FIRST IMPRESSIONS MATTER

OF **DAMON KEITH** has recorded a hit in each of his first 2 games in the Brewers organization, including a 113 MPH single on Saturday, the hardest hit ball by a Shucker this season... Keith was acquired via trade on March 27, 2026, from the Los Angeles Dodgers in exchange for cash considerations.

- ☞ Keith has reached base 6 times in 2 games, including 3 hits, 2 walks and a hit-by-pitch.
- ☞ Keith's multi-hit performance on Saturday marked his first since August 15, 2025, against San Antonio.

BURKE BOMBS, TIMES TWO!

On Friday, **1B BLAKE BURKE** became the first player in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015) to record a multi-home run game on Opening Day.

- ☞ Burke is the first Southern League player to achieve the feat since **INF Jaime Pedroza** in 2014 with the Birmingham Barons.
- ☞ Burke joins Pedroza ('14 at MTG) and **1B Paul Goldschmidt** ('11 at CAR) as the only 3 Southern League players to achieve the feat in the Digital Stats Era (since 2005).
- ☞ Burke has 13 home runs in 39 Southern League games, an average of one every 11.46 at-bats... It marks the 5th-best mark in the Southern League (min. 140 AB) in the Digital Stats Era (since 2005).

WELCOME BACK, DYLAN!

On Friday, **2B/OF DYLAN O'Rae** made his first appearance since September 20, 2024, in Game 3 of the Southern League Division series... O'Rae missed the entire 2025 season due to injury.

- ☞ In 2 games with the Shuckers, O'Rae has reached base in 5 of 11 plate appearances (3 hits, 2bb).

STARTING OFF ON THE RIGHT FOOT

With Friday's win, the Shuckers are now 9-4 on Opening Day in franchise history (since 2015)... Since 2022, the Shuckers have won 4 of their last 5 Opening Day games, outscoring opponents 31-28 (+3).

- ☞ Friday's extra-innings game marked the team's second on Opening Day and first since April 8, 2022, at Pensacola.
- ☞ A win today would clinch the Shuckers first Opening Series win since 2024 against the Montgomery Biscuits... The Shuckers have previously won their Opening Series in 2024, 2023 and 2022.

TIME TO GET FAMILIAR

The Shuckers begin the 2026 season with 33 consecutive games against the same 3 opponents; the Rocket City Trash Pandas (LAA), Pensacola Blue Wahoos (MIA) and Columbus Clingstones (ATL)... The Shuckers play 45 of 69 games in the first half against those 3 opponents, including 24 games against the Clingstones.

BACK IN THE SADDLE

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO returns to the Shuckers dugout for 2026 after 2 seasons as a Roving Infield Instructor with the Brewers organization... Guerrero enters his 9th season with the Shuckers, 10th in Double-A and 31st in the Brewers organization.

- ☞ After reaching 1,400 career wins during the 2023 season, Guerrero needs 54 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,446 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

MADE FOR THE BIG STAGE

SS/2B JESUS MADE (muh-DAY) enters the 2026 season as the top-ranked Brewers prospect and the 4th-ranked overall prospect by *Baseball America*.

- ☞ Made is the 4th Brewers player to enter the season as a Top-5 prospect and the 9th player to enter the season as a Top-10 prospect since *Baseball America* began their Top-100 rankings in 1990... Made joins Jackson Chourio (2023), Rickie Weeks (2005) and Ben Sheets (2001).
- ☞ Made will become baseball's top prospect once Konnor Griffin (6 AB), Kevin McGonigle (30 AB) and JJ Wetherholt (29 AB) all reach 130 AB.

RHP TYSON HARDIN (2-2, 3.29 in '25) makes his 2026 season debut... Hardin was named the Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2025 (21gs) after a 2.72 ERA and 2.35 FIP between Double-A Biloxi and High-A Wisconsin... Hardin was the 8th Shuckers pitcher to be named a Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Year over the last 10 seasons.
