ROAD ROUND TRIPPIN : During the latest road trip, the Loons hit 20 home runs in 12 games, nine different players hit a homer. Great Lakes has a home run in 11 consecutive games.

Jose Meza, homered on July 4th as part of a five-hit day. It's the first five hit game for a GLL since O'Neil Cruz on July 20th, 2017.

HARLAN... WITH NO REGARD FOR LUGNUTS PITCHERS : Chase Harlan on June 27th totaled 11 bases. He hit two home runs, a double and a single. The 19-year-old notched the first 11 total base by a Loon since Damon Keith on August 18th, 2022.

DOSE OF MUNOZ : In June, Samuel Munoz hit .318 with a .895 OPS. He has 21 hits and 32 total bases in 66 at-bats

It is his best month since 2022 when he played in the DSL

EDUARDO EXCELLENCE: Eduardo Quintero completed a 34-game on base streak on June 11th, the longest in Loons history.

Quintero, surpassed Mike Sirota and Miguel Vargas' 30 game streaks. Sirota's stretch was this year from April 9th to May 17th and Miguel Vargas did it from May 7th to June 10th, 2021.

Quintero after hitting .195 and posting a .585 OPS in April, earned a .372 batting average and .941 OPS in 20 games in May. Quintero led the Loons with 29 hits in May. In June he batted .333 with and a 1.011 OPS and a team-leading 27 hits.

STOLEN BASE CHASE: Through 78 games the Loons have 137 stolen bases, an average of 1.75 per game.

In 2025, the Loons had a franchise record 265 stolen bases. The pace of 1.80 per game is 228 in an 130 game season.

Great Lakes has amassed 200 stolen bases in each of the past three seasons.

PITCHING POWER: The Loons pitching staff is off to a tremendous start in 2026. GL currently ranks first in the Midwest League in strikeouts (852), and in ERA (4.35).

Great Lakes' 852 strikeouts rank first in High-A and sixth in MiLB. The Loons 11.45 K/9 is the best in the minors among full season levels (AAA, AA, A+, A).

FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED: The Great Lakes offense is hitting .282 in the first inning this year with 14 home runs and 58 runs.

It is not their best inning, with a .284 avg, .871 OPS and 63 runs in the third inning. Peoria has 74 runs in the fourth inning this season, most by a MWL team in any respective inning.

APRIL FOR THE AGES: The Loons went 16-8 in the first month of the season, their most wins in an April ever. In 2024 and 2014, Great Lakes won 15 games.

28 home runs and six in the first inning were both April records for the Loons. On the final day of April, a home doubleheader sweep against Peoria, Great Lakes hit five homers.

THE THREE MASHKETEERS: The trio of Chuck Davalan (6), Mike Sirota (5) and Logan Wagner (7) each had 5+ home runs in April, the first trio to that in Loons history.

Wagner's seven homers in April were the second most in the month in GL history behind Jerry Sands' eight in 2010.

OH WHAT A NINTH: The Loons scored nine runs in the top of the ninth in April 23rd's 13-9 win over the Beloit Sky Carp.

Trailing 8-4 with one out & the bases loaded Nico Perez powered his first pro career regular season grand slam. Jose Izzarra hit a go-ahead double up the left field line.

Chuck Davalan added a two-run single & Jose Meza's RBI knock gave the Loons a 13-8 lead and completed their best offensive inning of the season.

DAVALAN'S TWO HOMER INNING: Chuck Davalan had quite the Easter Sunday. In the bottom of the third, in game two of a doubleheader against Fort Wayne, Davalan went deep twice.

He started the frame with a solo homer demolished 417 feet. Then later in the inning with the bases loaded, he rifled a 3-2 pitch over the right field fence, a 355 footer.

Davalan became the first Loon since Jose Ramos on July 12th, 2022 versus Quad Cities to homer twice in the same inning.

