A, but ended the season strong.

MLB PIPELINE REPORT: Robberse is a unique development story, originally signed out of Zeist, Netherlands, in 2019. He was able to make his pro debut in the Rookie-level Gulf Coast League that season, allowing just one run over 10 1/3 innings. When the pandemic stopped baseball, Robberse was unable to return to the Netherlands and stayed at a hotel near the Blue Jays' complex with a group of prospects, including many of the Venezuelan players. This added yet another interesting wrinkle to his growth as he was often forced to work out by himself. Coming out of that, Robberse posted a 4.36 ERA over 88 2/3 innings in 2021, split between Single-A Dunedin and High-A Vancouver. Each number moved in the right direction in 2022, as Robberse climbed another level to Double-A and finished with a cumulative ERA of 3.23 over 111 1/3 innings, striking out 97. Much of Robberse's game is self-taught, which gives him a unique ability to adjust on the fly, and the Blue Jays were encouraged with some of his physical growth, too. After trying to keep on weight for years, Robberse finally packed it on in '22 and is now up above 200 pounds, which was the goal. There's hope this can bump his fastball up closer to the 93-94 mph range eventually. An increased strikeout ability would serve Robberse well, as at this point he relies on finesse with a promising package of secondaries. Now with the Cardinals after a Jordan Hicks trade at the 2023 deadline, the Futures Game participant can carry his momentum forward in hopes of joining a future St. Louis rotation.

FUTURES GAME & OTHER RECOGNITION: The right-handed pitcher was selected to participate in the futures game this season in Seattle during the All-Star Break. Robberse was named NorthWest League Pitcher of the week for his work in late May last season as a member of the Vancouver Canadians.
