### INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Indianapolis Indians tallied three runs in the first inning to defeat the Buffalo Bisons in Sunday's series finale at Victory Field, 8-3. Following an RBI single by Orelvis Martinez to give Buffalo, an early lead, Indianapolis took over in its first chance at the plate. Nick Gonzales smacked a line-drive double off former Indian Beau Sulser to jumpstart the offense, his first of two doubles in the game. He then scored on a sacrifice fly courtesy of Malcom Nunez. Two batters later, Matt Gorski singled home Jake Lamb to take the lead. In the fourth, the Indians boosted their lead after a Bisons pitching change when Luis Quinones allowed Dustin Peterson to score on a wild pitch. Gonzales followed with a ground-rule double over the center-field fence to score Andrés Alvarez. Buffalo scored one run in the fifth inning, but it was soon erased by three additional runs scored by Indianapolis.

**VICTORIOUS AT THE VIC:** The Indians won their 13th of 18 games at Victory Field on Sunday to clinch their third series victory at home this season. They lead the International League with 13 wins on their home turf this season. Friday and Saturday marked the first time this season that the Indians had lost back-to-back games at Victory Field after going 4-2 vs. Memphis from 4/2-7 (losses on Tuesday and Sunday) and 5-1 vs. St. Paul from 4/16-21.

**RAKE LAMB:** Jake Lamb went 2-for-3 on Sunday vs. Buffalo to improve his batting average to .403 (31-for-77) and on-base percentage to .485, both of which lead the International League. He also ranks among leaders in OPS (3rd, 1.095) and slugging percentage (9th, .610). Lamb is currently working a seven-game hitting streak with three multi-hit performances since 4/25 and has reached base safely in 23 of 24 games this season. Since 4/18, when his current 12-game on-base streak began, he owns a .474 batting average (18-for-38), nine runs, six doubles, one home run, 11 RBI, 11 walks, a .520 on-base percentage and 1.231 OPS.

**GONZO'S GOT DOUBLES:** Nick Gonzales, who trails teammate Jake Lamb as the International League's second-best hitter with a .360 batting average (41-for-114) this season, doubled twice on Sunday to lead the league with 14 two-baggers. After doubling eight times in 10 games from 4/9-19, Gonzales had doubled just once from 4/21-5/4 before roping two at Victory Field on Sunday. It was also his 12th multi-hit performance in 28 games with the Indians and his fourth with multiple extra-base hits. The middle-infielder reached base safely in all six games vs. Buffalo with three doubles, a triple and home run.

**SKENES DAY:** Right-handed pitcher Paul Skenes, who is rated as the No. 3 prospect in MiLB, No. 1 in the Pirates organization and No. 1 among right-handed pitchers (according to MLB Pipeline), made his seventh Triple-A start and second against Buffalo during the homestand on Sunday and allowed two runs over 4.1 innings. He allowed his first career home run in the fifth inning on a 97.9 mph fastball. On Tuesday, he posted a career-high 6.0 innings to record the Indians first quality start of the season. He currently leads the International League with a 0.99 ERA (3er/27.1ip) and is tied for the league lead with 45 strikeouts. He also ranks third among qualifiers in WHIP (0.91) and batting average against (.175).

**HELLER HAMMERS THE STRIKE ZONE:** Entering in relief of Paul Skenes, Ben Heller dominated the Bisons lineup with strikeouts of each of his five batters faced. It was the right-handers most strikeouts since 6/16/23 with Atlanta vs. Colorado, when he fanned five over 2.0 shutout innings. In eight total appearances this season between Single-A Bradenton (rehab assignment) and Indianapolis, Heller is 1-0 with a 1.86 ERA (2er/9.2ip), 22 strikeouts, a 0.52 WHIP and .147 batting average against.

**TONIGHT:** The Indians return to Louisville tonight for their second series of the season at Louisville Slugger Field after opening the season at the ballpark from 3/29-31. The Bats took two of three meetings during that opening series. To kick off the six-game set, LHP Eric Lauer (2-0, 3.52) will take the hill for Indianapolis in his second appearance vs. the Bats this season. Countering for Louisville is RHP Carson Spiers (1-1, 3.45), who owns a 11.00 ERA (11er/9.0ip) and seven strikeouts in two career starts vs. Indy.

**WELCOME HOME:** University of Louisville product Henry Davis returns to his college town after being optioned by Pittsburgh last week. Davis began the season on the Pirates' Opening Day roster and hit .162 (11-for-68) with seven runs, three doubles and four RBI in 23 games with the big-league club before being optioned last week. In 14 career Triple-A games with Indy last season, he hit .375 (18-for-48) with seven runs, six extra-base hits, a .516 on-base percentage and 1.120 OPS. He was the first baseball player from Louisville to be selected first overall and the fourth student-athlete taken No. 1 overall from the school regardless of sport.

**SNAKE EYES:** Henry Davis (2021 First-Year Player Draft) joins right-hander Paul Skenes (2023) as two No. 1 overall draft picks on Indianapolis' roster. He and Skenes are the fourth and fifth first overall draft picks to appear with Indianapolis in franchise history, following right-handed pitchers Tim Belcher (1983 No. 1 overall, pitched for Indy in 1995), Bryan Bullington (2002 No. 1 overall, pitched for Indy in 2005, 2007-08) and Gerrit Cole (2011 No. 1 overall, pitched for Indy in 2012-14, 2016).

**NEWBIES:** Outfielder Matt Fraizer and right-handed pitcher Isaac Mattson were promoted from Double-A Altoona today ahead of Indianapolis' series-opener at Louisville. Fraizer is set to make his Triple-A debut after spending the last two seasons with the Curve. Mattson was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent in the offseason and owns a career 1-2 record, 5.89 ERA (29er/44.1ip) and 57 strikeouts in 42 Triple-A appearances.

**THIS DATE IN 2002:** Left-handed pitcher Jimmy Osting tossed his first of three complete games on the season, the only to span a full 9.0 innings, in a 5-1 win at Pawtucket. Osting allowed just two hits, one of which was a home run, and struck out eight in the game. Osting is tied for third among Indians starting pitchers for most complete games thrown in the Victory Field era behind only Giovanni Carrara (5) and Casey Sadler (4).

**Eric Lauer:** Right-hander Eric Lauer is set to make his fifth start in today's matchup vs. Louisville.

**Last Outing:** Lauer took the bump for the Indians on 5/1 in his first outing vs. Buffalo and yielded four earned runs on eight hits (three home runs) and two walks with four strikeouts in 4.0 innings pitched.

**Against the Bats:** Lauer has made one career appearance vs. Louisville, posting a 10.13 ERA (3er/2.2ip)

**Lauer Power:** Eric Lauer split the 2023 season between the Milwaukee Brewers, Triple-A Nashville Sounds and the ACL Brewers. He made 23 total appearances (19 starts) while having his season shortened by right-shoulder impingement.

**Miscellaneous:** Lauer was selected by San Diego in the 1st round (25th overall) of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Kent State. He had his contract first selected by the Padres on April 24, 2018 and made his MLB debut that night at Colorado. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on March 22, 2024.