SHE'S A BEAUTY THAT NUMBER NINE: The Loons were ranked as the ninth "most talented" MiLB team preseason by Baseball America & ninth "best roster" by MLB Pipeline

On both lists the Greenville Drive (Boston Red Sox High-A) ranked eighth. The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (Milwaukee Brewers High-A) were third on Pipeline's list.

GL's roster is bolstered by six Top 30 Dodgers prospects and two Top 100 in baseball ranked by the publications.

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MANAGER

Jair Fernandez

The Great Lakes Loons in conjunction with the Los Angeles Dodgers have named Jair Fernandez as their manager for the 2026 season. Fernandez will manage Great Lakes for the third straight season. Jair Fernandez is the 11th manager in the Loons' 18-year history and the fourth to return for a second year. 2026 will be Fernandez's tenth season as a coach within the Los Angeles Dodgers organization. This is Jair's second stint with the Great Lakes Loons. He served as the hitting coach in 2017 and 2018. The Loons hit a combined .240 in those two seasons, accumulating 192 home runs. For his home country, Fernandez has served in a multitude of coaching roles. In 2017, 2023, and 2026 he coached for Team Colombia in the World Baseball Classic. He served as the hitting coach in the 26' Classic. In the Colombian League, played annually from October to January, Fernandez managed two different franchises from 2016 to 2018. Leones de Monteria for two seasons and Tigres de Cartagena midway through the end of the 2018 campaign. Fernandez, 39, debuted in minor league baseball in 2007 at the age of 18 in the Seattle Mariners organization. The Colombian-born catcher spent nine seasons in baseball, appearing with two teams at the Triple-A level. Fernandez played within four major league organizations, the Mariners, Minnesota Twins, Houston Astros, and Chicago Cubs. Two summers were spent in the Midwest League. In 2008, he was an MWL All-Star with the Beloit Snappers, now the Beloit Sky Carp. Beloit was then affiliated with the Twins. He had 36 hits in 36 games, batting .283 and posting a .703 OPS. Before that season, he was traded from the Mariners organization to the Twins organization for 34-year-old R.A. Dickey. Fernandez totaled 470 games in his minor-league career, 31 at the Triple-A level including two with Oklahoma City, in 2012. Since 2015, Oklahoma City has been a Dodgers affiliate.

PITCHING COACH

Brandon Bailey

Brandon Bailey joins the Loons as their pitching coach for the 2026 season. Bailey, along with Ramon Troncoso, served as a pitching coach for the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes, then a Low-A Dodgers affiliate) in 2025. The 2025 Quakes led the California League in strikeouts with 1329 in 132 games, en route to a regular-season South Division title. Bailey is in his second year as a coach in the Dodgers organization. The 31-year-old was a sixth-round pick of the Oakland Athletics in 2016. He pitched five games with the Houston Astros in 2020. He made his debut on July 26, 2020, throwing a scoreless inning against the Seattle Mariners. The right-hander threw five seasons in the minors with his last appearance in 2023. He pitched for the Beloit Snappers in 2017, a then Midwest League affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. Bailey pitched in 15 games posting a 2.68 ERA in 57 innings with the Snappers. Bailey underwent Tommy John Surgery twice in his playing career. He tore the ulnar collateral ligament in his pitching elbow forcing him to miss his senior season at Broomfield High School in Broomfield, Colorado. He did not pitch in 2021, due to an injury needing Tommy John Surgery. Bailey retired in 2023 after another injury to his pitching elbow. In February 2024, the Baltimore Orioles hired Bailey to be the pitching coach for their affiliate in the Florida Complex League. Bailey is of Spanish and one-eighth Chickasaw ancestry. He is a member of the Chickasaw nation and his Chickasaw name is "Nita' Iskanno'si". It translates to "Little Bear". Bailey has a little bear tattooed on his left arm. A native of Westminster, CO, Bailey has a master's degree in sports coaching from the University of Northern Colorado. He pitched collegiately at Gonzaga University.

PITCHING COACH

Richard De Los Santos

Richard De Los Santos will begin a second stint with the Loons, as pitching coach for the 2026 season. In 2025, De Los Santos was a pitching coach for the Dodgers affiliate in the Arizona Complex League. From 2022 to 2024, De Los Santos alongside David Anderson served as pitching coaches for Great Lakes. 2022-24 rank as the top three seasons in total strikeouts by a Loons pitching staff. In 2022, Great Lakes pitchers achieved a franchise-best 1398 strikeouts. The 2023 Midwest League East Division Championship squad, had 1303 punchouts. The 41-year-old had a nine-year minor league playing career. The right-hander accumulated over 400 strikeouts. De Los Santos pitched a portion of the 2005 season for the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays, who were purchased in 2006 by the Michigan Baseball Foundation and became the Loons in 2007.

HITTING COACH

Kevin LaChance

Kevin LaChance, 31, will serve as the Loons' hitting coach in 2026. This is LaChance's third year as a coach within the Los Angeles Dodgers organization and second straight with the Loons. In February 2024, LaChance was hired by the Dodgers and was the hitting coach for the 2024 Arizona Complex League Champions, the ACL Dodgers. The group had the top on-base percentage (.395), second-best OPS (.809), and second-most stolen bases (109) in a 60-game season. LaChance came to the Dodgers after two years teaching baseball at the Colangelo Baseball Academy in Manassas, Virginia, owned by former major leaguer Mike Colangelo. During the off-season, LaChance continues to instruct at the academy. The Clifton, VA native played five seasons of professional baseball. He was a 2016 10th-round draft selection of the Los Angeles Dodgers and played 50 games as a member of the 2017 Pioneer League Champion Ogden Raptors. After being released, LaChance would be signed by the Arizona Diamondbacks and appeared in 33 games across four affiliates in 2019. From the tail end of 2019 through the 2022 season, LaChance played for the Winnipeg Goldeyes of the American Association. A 2016 graduate of the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC), he played four seasons for the Retrievers baseball team. A career .301 hitter, LaChance started 198 games at UMBC, missing only one game over his tenure. LaChance played his high school ball at Centerville High School. Notable attendees include rapper Ludacris, sports reporter Lindsay Czarniak, and current New England Patriots running backs coach Tony Dews.

BENCH COACH

Marco Hernandez

Marco Hernandez is the Loons' 2026 bench coach. Hernandez was utilized as the bullpen catcher for the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes in 2025. The Venezuelan-born catcher was signed by the Dodgers in 2015. He played 224 games across six minor league seasons, two stints with Rancho in 2021-2022. Hernandez finished his playing career in 2023 with the Gary SouthShore RailCats of the American Association.

BREAKOUT GAME IN SPRING BREAKOUT: The left-hander pitched three innings and struck out eight in the Dodgers Spring Breakout game against Chicago White Sox propsects on March 21st.

The eight strikeouts tied the Spring Breakout single-game strikeout record.

3 of Root's strikeouts were via the curveball, his fastball topped out at 99. His new slider has led to his other offspeed offering having more success. Root told MLB.com's Sonja Chen

"The last two years, I wasn't able really to throw a curveball for a strike very consistently. And it was just easier for hitters to sit on different pitches,"

DRAFT REACT: Root was selected with the first of back-to-back Competitive balance round A picks for the Dodgers in 2025.

Root was chosen 40th overall followed by Arkansas and Loons teammate OF Chuck Davalan.

MLB Network's draft coverage lauded Root.

Former Tennessee coach and current San Francisco Giants manager Tony Vitello noted "Our guys couldn't see it" when talking about his stuff.

Host Greg Amsinger, who is always nostalgic for the 90s, compared Root to 20-year big leaguer and former Dodger Terry Mulholland.

ROOT THE RAZORBACK: Zach Root pitched last season at the University of Arkansas. His 126 strikeouts were the seventh-most for a Razorbacks tosser in a single-season.

The left-hander earned 1st Team All-SEC honors and his best game was a seven-inning six strikeout win against Tennessee in the NCAA Fayetteville Super Regional.
